THE FAMILY MYSTERY

John Humphreys, according to family tradition, was a seaman, and was lost at sea on a voyage to Liverpool, England. He left a young widow with two small children, one of whom was William Blanton Humphreys, grandfather of Willma Humphreys Newton, who compiled this information.

About age 7, William B. was bound (apprenticed) to a man named Kelly. Kelly was not good to William B., and he ran away. He was later bound to a man named Carlisle who treated him as an own son, taught him the blacksmith trade, and gave him a suit of clothing and a sum in gold at the end of the apprenticeship. William B. at one time was in Mooresville, but later made his way to Belville where he set up a blacksmith shop, married and three of his seven children were born.

Where he was apprenticed is not known.

The obituary of Wm. B. Humphreys refers to his "sisters".

The 1840 Census of John Blanton Page 34 Morgan Co.:

Tradition has it that Malinda Humphreys had 3 daughters "Allie", "Lanie" and "Belle" "Allie could be Alice Humphreys, married Hughey Asher, March 25, 1875.

Belle could be Frances B. (Belle?) Patrum, married Wm. L. Moore, May 16, 1888.

"Lanie" could be Delana Patrum married Abner J. Russell, October 5, 1882
"Jane shown in 1870 Census is evidently an error on the part of the census taker who mistook "Jane" for "Delane"

Melinda changes her age from census to census making her born sometime between 1830-35.

FAMILY MYSTERY -2.

When my grandfather was between 7 and 8 years old something tragic happened in his life. According to my father (and the older members of my family who remembered my grandfather) that is when he ran away from home. All he had was the clothes on his back, and he always said he never remembered seeing his father's face. Was this when Melinda was born? Was he brought back and apprenticed to Carlisle. Did he run away from home and return to his grandfather's roof. Was he a boy of 15 in the 1840 census. Or did John Blanton bring his daughter Margaret to Indiana as a young widow, and did she leave William B. in Kentucky. Apparently Melinda was a posthumous child.

Until I can find the apprenticeships on William B. I am stuck. I have had professionals working on this and have advertised in Indiana publications as well as national publications, but have found nothing.

There could have been children between William B. and Melinda. Or if John was at sea, maybe there were but the two.

The Humphreys family Bible, which refers to William Blanton Humphreys, son of John and Margaret Humphreys is in possession of the Humphreys heirs, at "Sunnymeade", the Humphreys family home, Jennings, Louisiana.

NOTE: The name Humphreys is spelled Humphrey" Umphrey" Umfrey" "Umphris" in the records.

Gentlemen:

At long last I am enclosing applications for four descendents of John Blanton, 1780/90 who died in Hendricks County Oct/Nov. 1844, together with supporting Family Group Sheets.

We also descend from William E. and Martha Chipman Carter who lived there 1838-1858; and William B. and Jane Carter Humphreys who lived at Belville about the same time

It was originally my intention to get one of these certificates for myself, but my only brother died very suddenly a month ago today, and I had to go to Oklahoma for his burial and to help his widow with the necessary business incidental thereto. This is one reason for my being so late in getting this off.

I found that my brother's children were very devoted to family history, and since they knew so little about it, enjoyed hearing the many many things I had to tell them. I have many of our lines back into the 1500's. So I decided to get certificates for my two great-nephews and my great-great niece. So I had to send family group sheets my nephew and the two neices for revision, (they went to California, Virginia and Arizona) and wait to get them back. I havent heard from my nephew with his family dates etc. He travels by plane about 250,000 miles yearly often into foreign Two weeks ago he was in Mexico City. His son CRAIG ALLEN HUMPHREYS is the White Hope of our branch of the Humphreys family, as we are depending on him to carry on the family name. And I certainly want a certificate for him, even though I dont have his birth date. But I trust I have given enough information. None of the children sent me any marriage dates. They dont think of me as their venerable auntie, great aunt etc. They think I am just their age, and that is flattering.

