Burial was in Greenlawn Cemetery, Brownsburg. She is survived by four daughters, Mrs. Daisy E. Parrett of Ohio, Mrs. Millie M. Vorhies of Texas, Mrs Leona Wilson of Kentucky and Mrs. Minnie Smith of Brownsburg.

At Greenlawn Cemetery, she is buried in Sec. F. Her Tombstone reads "Cynthia J. Hession, 1854 -1947" I found no other Hession buried near her.
