

BRYANT FAMILY

The JOSIAH BRYANT family listed below (with his family) is the earliest known record of the BRYANT family, that I have. (If Josiah had any brothers or sisters they are unknown to me at this time (July 1, 1960))

From "A portrait and Biographical Record of Boone, Clinton, Hendricks Co. Ind. 1895."

JOSIAH BRYANT came from Ireland and settled in Virginia (date not given) he was born in 17-- and died in 1835 in Hendricks Co. Ind. He was of Irish and English extraction and was married to -----(Mary Woodson)? of German stock.

Some time before 1799 this Bryant family moved to Ky. settling in what is now known as Bryantsville, KY. He was the founder of that town. (I have been unable to verify any of the above, however it does tell something about this Bryant family and perhaps the above information is correct. (Agness Bryant)

Josiah is supposed to have come to Indiana as one of the earliest Pioneers and his grandson Silas J. Bryant (son of John W. Bryant) born March 18, 1820-was the first white child born in Hendricks Co. Ind.

WILLIAM BENNETT BRYANT'S lived all of their lives in Ind. except six years in
Missouri and four years in Iowa. They lived on the farm of Bennett's father
(Anderson Bryant) until the house burned and Bennett built a new house. They
later moved to Danville, Ind. (the county seat of Hendricks Co. Ind.) when Bennett
Bryant was elected Sheriff of this county. Bennett Bryant was in the Civil War.
Two of his brothers (James and Woodson) and fifteen cousins also served.

Bennett and Cassandra Bryant are buried at Minburn, Iowa.

Cassandra Bohannon father was Abraham Bohannon married Polly Pearson(a Quaker) who later became a Baptist as Abraham was.

The above information concerning Bennett and Cassandra Bryant was sent to me from Mrs. Rose Bryant-Gottschalk--dau. of Bennett and Cassandra Bryant--Rose lived most of her married life at Minburn, Iowa--but is now making her home with her dau. Helen Smith, of Iowa City, Iowa.(1961)

from records of Hendricks Circuit Court-Danville, Ind. there is a record of a ANDERSON BRYANT and SALLY OSBORNE married in 1833.

SARAH ANN OSBORNE wife of ANDERSON BRYANT--came from a family who owned slaves in K y. Crab Orchard, Rockcastle Co. Ky. (she was born at Mount Vernon, Ky.) They came there from the Carolina's. The OSBORNES were tall in stature and was thought to be of the family of OSBORNES in England, who owned large plantations in Carolina. She was one of a twin(I've been unable to find out if Sarah Ann twin lived or if she had any other brothers or sisters)(A,B.). She was nursed by a neg ro mammy and her father gave her a neg ro servant named 'Sukey'.(believe this servant was given to Sarah Ann as a wedding present, but was probably sold in Ky. (A.B.)--Her daughter(Aunt Mollie Hays) said'there never was any thing quite good enough for her mother and of her father that any thing was good enough for him.'

The ANDERSON BRYANT'S settled at Springtown, Ind.--Anderson helped to build the first road between Plainfield and Styleville, Ind. which is now State Road # 40 and from coast to coast. He made enough money to buy a farm near Coatesville, Ind. There they lived and reared their family of eight children. This Springtown farm had a spring and flowing well on it. Aunt Mollie said 'she remembered when as a girl they used to take their clothes to the spring to wash and in that early day there was much underbrush and thick growth--also plenty of snakes and whenever a snake came into view they would 'slither him with' billin' water from their gourds'. Aunt Mollie states 'my daddy took the Cincinnati Gazette' and later the Indianapolis Journal'. The Bryant's were Republicans and Primitive Baptists.

The first home in Ind. was in Hendricks Co. towns of Almo and Hadley (near the old Springs Meeting House(Quaker)--the house is gone but a cemetery remains.

Woodson was in the 27th. Inf. with Grant and was confined in the Andersonville Prison. When the Civil War broke out they sent three sons to service-- James--Woodson and Bennett(than just 16 yrs.old.)(he lied about his age) and served two yrs.. Aunt Mollie states'I believe Bennett was in the 122nd. and Jim(James) was with Sherman on the 'March to the Sea'. Soldiers would come walking past our place and father would send them on horseback a piece to relieve them. We were at Coatesville, Ind. when a big crowd had gathered and they were calling for volunteers and when mother heard that Bennett had enlisted 'I tho. she would faint, she cried and cried!'-Members of the 'Golden Circle'(democrats) came to the top of our hill and shouted abuses at my father and said he wanted his dau. to marry Negros'.

Almost all of the above information has been taken from the interview by Mrs. Marion Greelee-Jefferies of her great Aunt Mollie Bryant.

Anderson and Sarah Bryant are buried in the cemetery at Stilesville, Ind.

Mrs. Lizzie O'Neal-Nelson--Plainfield, Wisconsin wrote me the following concerning her parents(July 13,1960)

My mother was born Dec. 1, 1876 in Sullivan County, Missouri--as it was the Centennial year of America Independence, that accounts for her unusual middle name of Centennial.

I was 9 yrs. old when the O'Neal family moved to Iowa, probably early in 1907 in 1910 we moved to South Dakota (Beadle County).

Ida and William O'Neal are buried in Wessington Cemetery near the town of that name in Hand County, South Dakota.

She writes 'Mama' always said that they (Bryant's) had been in this country so many generations that she had no idea where they emigrated from. She often spoke of having a Quaker grandmother.

Mrs. Nelson writes--'Years ago I learned the Bryant's is considered an Irish name and that all Bryant's are des. of BRIAN BORU. There may be a lot of imagination in that O'NEALS also are supposed to be des. from the great BRIAN having received their name from his son Neal.

