She was born Abt. 1782 in PA Scotch Irish who came from Ireland<sup>2</sup>, and died 09 Feb 1863 in Hendricks Co., IN<sup>3</sup>.

James Downard was a Judge in Hendrick Co., IN. James came to the Northwest around 1811, migrating to Kentucky and then Indiana.

From History of Hendricks Co., Indiana 1885 - Center Twp. found on the internet and submitted by Tracy Turek a biographical sketch of Robert R. Downard we learned that James Downard was a native of Ohio and from there went to Kentucky, where he was married. His wife was a native of KY.

After his marriage James and Elizabeth Curry Downard lived in OH for eleven years and in February 1823 migrated to Hendricks County and located in Guilford Township. He was an energetic businessman, and was possessed of considerable means. He entered 900 acres of Government land in different parts of the county, a part of the town site of Danville covering one of his land entries. He donated twenty acres of land for county buildings on which the court house now stands. Mr. Downard (James) was in early days County Judge. His first home was in Guilford Twp., and is now owned and occupied by the State Reform School. He reared a large family to maturity.

Adam Downard came to Indiana when about three years old by his parents James and Elizabeth Curry Downard. They located on a farm in Guilford Township on which the Reform School building at Plainfield is now situated, and where he lived until he was twenty-two years of age. In 1843 Adam settled on a farm in Center Township where he farmed till 1850 when he moved to Marion Township. In 1860 he returned to Center Township where he lived on a farm two miles west of Danville till 1869 when he gave up farming and became a resident of Danville, IN.

Mrs. Downard lost her parents, Thomas and Nancy Emmerson Bereman, before she was twelve years of age. She came to Hendricks Co., IN in 1835 to live with her brother, Jesse Bereman.

Both Adam and Mildred were member of the Christian Church since 1842 and he held office of Trustee for eight years.

Jonathan Russell was a farmer. In the Civil War he served in Co. I 150th Regt. Indiana Vol. Inf. He was discharged August 5, 1865 and his Pension No. 490-465. He was a member of GAR.

His Civil War Pension papers has his name as Jonathan N. Russell. Certificate No. 921990. They also state that Jonathan Russell enrolled on the 21st day of February, 1865 at LaFayette for one year. He was mustered with Co. August 5, 1865 at Stevensen Station, VA a corporal. A copy of the pension records is on file with Mary K. and David P. George.

The death certificate for Jonathan N. Russell has his name as "Johnathan N. Russell" and can be found in his Civil War Pension Records and the Indiana State Board of Health. John N. Russell is the name used in the obituary in the Kirklin Press and the Frankfort Times which may be found at the Frankfort Community Public Library, Frankfort, IN.

Jonathan Russell had been out to check on the farm from his home in Kirklin and when returning he fell asleep, the horse was spooked by the train and the horse, buggy, and Jonathan was hit and killed by the passenger train.

Jonathan N. Russell is also on the marriage application and marriage license.

Jonathan N. Russell's farm was 3 miles northwest of Kirklin and on Rural Route 1 per Joan Bohm June 2003.

In the 1905 Frankfort City Directory and Clinton County Gazetteer Jonathan N. Russell owned 154 1/2 acres.

Jonathan and Harriet A. Huffine Russell's residence in Kirklin, IN was on the SE corner of North Mail Street (507 Main Street, Kirklin, IN) and E. Washington Street. This is where they lived when Jonathan and his buggy was hit by a train crossing the railroad track on his

way home from the farm. Probably lots 54, 55, & 56 Block #1, Original Plat Town of Kirklin.

The farm is located by current day address at 5278 State Road 38 east going into Kirklin from Antoich, IN. The first house set right behind the brick house that is present there (June 2005). Jonathan Russell built that house in 1910. This is also where Fred and Beulah Maish Russell and their son Fred, Jr. lived after Fred, Sr. purchased all of the land except 40 acres from all the Russell heirs. Fern Russell Hendryx retained the 40 acres she received from her parents.

Another home for Jonathan and Harriet Huffine Russell was a home just east of Oak Hill Cemetery on a hill. Today November 2003 there is a home there but much newer.

Railroad for a period of six years.
