101.6.3.ELIZABETH DAVIS was the third child of Nathan Davis (101.6) and his first wife, Nancy Kidd Davis. Elizabeth was born in Montgomery County, Kentucky on January 19, 1822. She married JOHN FLEECE, son of Charles Fleece on April 16, 1840 in Hendricks County, Indiana. She spent most of her life here, her parents having moved from Kentucky in 1835, when she was thirteen years of age. Elizabeth was a fine Christian woman and led an exemplary life. For a few years after their marriage Elizabeth and John Fleece lived at Ladoga, Indiana.

Eight children were born to this union, the oldest child and only son, dying in infancy. The names of these eight children were: Jeremiah, Mary Ann, (Molly), Harriet Catherine, Louisa Jane (Jennie) Sarah Christena (Sally), Cornelia (Neelie), Joanna. (Joda) and Lillie.

ELIZABETH DAVIS (101.6.3) wife of John Fleece, died August 11, 1874. JOHN FLEECE died February 12, 1884.