I am also tugging away on John Blanton. I have heard my grandmother tell all this stuff by the hour. Since I have been compiling this particular family group, it has occurred to me to attempt Morgan County again for my grandfather's apprenticeship papers. Unfortunately, I havent been able to contact a researcher who can go into the records there. Everything I have had done has been from film or whatever is in the library in Indianapolis.

I know that your celebration has been very successful.

I am enclosing my check for \$8.00 to cover the cost of these four certificates.

Dear Mrs. Cox:

I found your nice long letter when I got in from Little Rock Sunday, whence I had been for the week end in the interests of the Arkansas Genealogical Society, and a Seminar on Local History.

Thank you so very much for all your good work and the information contained therein.

We do learn several things from all that, which may give me a clue to work back on. Two of the children, ~~Jane~~ Catharine Murphy and William Blanton were in Estill Co. Ky - had never come to Indiana. I have Thomas Blanton and his family in 1850 Census in in Owen County, ~~Kentucky~~ Indiana, and it seems that his sister Belinda (Melinda?) Sommers (Summers) lived there too. (She was in Hendricks too) and Mary Allison in Morgan.

I had to laugh at that fancy claim of Obed Thomas. I am of the opinion that instead of John Blanton living with Margaret (Peggy), Peg was living with him. That bill runs from January 1841 to October 23, 1944 for taking care of John Blanton. Peggy and Obed Thomas did not marry until May of 1841- so it would seem that Peggy had it to herself for awhile. As you say, Oct. 23 is probably the day he died, since the bill for her tender ministrations seems to cease as of that date. I have worked with estates for about 28 years, both as an abstractor and as a genealogist, and have settled a few myself, and I find that everything, as a ruly will go fairly harmoniously among the children, until one of the in-laws steps in with some of their bright ideas. Professionally, I am an Abstractor; genealogist as a result of my knowledge of records and besides I like it.

I have found for years that in working with estates, if one can find the actual papers, he is in clover. There is usually an affidavit or statement made to the court that John Doe died on such and such a date, that Richard Roe is Administrator, and that the Heirs of (Deceased) are (a list of them) and their addresses. Of course the statement is from an Executor, if there is a will.

I imagine one reason it took so long to settle the estate, all of John's possessions had to be converted to cash, and the heirs were scattered. It seems that there was some dissatisfaction with Charles Reynolds, the Executor, as the lawsuits were brought, and of course that held things up. I notice too that Belinda Summers seems to have died in 1850, before they got the thing settled.

I dont think my grandfather liked Obed Thomas very well, and Allen K. Thomas, son of Obed and Peggy, loved my grandfather very much, and at times called himself "Allen Humphreys" Of course my grandfather was not raised by his own people (he was a bound boy) and he was a gorown man when Peg married Obed. I dont know whether he knew Thomas Black, Peg's 3d husband. Maybe he had gone to Iowa by then. In fact the lady in Indianapolis who did the first research for me came up with this husband. None of those alive at the time had heard of him. (My family, I mean)

As to the reference about 'preparing the papers - certificate and other business to Virginia. I am sure John Blanton came from Virginia originally (But where?)- Pegs Census records said she did. They must have stopped over in Kentucky for a few years, before the final move to Indiana. That must be where Peg met John Humphreys. I am going to try Estill Co. Ky for my frandfathers apprenticeship. I know he went to Indiana as a grown man looking for his mother - or so I have been told.

My father said his mother made references to ~~my~~ Peg "coming to visit them." Apparently my grandparents lived on the Hendricks county side of Mooresville, as their 3 oldest children were born in Hendricks Co. Indiana. William B. Humphreys was a Blacksmith -and they gave their P.O. as Mooresville.

I am going to keep working on John Blanton. My niece is in Alexandria Virginia, and when I visited her last month, I got her interested. And left her what meagre data I had, and she has promised to go to the Library of Congress and the Archives. But I think there were about as many John Blantons as John Smiths.

