

The Hamilton Family

John Hamilton was born in Maryland, Nov. 26, 1768. He was of German descent but nothing is known of his family. It is thought that the Hamilton family moved from Maryland to North Carolina. From there John Hamilton went to Tennessee where he married Catherine Spurgeon.

Catherine Spurgeon was the oldest daughter of John and Elizabeth Treadlebaugh Spurgeon.

John Spurgeon was born in England Feb. 6, 1755 and married Elizabeth Treadlebaugh.

The following records were furnished by Rhea Anderson of Blountsville, Tenn. from the old Spurgeon Bible which was in the hands of Elizabeth Spurgeon at the old Spurgeon home in 1927.

John Spurgeon and Elizabeth Treadlebaugh Spurgeon moved from North Carolina to Tennessee about 1782. They settled on Muddy Creek near Blountsville, Tenn. He

became one of the wealthy men and big land owners of his day. It is said that he owned more land than any man of his country. The old homestead on Muddy creek was owned by his descendants up until 1937. He was rich in negroes.

John Spurgeon is noted in Colonial Records as a Tory leader. The records states:

"Gov. Josiah Martin to the British Government
"So. Molton Street
7th March, 1782

"I have the honor to represent to you that there are many of the Scotch Highland Emigrants who had settled in N. Ca. before the rebellion, as well as many natives of the Province of whom I humbly apprehend to be fit objects of care and attention of the government, and as there is a new Commander - in-chief appointed over His Majesty's forces in N. Ca. I consider this the proper season for offering them to your consideration that the General now going to that Continent may receive such recommendations of these loyal and suffering people as their fidelity and attachment and their sacrifices to their duty to their King and Country may appear to deserve. Mr. Samuel Bryant; William and Robert Fields and John Spurgeon in particular have great claims to the notice of the Government."

John Spurgeon and his wife were both buried on the old homestead farm on Muddy Creek.

John Hamilton and Catherine Spurgeon Hamilton settled on Muddy Creek, also.
