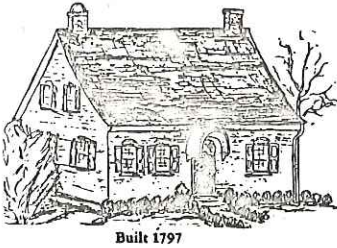

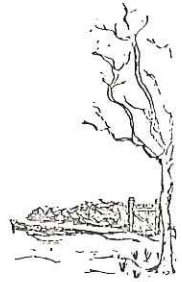

Sarah E. Fultz married Henry House, eleven children, seven girls, four boys: Daniel, Anna, Jennie, Charlott, Dora, Douglas, John, Otto, Kate, Ethel, one dead.

Dear Ruth,

So glad to hear from you again. I didn't realize I had sent you a check before. Been too busy. I had another letter from DAR in Washington D.C. and they don't think all my efforts are enough to be accepted in to the DAR society. I haven't shown that Jacob showed unfailing loyalty to the cause of the American Revolution. He was only about 15 years old according to the diaries, and his mother ran out and said "don't take my boy, he is so young" when the militia just rode in to take him away. They did take him away and it didn't say how long it was before they brought him back. I think I was a Johann Jacob Foltz, (Volz, Fultz) in a DAR book somewhere, but at the time I didn't know his first name was Johann. According to Moravian archives it lists his birth as 1753 but the stone varies about 3 years. But records were not kept so well then and probably when stones were erected, records weren't checked to see if the date was exact or not.

Anyway, I got to thinking that perhaps a signed statement by Ivella West, gr, gr, granddaughter of Johann Jacob Fultz, saying that her grandfather, Elihu wrote a lot of information down about his ancestry and it stated that Jacob was in the Revolutionary War and that he placed the family in E. C. at the time of the war in the right county, etc. I asked her once where the original copy was that was written by Elihu and she told me her sister had it and she didn't know where it was or what happened to it. It would really be better to have a copy made from and have witnesses and be notarized. But if I can't get that, looks like a copy saying Jacob came from Penn. to N.C. with his parents, that they resided in the _____ community, that Jacob was in the war, that his son, Andrew (Andreas) moved to Indiana and that's where Andrew started the Salem church in 1829. If you can get a chance could you talk to Ivella about this. She isn't in very good health and I tried to call her but couldn't reach her. It's urgent that I get as much proof as I can before the deadline is up. The way her Fultz history starts out is in error. It says that Jacob was born in Holland and came to Penn. and later came to N.C. Jacob was born in Heidleberg, Pa. according to Moravian Archives records and his father, Peter came over from Port in Holland, but wasn't from there. He was from Lower Alsace (Germany?) This was quite common then. You had to go to the port that took you where you wanted to go. I saw a ships' passenger list with his name listed and almost bought the book at the Illinois State Genealogical meeting. I am writing Winston-Salem again to see if any Moravians have ever been accepted in to DAR Society. The New Chapter here had a deadline on being a charter member and it looks like I'll have to fight all the way. Even though I sent 20 pages, of zeroxed pages from Moravians in E.C. about the people building a place for the soldiers to stay in one of the towns, feeding the soldiers, quartering the horses, tending the sick and preparing bandages for the wounded. This must qualify as aid to the soldiers. If you live in a wartime zone you are involved one way or not. I am going to see if Faleigh has a copy of goods furnished to the troops. Seems like there is a book on it that I read about but that remains to be seen and if I could get a copy of anything linking Jacob directly with aid to soldiers. They said that ^{they} would like something listing his first name and last name with aiding the soldiers or serving in the military. I wish that I could say that he was a Capt. or something. Would be so much easier. Do you have any suggestions? I was told that in fall of 1977 it was made a lot harder to get into. If you could get a statement from Ivella and witnessed and notarized, I would be glad to pay you.

I also need a list of her brothers and sisters, their birth, marriage dates, death dates, Where buried, their children's names and the grandchildren and great grandchildren and where they reside(their birth dates, etc. etc.)

I'm planning on trading some of my information here in Illinois with Mr. Herman Foltz(Fultz) in Winston-Salem, N.C. for the names of the brothers and sisters of my gr.gr.gr.gr.grandfather and the parents if he knows. I talked with him and he let me look at some of the information but Bidn't want to give me any of it, and I asked if he would like to exchange information. He was up in years so I want to get it done , if he still will do it.

He had won a National Palmer Method contest way back and took us into the bedroom to see it. It was a huge certificate and all done by hand. He was very proud.

I don't know about Aug. 20 yet and coming over. Will there be a basket dinner. I can't remember if that is the date of a reunion here or not. I'll check on it. I am canning green beans and it is 2am. Must close before I make one more mistake.

I would like to check out the Crutchfield family in your quarterly if you have a query page. Elizabeth Fultz was married to a Crutchfield before she married Andrew and then inter-married with another Crutchfield after Andrew's death. I can't find a record of his burial here. Wonder if he wandered to another county here or went back to Indiana.
