BLAIR FAMILY HAD TURNED REPUBLICAN

BY SERGEANT DALZIEL, Civil War Historian

The Blairs were surely a family to be reckoned with in the Republican Party in 1860.

Francis Preston Blair (1791-1876) was born in Virginia, his sons in Kentucky, and now they wielded political power in both Maryland and Missouri.

The head of the clan, long in retirement at Silver Spring, Md., had been a member of Andrew Jackson's famous "Kitchen cabinet" and (through the Washington Globe) the newspaper spokesman for Jackson's administration.



Opposing slavery's extension as an economic drag on the country, the Blairs had turned Republican. Old Francis and his son Montgomery (1813-83) would be Maryland delegates to the 1860 convention. In due time, Montgomery would be Lincoln's postmaster general.

In the Republican delegation from Missouri would be Francis P. Blair Jr., better known as Frank. Arriving at the age of 39, February 19, 1860, Frank had his work cut out for him. Running successfully for Congress, he campaigned far and wide.

Later he would be credited with saving Missouri for the Union.

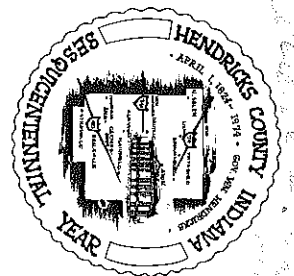

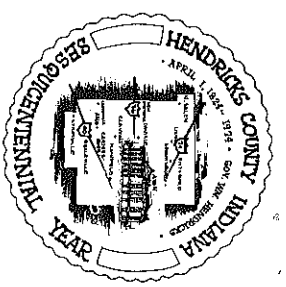

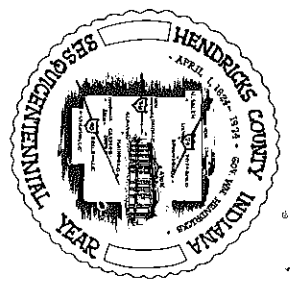
