Dear Susan,

I wrote to you some time ago trying to find information on my Bales-Davidson lines in Indiana. You were kind enough to send some info and asked me to send family group sheets of my Indiana lines, which I did at that time. I have been fortunate enough to find out more since then and I was hoping that you would like receiving my new information. First- my Eden Bales & Elizabeth Davidson Bales family moved to Dallas Co Iowa ab 1869 or 1870, according to a deed record—which is why I haven't been able to find death records in Indiana! Also Eden & Elizabeth were marr. 3 May 1829 in Hendricks Co. Ind.

Elizabeth Davidson's parents are James Davidson & Mary Morris. I am enclosing a family group sheet for them & one for Mary Morris' father & family. I have a copy of will and deed record for James Davidson— and have received a typed copy of geneological data from William Morris deed—from heirs to one son for payment of debts. Both definitely name the right people to tie things together.

Also note that on James Davidson's sheet # 1 is the father of Samariah Davidson Bales the wife of Tarlton, the son of John Bales on the sheet I believe I sent you before. On William Morris' sheet # 8 seems to be the same as on the James Bales sheet I sent last time— #8 on that also. So although I cannot as yet tie the James Bales data into my family by a main line I have two marriage ties.

Thanks again for your help a few months ago.

Dear Susan,

Thank you so much for your help on researching the Bales' in Indiana.  
I will enclose the data I have on my Bales line up to now.

Yes I had noticed the Davidson's that lived near Eden & Elizabeth (Davidson) Bales but so far cannot prove them related but merely think so. There is also a Tarlton Bales who lives near them in both 1850 and 1860. According to what I've received from other Bales' researchers Tarlton's wife Samariah is also a Davidson. But they don't think that Eden & Tarlton are brothers--so maybe cousins instead?? I will also enclose the info they have sent me. Some of it I have no idea where they got the info--I will mark as much as possible with the sources and which researcher I got it from. The names of the Bales families they have seem to fit the names I have in later generations, so I feel that they must be in some way related.
