PREFACE

This compilation of data regarding the descendents of McCARTY BURCHAM, a pioneer of Indiana, is not considered complete. It is accurate to the best of my knowledge, and it does show the outline of the various families of earlier days.

If current descendents have further data to add, I would appreciate receiving such extra genealogical information.

I am indebted to Hazel Stewart, a great-grand-daughter of McCarty Burcham, for much of the enclosed information. She, and Blanche Burcham Simenson, seem to be the two descendents of the sons of McCarty who pioneered in Nebraska who are most interested in this research. McCarty Burcham, with his wife Elizabeth and daughter, Amanda, arrived in Indiana either 1828 or 1829 and settled about 2½ miles south of Plainfield. Registers of voters for 1831 show him as voting in local elections.

McCarty's origin has not been proved decisively; he claimed to have been born in Surry County, No. Car. 10 Feb. 1807. There were Burchams in that county, but records have not been located to prove parentage. Also he states that he was married in <sup>Tennessee</sup> ~~North Carolina~~, and Amanda was born there in 1826. Records of the marriage and birth of the daughter have not been located.

McCarty, also known as Carter sometimes, with his wife Elizabeth, added eleven more children to their family, making a total of four daughters and eight sons. Pages 2 and 3 are a family group sheet of McCarty's family.

Elizabeth Owen stated that she was born 6 July, 1805 in Tennessee and that her parents were born in the colonies and not in a foreign country. Knowledge of her ancestry would be helpful, but records have not been located as yet. Elizabeth died 28 Dec. 1869, ten years before her husband's death, and she was buried in Sugar Grove Cemetery where two of her children had graves.

Page 4 is a family group for Amanda Burcham and her husband Joseph D. Hollingsworth. Tracing of their 8 children has not been done.

Two children died suddenly within a week of each other in 1842. Robert, aged 7, and Mary, age 2, have graves in Sugar Grove Cemetery. The 1850 census lists two more children with the same names: Robert age 6 (born 1844) and Mary, aged 1, (born 1849). There is no further mention of two such children in any records. Would it be possible that an error exists in the census? Could the mother have reported data from sad memories which was misunderstood and listed as current?

Sons, John, James, Frank, and Henry moved to Nebraska after the Civil War. It is known that Henry and Frank have Civil War veteran status, and it is presumed that the others also served in the Union Armies. See page 9.

JAMES BURCHAM born in Hendricks County on 16 Oct, 1836, married to Lydia Ann Faucett in Danville, Indiana on Sept. 13, 1857, homesteaded in Nebraska between 1865 and 1867. As a veteran of the Civil War he was entitled to generous land grants in the newly planned Lancaster County south of Lincoln, Nebraska. Four of their ten children were born in Indiana and the other six in Nebraska. Four of their children died at early ages, but the remaining five daughters and one son married and had children.

James was an excellent carpenter and left farming for construction work. The family moved to Seattle after about 30 years on the farm, and numerous buildings constructed by James Burcham are still standing as early monuments to his ability.

-----

FRANKLIN J. BURCHAM, born in Hendricks County Aug. 1, 1838, married to Fanny Thomas Mar 7, 1872 in Hendricks County, migrated to Nebraska in the early 1870s. Frank was a Civil War veteran, a Mason, and a willing farmer. This couple raised five of their seven children on the farm near Hickman, Nebraska. Two died in infancy.

One son and four daughters were married in their home county, lived on their farms or in Lincoln. Graves are found in Roca Cemetery, Hickman, Cemetery, and Lincoln Memorial Cemetery for these people.

-----

Henry S. Burcham, born in 1843, enlisted in the Union Army early in 1861, served thru several of the famous battles of the war, was discharged in 1867 and promptly married Hanna S. Miller in Hendricks Co. The couple farmed for a few years near Champaign, Ill where two of their children were born, then moved west to Lancaster Co. Nebraska, to farm, with Henry's brothers. Two children died in their early years, but two other sons and three daughters grew up in South Precinct Pass, on an excellent farm. One son's family still has descendents near Firth, Nebraska while the families of other children are scattered thruout the states.

-----

The above three families are considered more of Nebraska people than those remaining in Hendricks County.

TWO men with the same name, JOHN BURCHAM, lived respectively in Surry County, No.Car. and in Frederick County, Virginia. The one in Surry County can be traced back thru several generations to an emigrant from England.

