Inquest Today at

DE LAND, Feb. 17, (P)—R. N. Dillard, tender of the Astor Bridge across the St. Johns River 20 miles north of here, was turned over to Lake County authorities today, following the start of an inquest into the shooting last night of M. A. Johnson, Lake County resident, who was killed last night.