They came to Hendricks Co Indiana in 1819 and settled
in Plainfield among the Indians. His son Silas was born in 1819
in June of 1864 - he cleared up 7 farms. The last one
being one and one half miles east of Stilesville and
comprising of 400 acres.

(John was elected J.p. in 1845
and again in 1847)

in his early days, he was a soldier under Jackson in the War of 1812, and was at the Battle of New Orleans. John W. Bryant died age 66. He had 3 sons in the Civil War. John Burton born Ind. 1830 Wigs Co. Daniel P. born 1836 and see subject Richard Bennett Bryant.

RICHARD BENNETT BRYANT was born OCT 16 1835 in Clay Twp. one mile east of Amo. He enlisted at Gosport, Owen County Ind. Nov 1, 1861 in Co. B. 59th Regt. Ind Inf't. as a private and served 13 months. He was married Oct 20

1863

to Abigail Newman, daughter of John + Mary (Blair) Newman. Mr. Newman was one of the pioneers of the County from North Carolina. Richard settled at Stilesville and engaged in the drug business for 3 years, then came to Coatsville in 1874 and engaged in the drug business for 15 years. and is now retired. He was very successful and now owns a farm of one hundred acres.

Mr + Mrs. Bryant have 7 children — GREENY W - MARY - HENRY, ROBERT, ROSE, LAURA and CHARA BRYANT.

from a letter to miss AGNESS BRYANT in Ithaca N.Y. during the year 1959.

Richard Bennett Bryant had brothers - Cyrus - Elias Daniel who drank and their father (John W. Bryant) would have nothing to do with them. Mr. - living in Coatsville Ind - would drive to Stilesville 5 miles - horse and buggy to visit with them.

Father (Richard Bennett Bryant) inherited a walled mill in Stilesville and a pillard house which still stands


Joel B. Garrison attended the common schools, near Stilesville, Indiana, for only a short time. When he was eighteen years of age he enlisted in Company B, Fifty-ninth Regiment Indiana Volunteer Infantry, and served from February 25, 1864, to July 7, 1865. He then returned to his home and engaged in the blacksmithing trade, which he followed for about thirty-five years. He then purchased a farm and since that time has devoted himself to agricultural pursuits.

Mr. Garrison was married January 19, 1869, to Amanda Bryant, the daughter of Silas and Matilda (McCormack) Bryant, and to this union were born four children: Flora Alice, who married Elmer Fuson, and has two children, Winifred and Wendall; Rossie became the wife of Osro Hader and has one child, Ethelyn; Don A., who married Bernice Owen and has one child, Helen Lucile; Elsie, who married O. Harper.

Mrs. Garrison's parents had a family of nine children: Lucy, the wife of Martin Sims; John married Ruth Sharp; Amanda, wife of Mr. Garrison; Nancy, wife of Mr. Balldock; Clementine, deceased; William, who married Helen Stingler; Anderson, deceased; Albert, and Woodford, who married Mary Clark. Mrs. Garrison's father had the distinction of being the first white child born in Hendricks county. His death occurred in 1899 and his wife died in 1913.

Joel Garrison, the grandfather of the subject of this sketch, was a soldier in the Revolutionary War. Jeremiah Garrison, the father of Joel B., died June 5, 1857, his wife having died ten years previously, October 15, 1847.

Mr. Garrison has been a life-long member of the Republican party although he has never had any political office. He is a member of the Free and Accepted Masons and holds his membership in the Baptist church of Stilesville. During his long and busy life in this community he has so conducted himself as to win the sincere respect and esteem of all who know him.

Josiah Bryant's family along with births and death
Josiah Bryant came from Ireland and settled in
Virginia, was born in 17---? and died in 1835 in
Hendricks County, Indiana. He was of Irish and
English extraction and was married to Mary Woodson
of German stock.

Sometime before 1799 this Bryant family moved
from Virginia to Kentucky, settling in what is now
known as Bryantville Kentucky, then on to Indiana
about 1820. They had six children - William, John
Silas, Anderson, Woodson and Patience.

He came to Indiana as one of the earliest pioneers.
The first home in Indiana was in Hendricks
County towns of Cane and Hadley (near the old
Spring Meeting House (Quaker) the Bryants were
Republican and Primitive Baptists.

His grandson Silas J. Bryant, born March 18, 1822
was the first white child born in Guilford Township
Hendricks County, Indiana.

as Sheriff of Hendricks County. 1886-1888

He was married three times -

died, May 22, 1941 - married - one - stepdaughter.

Second wife - Emma (Fawles) Bryant - born 1858
died May, 22, 1886 at Joppha, Indiana.

Emma being my own Grandmother - my mother
(Grace Bryant) Woodson & Emma's daughter.

They had three children - Paul, born Mar. 24, 1877
died Aug 6, 1950, in Lead, South Dakota.

He was married twice - no children. He was my Uncle
I remember seeing him one time.

The records of Department of the Army show that
Paul Bryant, enlisted on November 29, 1897 at Indianap-
olis, Indiana, and served as a private in Troop L,
6th United States Cavalry, until discharged on November
28, 1900. He re-enlisted on November 29, 1900 at Pekin,
China, and served as a private and sergeant in the
same organization until discharged on November
28, 1903 at Fort Keogh, Montana. He re-enlisted on
February 23, 1904 at Indianapolis, Indiana and
served as a sergeant in Troop I, 4th United States
Cavalry, until discharged on June, 30, 1905, at the
Presidio of San Francisco, California.

He again re-enlisted at the Presidio and served
the same organization until discharged as a sergeant
on June 1, 1908, at Fort Meade, South Dakota.

Grace E. (Bryant) Haydon - born July 4, 1860 died Oct 3
1932.