My sister also became indoctrinated- I took her into the Courthouses with me in Virginia, records back to 1777, and she just had a ball. She had never seen anything like that before, We were looking for her husband's people, the NECESSARYS and Lyons. The found the third marriage of his Grandfather Lyon, all by herself and was so proud.

We went through Alamance, Orange, Randolph and Guilford Cos. Stopped at Guilford College (outside Greensboro) and and went to old New Garden Monthly Meeting burying Grounds. Gad! IT IS ANCIENT. The one place that I most wanted to see was Deep River (not too far out of High Point) and before I left home I tried unsuccessfully to find out anything about it. We made a wrong turn in Guilford College, and behold I saw a sign with an arrow "TO DEEP RIVER CHURCH" We ran into a surveyor and his wife in New Garden, and he gave us directions to Deep River, and we found the old black tombstones- of my great-grandmothers brother, Joel Chipman, and hermother Elizabeth Sanders ~~Stewart~~ Chipman Stewart. The Lord simply intended for me to get there - that's all.

I have folders and folders of Carter Data.

My American Progenitor was Nathaniel Carter of Dublin who came to America about 1732 and married a young lady named Ann McPherson at Old Swedes Church about 1734. He was son Of Nathaniel (or Nicholas - I have toget my notes, the name Nicholas alternated for 3 or four generations) Gentlemen of Carter's Alley (no less) Dublin. Nathaniel was a younger son. His older brother visited him in America, and asked him to return to Dublin, so that the titles to the Crown lands which the Carters enjoyed would not revert to the crown, for lack of a male heir. My Nathaniel was next in line, as the male heirs of the older son had died before they attained majority, but Nathaniel declined.

His son Willlliam (whose wifes name we have never been able to prove) had a son named William E. who married my Martha Chipman, and became= parents of my grandmother Jame Chipman Carter Humphreys. Her parents, were married at this Deep River Church.

I know there were some Sarah Carters, and I have the Hinshaw book of North Caroline Quaker Records, but I'll have to look this up. Was your Sarah a Quaker. (Several of mine including my grandmother got bounced out of the church for not marrying a Quaker, but grandfather joined up, and that squared the deal). I'll have to check on your Sarah.

I will check this out, and let you know. If your Sarah is kin, she is through one of the brothers - I dont think my direct line.

At the moment, I am trying to do two things, thank you for all the interest you have shown in my case, and get the papers back to you, so I can get a certificate for my self, and my grand-nephews, William Joseph Lord III, Craig Alan Humphreys, and my great-great niece Gretchen Wilms Kettenacker (who has had her first birthday since I started this).

I am sorry that I do not have the birthdate for William J. Lord, Jr. I wrote for it three times, and they never did send it. In fact I didnt get some of these recent dates until I got to Alexandria Virginia. ' (they are wonderful)

My "children" all have wonderful education, and a slew of degrees etc, but they cant spell, and their handwriting is fierce. My niece plainly wrote the name of one of her daughters as "Katheen" and then wondered why I didnt make "Kathleen" out of it. There are somany of us that have birthdates so nearly the same - so dont worry that is right. My sister and I the same- our borther 4 days later, his grandson next day- grand-parents and granddaughter same wedding date - June 20 - years apart. If any of this is wrong, its what they gave me.

I am returning my own application - re-don; with the applications for the children. All of this has been up-dated w ith the latest information at hand.

I wonder why ~~Ma~~ Jane Moss wasnt named in the will, or did the woman who copied it for me forget it?

I probably showed more stuff on these family group sheets than necessary, but I thought it might be helpfuxl to someone working on the same material in the future.

I am so grateful that you are going to let us have our certificates on JOHN BLANTON - he is such a challenge. And from the little bit I have been able to learn of him, he seems to have been a man who met his responsibilities to his family. We are proud that he was a Hendricks County Pioner, regardless of the length of his residence.

Enclosed is another form of appreciation for what you have done for me. I hope this is about right - it is what I would charge. (Of course I am not a Professional Professional - I just do it because I like it, and like to help somebody out.)