John Burcham of Surry County had several sons: a grandson named Joseph emigrated about 1818 to Greene County, Indiana with five children. Their descendents raised families in that county and made Greene County history.

A daughter, Mary Burcham, married a John Hiatt in Surry County. They eventually moved to Ohio and Indiana along the Ohio River. The Hiatt history has been well traced by a noted genealogist Wm. Perry Johnson of Raleigh, No.Car.

Another son, Reuben, was disowned by the Quaker group in 1903 in Surry County for marrying out of unity. Our main records were the reports of monthly meetings, and being disowned meant not being again mentioned in the records. He was re-instated in 1818 but there is a 15 year blank. The 1810 census of Surry County shows that he had two sons; and the 1820 census indicates these boys became men and left. (McCarty Burcham could have been one of these males, but we have found no proof of it.)

Reuben moved to Indiana, Morgan County, about 1828/9, as he is listed in the 1830 census with a wife and three daughters. Just who these females are is uncertain. He remarried in 1836 to a Ruth Davis, who came from Surry County and may have been a sister to the Ballards there.

Thus, three counties received Burchams from Surry County.

The John Burcham of Frederick County, Virginia, had at least two sons, Samuel and John. Samuel emigrated to Jackson County, Indiana, and John settled in Washington County. The genealogy of Samuel Burcham has been listed in Books by Dr. C. Tucker and Helen P. Folk.

The 1820 census of Switzerland County, Indiana, shows a Daniel Burcham. Where he came from is unknown. He may be the ancestor of several Burchams in Bismarck, No.Dak. and Stevensville, Montana, and in Washington state.

There are numerous lines of Burchams. I have interviewed one man named Louis Birchem, whose grandfather emigrated here from Switzerland, settled near Hankinson, No. Dak., and has children and grandchildren widely scattered.

The untangling of the sources of Burchams located provides numerous angles, all being done with one main question:

WHO WAS McCARTY'S FATHER ?

Now, I have a copy of all the Guilford/Twp elections from the beginning to 1850, and there are Burcham names included in these. If you want to check them, sometime, and let your know who and when. I rather suspect this information is superfluous for your purposes.

I trust your other efforts to pinpoint your Burcham redhunts are proving more rewarding. In due time - perhaps it will be some years - I shall read through the extant copies of the Danville papers from the 1840's on and it may be that there I shall find the Burcham name. And of course if I should come across any of the early Sugar Grove records they should tell us something. Another source might be the Indiana Yearly Meeting minutes prior to the setting up of Western Yearly Meeting in 1858. (That is something I should look into for our Historical Collection... had I thought of it before!)

This opportunity I have of assembling the historical records for Town Township is most challenging. The facets are many and varied.

Margaret Smith and I also visited Mr. Albert Maxwell, who had the Sugar Grove Cemetery records. He showed them to us and I recorded the following information:

We weren't able to find the 3 children listed. These were the stones that we found covered over with sod. We uncovered them and made rubbings and discovered the inscriptions listed above. All were close to the stone of Elizabeth. I believe Margaret Smith has photos of the gravestones. Her husband, Richard, is one of McCarty's descendents.

Another of McCarty's descendents sent me the following information:

"My cousin, Clinton Danielson visited Indiana. He went out to Sugar Grove Cemetery and recorded the following: Sugar Grove Cemetery, 27 rows south & 28 rows north. South half 5th row, pge 9 of record: Grave #34 Robert Burcham 5 yrs of age, son of McCarty and E. Aug 7, 1842. Grave #35 Mary Burcham 2 yrs of age, dau of McCarty and E. Aug. 7, 1842. Grave #36 Mary E. Burcham daughter of F.J. and Fannie, b. Feb. 7, 1873 died 20,2, 1875 McCarty Child, no name or data. Ruth Burcham, wife of Reuben Burcham d-2,15,1873. Age 74-10-9 South half 7th row grave #23 Burcham, no data Grave #24 Levi Burcham Grave #27 McCarty Burcham b-Feb. 10-1807, d-Sept. 21-1879 Mr. Danielson made a reference to Book #G PF 977.201 H498 #10 (3), Indiana State Library.

He was a Quaker. His father and mother were Quakers. Reuben was expelled from them for marriage out of unity, July 23. 1803 at Westfield Monthly Meeting in Surry Co. No. Car. His application for re-entry in Aug. 1818 but he was turned down. His name appeared in 1820. 1830 and 1850 U.S. Census lists In 1820 Surry Co - 1830 and 1850 in Indiana.
