Dear Rev. Duncan:

In reply to your inquiry of June 15, 1985 please be advised that I made another search for early Fawcetts, etc. in Ohio.

I made a check of an index of early tax payers in Ohio and there were a number with the Fawcett name and variations of the name but all of them were in this eastern part of Ohio and most I could identify as coming from the Virginia Fawcetts.

In a listing of early land purchases made through the Cincinnati Land Office I found John Fossett purchased on Dec. 31, 1801, 198 acres in Sec. 28, T. 3, R. 4 in Hamilton Co., Ohio. I could not find where this was as I have a map which shows Sections in Hamilton Co. but not Townships and Ranges.

I also found an Elias Fassett listed as an early settler in Lucas Co. but that County was not founded until 1835 and is around Lake Erie so would not be your family.

The one buying land in Cincinnati seems to be the best bet. I hope that this will help you in some way.

Warren Co Ohio Deed BK 4

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JAMES MADISON president of the United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come Greetings. Weege, that John Foffett of Hamilton County, Ohio, having deposited in the Treasury a Certificate of the Register of the Land office at Cincinnati whereby it appears that he has made full payment for two hundred and four acres and 70<sup>o</sup> of an acre of land on the South West corner of lot or Section number Twenty-Eight, to Number hundred poles from East to West and one hundred and one hundred rods from North to South of Township number three in the fourth Range of the land lying between the Great Miami River and the Virginia Reservation sold under the direction of the Register of the Land office at Cincinnati by virtue of the Right of pre-emption granted by law to certain persons who have contracted with John Cleves Symmes or his associates. There is Granted by the United States in pursuance of the act of Congress in that case provided unto the Said John Foffett the Tract of land above described. To have and to hold the Said Tract of land with the appurtenances unto the said John Foffett his heirs and assigns forever. I Testimony whereof I have caused these letters to be made patent and the Seal of the United States to be affixed —
