Samuel Barker, born in Claverly, England, in 1648, first appears in the records of the Court of Newcastle, Delaware, in 1677, when he petitions the court for a parcel of land, which is granted to him on condition that he settle on it and improve it. He may have come over a few years earlier with his brother John, who appears on a tax list of 1676, and helped him settle before taking up his own

Delaware at this time was under the jurisdiction of Governor Andros of New York, under English authority. It had been part of the Dutch colony of New

Netherlands until 1664, and was originally settled by Swedes before that.

The historical record flatly contradicts the tradition that Samuel Barker was a Quaker who came over with William Penn.

Samuel Barker appears often in the Records of the Court of New Castle, buying and selling land and arguing with others over debts. Samuel's last name was spelled "Bercquer", sometimes "Berker", in these documents until September, 1682, after which it is usually found as Barker. He must have been a man of reputable character, being named a church warden in 1678. (The church is named, but it would have to be the Church of England, since the civil court In 1681 Samuel Barker was appointed constable of the area jurisdiction.) north of Christina Creek.

The Court of Newcastle County met monthly in the town of Newcastle, beginning on the first Tuesday of the month, and meeting for one, two or three days as Many of Samuel Barker's appearances were in conjunction with a neighbor of his, Abraham Man. In January, 1678, Barker appeared as witness in a case between Man and one Jarvis Marshall. Marshall had agreed to sell Man a hundred-weight of sugar for 50 shillings. Man offered to pay in wheat, skins or Marshall refused. The court ruled that since wheat, skins and tobacco were "all three good and Currant payes of the River", Marshall could not back out of the agreement.

Later, Barker and Man had disagreements of their own. In June, 1680, Man sued Barker for the delivery of "one good sound merchandable hoghshead of tobb" (i.e., tobacco). In January of 1681, Samuel Barker came back to ask the court to rule on how much tobacco constituted one hogshead. The court ruled that the

necessary quantity would be 300 pounds.

1682, Samuel Barker received a warrant for 200 acres of land from William This may have been land he was already living on, as many of the early warrants were made as confirmation of transactions made under the previous government by Penn's new management. This tract of land was on the west side of Red Clay Creek in Mill Creek Hundred, and was later known as "Stony Hill". In 1685, Samuel Barker received a second land grant, and he is listed in the tax list of 1685/86 as possessing 400 acres.

Whether the marriage took place in Samuel married a woman named Agnes. Delaware or in England has not been found. Agnes Barker's name first appears in the court records in connection with a land transaction of 5 September, 1682, when Samuel Barker recorded the sale of land which he had bought two years earlier from Charles Rumsey. Law required a wife's approval when her husband sold property. She was named in the deed, and often there is also a note in the records that the wife was interviewed privately to assure that she signed of her own free will. Wives did not participate in their husbands' purchases.

Samuel and Agnes lived along the Red Clay Creek in Newcastle County and raised four children: Mary, Joseph, Daniel and Anna. There is little record of the early years of the family, but a family portrait can be drawn from later events. On July 31, 1717, a sort of family reunion took place. The minister of Old Swedes' Church came to Samuel Barker's house on that date and baptised three children:

Anna, daughter of William and Mary Richardson, born April 5, 1710.

Mary, daughter of William and Mary Richardson, born March 17, 1715.

William, son of William and Anna Hicks,

born 17 December, 1715.

Joseph and Mrs. Johanna Barker are listed among the sponsors of these children.

The children's ages show that Mary Barker wed William Richardson about or before 1709, and Anna wed William Hicks no later than 1715. The marriage of Joseph Barker to Johanna Clayton took place at Old Swedes' Church in Wilmington on 27 September, 1716.

What was the purpose of this family gathering? Did the minister of Old Swedes' Church come out just to baptise these three children? Could the occasion have been the funeral of Agnes, Samuel's wife? Or was the family being brought into the church through the influence of Johanna Clayton Barker, whose family is found frequently in the records of Old Swedes' Church?

Samuel Barker died in 1720. He was buried in the cemetery of Old Swedes' Church, 25 July, 1720. He left no will and Joseph was named administrator of his estate. From this it can be surmised that Agnes had died earlier, and that Joseph was the eldest son. Joseph and Daniel divided the property. Joseph kept the land granted by Penn in 1682, and Daniel received the grant of land from 1685.

