The Arabic numerals nearest the left-hand margin simply indicate the number of the male members that are discussed in the family line. The small Roman numerals show the number of children each male member had, while the small Arabic numeral between the first Roman numeral and the first name of each group of children indicates the generation of that group.

An Arabic numeral to the left of a Roman numeral (always indicating a male member) shows that this man will be taken up for discussion later under that same Arabic numeral.

The Arabic numeral between the christian and surname also indicates the generation of that member of the family, while the name of each male ancestor together with the number under which he is discussed is placed in parenthesis at the right of the name then under discussion.

Whatever is to be said about the women in the family line must be done each in her own order when they are mentioned under the heading: 'children' as their descendants rightfully come under their father's family head.

I had a hard time with the rebels and gurilers. I was radical from the top of my head to the bottom of my feet that was the reason the rebels were so hard on me that kept me on the scout for months and years I lived in the middle of rebeldom.

I am for the right of sufferage. I am in hopes that I will live to see the white ladies have the reght of suffrage too.

Thiss leaves us all well.
