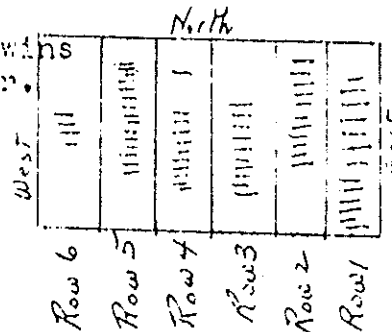

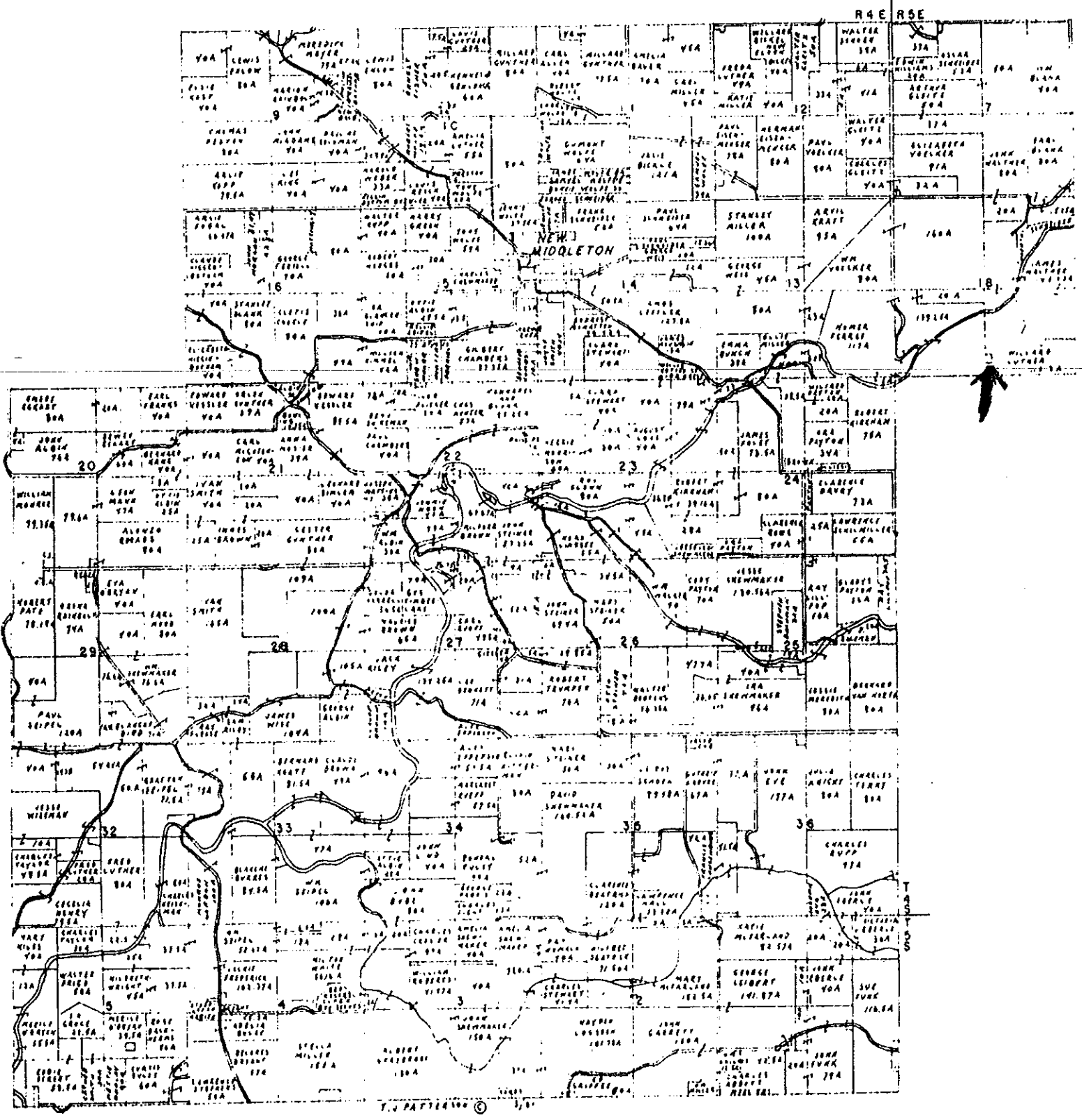

In *Pioneer Footprints Across Woods County*, his name is given as John William Granville Blunk while Myrtle Blunk gives it as John William Grandvill Blunk in her family record book. I assume Myrtle knew her father's name correctly.

John William Grandvill Blunk

The following article was taken from Volume II of the Biographical History of Central Kansas.

This article was submitted by Eva Blunk. It was written around 1901.

John W. Blunk, whose home is in section 27, Elwood Township, Barber County, is a native of the middle west, his birth occurring in Morgan County, Indiana, on the 26th of October, 1850. His father, David Blunk, was born in Owen County, that state, and is still living in Indiana. The latter's father, Aaron Blunk, was one of the first settlers of the Hoosier state and was of German ancestry, the family having been founded in America by two brothers who came from the fatherland at an early period in the development of the United States. Aaron Blunk (John's grandfather) served his country as a soldier in the war of 1812. He married a Miss Davis, sister of Jefferson Davis, the president of the Confederacy. They had a large family, including David Blunk, (John's father) who was reared upon the home farm in Indiana. In Morgan County, Indiana, he was united in marriage to Temperance Hadley, who was born in South Carolina, whence she went to Indiana with her father, George Hadley, who was a native of North Carolina. Unto the parents of our subject (John's father and mother) were born eight children, of whom five are yet living, namely; Mary J., Davie E., John W., Jeremiah and Silvanus. Those deceased are George H., who died from the effects of the hardships of war, having nine years, and Harvey, who died at the age of six years. The parents are still residents of Danville, Indiana. The father was a successful farmer but is now living retired. His political support has been given to the Republican party since its organization. In religious faith he is a Baptist, while his wife is connected with the Society of Friends.

