Jesse D. Hiatt - born 1817 - died 1900 - age 83 yrs.

Achach Reynolds Hiatt - born 1818 - died 1901 - age 83 yrs.

They came from High Point, North Carolina, Guilford County, in year about 1850. They both came through in wagon and on horseback. — Jesse D. Hiatt had four brothers — as he says he has never seen but one of since. — Achach had eight sisters and one brother. They were the daughters and son of Job and Jane Reynolds, who came to Indiana about the same time they did. — The names of the eight daughters were Achach Hiatt, Margaret Hampton, Eunice Wilson, Susan Trueblood, Jennie Hodson, Aseneth Townsend, — Osborn, <sup>Phoebe</sup> <sub>Jane</sub> Kenworthy Rensworth and a bachelor son, David Will Hiatt — son of Job and Mary Hiatt.