Daniel Barker and Elizabeth Barker Berry

Daniel Barker first appears in the deed records of Newcastle County in 1729. He bought his first property in January of that year, selling part of it a month later, along with his wife Elizabeth. A birth date of 1704 has been listed for Daniel, apparently working back from this first mention of his wife in 1729. However, this would make him much younger than his brother and two sisters, who were all married by 1716. A late marriage is the more likely possibility than a late birth.

That Daniel is indeed the son of Samuel Barker is proved by a deed of 1764 in which Robert Barker identifies himself as son of Daniel and grandson of Samuel to explain his possession of Samuel Barker's 1685 grant land.

The family of Daniel's wife Elizabeth has not been identified. Family lists give her maiden name as Nicholls, or Nicholas; the latter is only a less common variant spelling of the former in the early 18th Century.

In February, 1735, Daniel Barker obtained a land warrant for survey of land on Red Clay Creek from John and Thomas Penn, successors to William. had originally been in the possession of Charles Springer and was identified as adjoining the land of Samuel Barker. Springer had transferred his claim to Daniel Barker, who had already settled and improved the property before he applied for a survey warrant. The terms of the warrant included a yearly quit rent, payable to the proprietors, of one penny sterling per acre.

In 1745, Daniel Barker was a resident and property owner in the town of Wilmington, which had been established in 1739, though he still owned land in the country. He owned property on Front Street, near West. Daniel died intestate in 1748, leaving his widow Elizabeth with six minor children. It is likely that he was buried in the cemetery of Wilmington Friends Meeting, which allowed no tombstones and has no records before 1800. They accepted persons of all faiths for burial. Daniel Barker was not a Quaker. His widow Elizabeth had connections with Quaker families, and eventually became one.

In keeping with standard practice, Elizabeth Barker was named administratrix of her husband's estate, on 19 December, 1748. On 17 October, 1749, she produced an account of her administration and the matter appeared to be closed. Between October of 1749 and April, 1750, she married Thomas Berry, a widower and Her six children were still minors. Their rights became of a concern of the County Orphan's court and guardians were appointed for them.

Two of the children, Dorcas and Robert, were old enough to appear in court and choose their own guardians. Dorcas chose John Bishop and Robert chose William Dixon. Then their mother appeared in court to request that these two men appointed guardians also for her four younger children, listed in the order:

Nicholas, Samuel, John and Elizabeth.

Thomas and Elizabeth Berry received permission from the court to sell Daniel's property to pay his debts, including 300 pounds owed to his brother Joseph, and to pay themselves. They sold his 1735 warrant land in 1752. They probably moved down to North Carolina that same year. In January, 1753, John Stapler appeared in court as their attorney to complete the accounting for the estate.

Elizabeth Berry joined the Quakers in North Carolina, being received by Cane Creek Monthly Meeting 6 October, 1759. Two of her children, Nicholas and John,

Nicholas was the only one to remain a Quaker. He married Hannah joined later. Allen, from Pennsylvania, daughter of John Allen and Phebe Scarlett. Their seven children produced many Barker families in the Quaker communities of Cane Creek and Holly Spring.

The history of Nicholas' brothers and sisters is as follows:

Dorcas returned to (or perhaps never left) Delaware. She married John Lowber

(or Lawler) in Old Swedes' Church, Wilmington, in 1759.

Robert also returned to Delaware. In August, 1764, he sold his grandfather Samuel's grant land of 1685, on behalf of himself and his brothers John and Nicholas, from whom he had powers of attorney. He lists Samuel's issue as four, though he cannot remember his Aunt Anna's name, and Daniel's issue as five: Dorcas, himself, John, Nicholas and Samuel.

On 10 October, 1764, Robert married Deborah Jordan in Old Swedes' Church.

John, who had joined Cane Creek Monthly Meeting in 1763, went back to Wilmington to marry Miriam Craig in 1765. For this the Cane Creek Meeting He did not make an acknowledgement to regain his disowned him in 1767. membership.

Samuel lived on the fringes of the Quaker community. His first wife, Margaret, was received by Cane Creek in 1769, on certificate from New Garden M.M., Pa. His daughter Dorcas (by his second wife Rebecca) joined Cane Creek on


request in 1807 and married into the Wells family.

Elizabeth, last in the list in the Orphan's Court records, apparently died young, since her brother Robert does not list her among Daniel's issue. Family lists claim that she married a Mr. Barry. This is probably a confusion with her mother's marriage to Thomas Berry, since mother and daughter had the same first name.