John W. Blunk was reared upon the old homestead in Indiana and began his education in a log schoolhouse. Although his privileges in that direction were somewhat meager, his training at farm work was not limited. In 1875, in Indiana, he married Alice Shake, who has traveled life's journey with him for twenty-six years. She was born in Morgan County, Indiana, and is a daughter of Adam and Martha (Whitaker) Shake, both of whom were natives of Kentucky. Her mother died in Indiana at the age of seventy-three years. Her father is still living at the age of eighty-four. Throughout his business career he [Adam Shake, Ed.] was a farmer. He belongs to the Christian Church and is a Republican in politics. In his family were nine children of whom six are yet living: Ann, Juliet, Mary, George, Levi and Mrs. Blunk. (wife of John W. Blunk). Those deceased are Robert, who died at the age of eighteen; John Henry, who died at the age of eleven years; and Mrs. Lucinda Goss, who passed away at the age of twenty-six.

No events of special importance occurred to vary the routine of farm life for Mr. Blunk in his youth. He arrived in Barber County in 1878, at which time he possessed a team and wagon and five dollars in money; but he had what is better than gold, a strong determination to succeed, supplemented by untiring industry and perseverance. His own labors and the assistance of his wife have won for him a prominent place in agricultural circles and today he is the owner of a valuable farm of over four thousand acres, constituting one of the best properties in the township. There is a good granary and wagon shed, fourteen by thirty-six feet, with ten-foot sheds on each side. He has a large barn fifty-two by sixty feet, and thirty-six feet from the ground to the ridgepole. In his pastures and feed lots are found thirty-seven modern farm implements, wagons, carriages and everything required to carry on farm work along progressive lines.

The home of Mr. and Mrs. John W. Blunk has been blessed with seven children, of whom five are living: Myrtle, Birdie, David Adam, Vera Zella and John Glenn. Those deceased are Maude Derrick, who died at the age of twenty-one years, loved and respected by all, and one who died in early childhood. Mr. Blunk votes with the Republican Party. He has been identified with the state militia, and fraternally is an Odd Fellow. His wife belongs to the Christian Church. Both are well known in the community where they enjoy the warm regard of many friends.

OBITUARIES: NUMBER 1 (of Maud Blunk Derrick)

"Mrs. Maud B. Derrick, wife of William Derrick and daughter of Mr. and Mrs J. W. Blunk, at the home of her parents 20 miles west of Kiowa, Kansas, on Tuesday, February 25th, 1902.

Mrs. Derrick was born in this county on January 11th, 1881. On June 12th, 1901, she was married to William Derrick, and February 25th, 1902, at 8:30 o'clock p. m. she died, at the age of 21 years, 1 month and 15 days, deeply mourned by her husband, parents, relatives and a large number of friends. She was a young woman of many qualities which endeared her to her family and friends. For several weeks she was a sufferer, but she bore up bravely until Death claimed her as a victim. Wm. Derrick has the deepest sympathy of all who know him. His loss is a great one, indeed, and time alone will be able to ameliorate his sorrow and grief.

Funeral was held yesterday. A large cortege followed the hearse from the house of mourning to the Kiowa cemetery, where short but impressive services were conducted by Rev. H. L. Marsh after which the body of Maud B. Derrick was laid to eternal rest.

Misses Martha, Florence and Alice Derrick were prevented to attend the funeral of their dearly loved sister-in-law Mrs. Wm. Derrick yesterday on account of the serious illness of Miss Martha at the home of her parents at Anthony."

NUMBER 2 (of Maud Blunk Derrick)

"Died, It is with more than usual sorrow that we are compelled to record the death of Mrs. Maud B. wife of William A. Derrick and oldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. W. Blunk.

Mrs. Derrick was born January 11, 1881 in Barber county Kansas, was married to William A. Derrick on June 12, 1901, and departed this life Tuesday, February 25, 1902 at 8:30 p. m. aged 21 years 1 month and 15 days.

It is sad to see one die so young with so much of life before them, but Gods will be done, not ours.

Mrs. Derrick had been sick at the home of her parents, 20 miles west of Kiowa, for several weeks, surrounded with the love of a father, mother, husband, brothers and sisters. Everything was done for her that willing hands and loving hearts could do.

The many friends of the family and husband attended the funeral and accompanied them to the Kiowa Riverview cemetery, where a short service was conducted by Rev. H. L. Marsh of the Congregational church.

The sympathy of all is extended to those who are left to mourn the untimely death of the dear departed one.

Martha Derrick Florence and Alice were prevented from attending the funeral by the serious illness of Martha at her home in Anthony.

We were requested to thank all who so faithfully watched over and cared for the deceased during her last illness, and to those who showed deep expressions of sympathy."

Myrtle Blunk Hull

Born August 17, 1882 in Barber County, Kansas. Attended a summer of Normal school at Medicine Lodge, Kansas and received a teaching certificate. Taught school in the Sand Creek school in Barber County, Kansas in 1898 when she was 16 years old. Enrolled in the Northwestern Normal School in Alva, Oklahoma in 1901 before the building was hardly finished. She graduated in June 1904. In 1904 and 1905 taught one term of school at Ingersoll, Oklahoma. In 1906, another two years was added to the original course at Northwestern Normal School. She attended and got a degree (diploma?) in June 1906. She then taught in Alva City Schools for four years. She married Walter Vernon Hull on June 8, 1910. She moved to Woods County, OK in 1914 and then to Hardtner, KS in 1944 after Vern died.
