Good to hear from you. There's no rush in any of this genealogy; it took years to get this far and it's only a hobby for me. I just think this is a fun family to research.

You are on the right track about the Haworths coming from North Carolina. They either stopped in Tennessee or they lived in that part of North Carolina that later became Tennessee.

Since you are taking an interest in this, I'll briefly show you some of the family:
