emigrated to Chester county, in Pennsylvania, in the year 1632, the same year that William Penn and his company arrived in the ship "Welcome". Before leaving England he bough of Penn two hundred and fifty acres of land, which was located in Aston township, now in Delaware county, and settled there. He was a carpenter by trade, and probably a farmer also. He appears to have been a prominent citizen, active in public affairs, for his name is often mentioned in the early Provincial records. In 1686 he was made constable, and in 1688 was chosen a member of the Provincial Assembly.

Edward Carter was a member of the Society of Friends, and took an active and prominent part in its affairs, in both the "meetings at Chester and at Chichester, near which the latter meeting he lived. He was one of the trustees appointed to have charge of the property given by Jurian Keen "to the people of God called Quakers," and on which the first meeting-house at Chester was built. For some time the meeting for worship was evidently held at his house, for in the records, under date of Seventh month (September) 23rd, 1703, appears the entry, "The meeting formerly ordered to be at Edward Carter's the last 5th day of every month is now moved to Chichester Meeting-nouse."

Edward Carter's wife was named Margaret. They had one son,
Robert Carter, who married Lydia Walley.

Edward Carter no doubt died soon after May 12th, 1703, for his name appears on the meeting records of that date, and not afterward.

Robert Carter, only son and heir of Edward ann Margaret Carter, was born about 1665, in England, and came to America with his parents in 1682. He lived in Aston township, now a part of Delaware county, where he owned 375 acres of land, most of which was probably inherited from his father. In 1722 he was living in Marlborough township, and later in Kennett. In 1698 and later he was a member of the Provincial Assembly of Penn sylvania.

Robert Carter married in 1688, Lydia Walley, and has six children. Children of Robert and Lydia (Walley) Carter: Prudence, born 1689, married 1712, Caleb Pusey, Jr.
