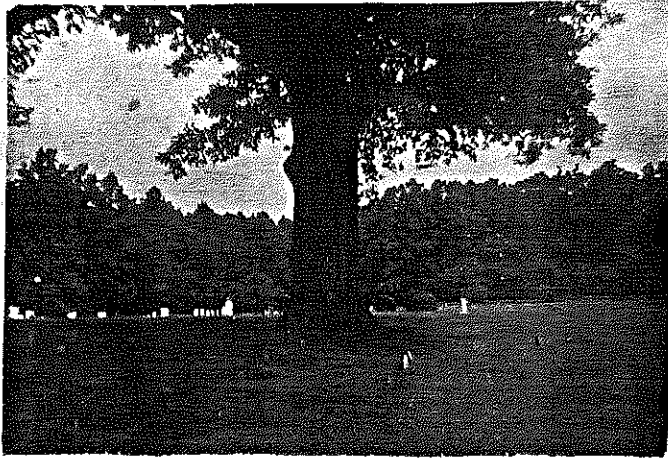

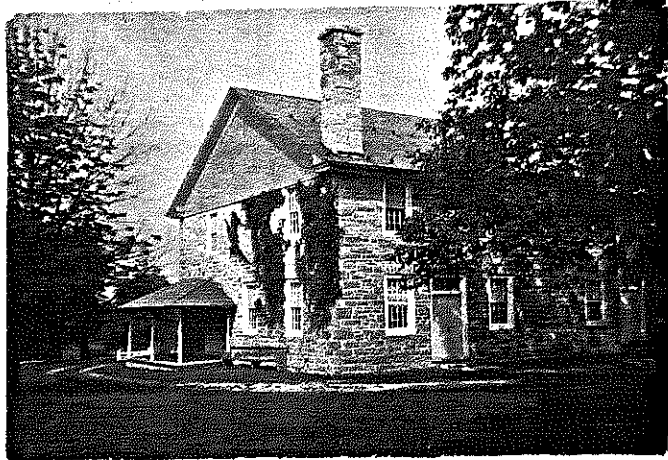

Winchester. (Do not confuse
with the war boom Hopewell
near Richmond, Virginia)
The church records show
that in 1746 your great,
great grand father, Eleazar
Hunt, Senior, and his first
cousin the famous John Woolman
were here together at that time.

Alfred Hunt settled in " " " " by or before 1839.

Cyrus Hunt lived in Belleville, but Alfred and four other Hunts lived and voted in Springtown (North of what is now Amo at Springtown's first recorded election - 1846.

Cyrus, Alfred and Amiel Hunt helped organize and were original stockholders in First National Bank, Danville, Indiana, established 1863. Some of Alfred Hunt's shares have never been out of the family.

HUNT FAMILY

Cyrus Hunt was head of the Brownsburg tribe.

Alfred Hunt was head of the Clayton and Danville tribe.

Their ancestors and relatives had a leading part in the history of Guilford County, North Carolina. The first white child born in Guilford County was a Hunt boy.

They and their relatives and descendants an active part in the history of Hendricks County, Indiana.

The mother of above children was born in Kentucky May 18, 1820, died May 15, 1881.

Alfred Hunt was born in North Carolina January 5, 1808, died December 10, 1891.

HUNT FAMILY

Cyrus Hunt was head of the Brownsburg Tribe of HUNTS. The only living descendants that I know about are -- his grandson, Marcus A. Bland, Brownsburg, who has five sons and one daughter. Also a few grandchildren. Four of his sons and two of his grandsons were in the recent World War (2). Cyrus Hunt was also the grandfather of Cleo L. Hunt of Indianapolis.

Amiel Hunt's descendants (the E. B. Owen family of Amo) moved to California around 1900 - 1907. One great-grandson named Willard Owen Hopkins did live in Indianapolis.

Alfred Hunt's descendants are through John F. (Uncle Doc) and Julia Hunt Martin
and

Richard E. and Eliza Hunt Reid.

Several of these in Indiana, Arizona and California. From latest reports, scattered from New York to the Philippine Islands.

The HUNT'S had a prominent part in the founding of this North Carolina Quaker Settlement.

Several Quaker HUNTS were in America before Wm. Penn, who came in 1682.

LONG SHOTS

Hinshaw is still working on Quaker History. When more of his books are published, you have an outside chance to go father back with some of the following:

1684 John Woolman married Elizabeth Bourton. They were your ancestors and the parents of Mary Woolman, whose name is on that New Garden Tablet.

1687 Wm. Hunt licensed to marry Margaret Pearson.

1694 Wm. Hunt buried in Philadelphia.

Hunt's, Woolman's, Bourton's, Pearson's -- Hinshaw's Record Searchers may find information that takes us back beyond his established date of 1684.

Also, it looks like Ann Newby (HUNT) the mother of Cyrus, Alfred, and their brothers and sisters was the daughter of Elizabeth Ratliff (Newby) of Perquiman's County, North Carolina.

NEWBY'S AND RATLIFF'S

The mother of Cyrus and Alfred Hunt and the other Hunt Children was a NEWBY of Randolph County North Carolina. This is the first county south of Guilford.

Her mother was a Ratliff of Perquiman's County, North Carolina. This is on the Atlantic Coast. Both were Quaker families.

N.B.

If any of you know or ever learn anything about JANE BROWN of North Carolina who married Cyrus Hunt and the few years younger JANE BROWN of Kentucky, who married Alfred Hunt, I will appreciate the information.

the JANE BROWN who married Alfred Hunt was a "Campbellite". She brought that religion with her as a bride. All of her daughters and some of her grand-daughters were members of the same "Campbellite" Clayton Christian Church as their mother and grandmother.

I understand that the JANE BROWN who married Cyrus Hunt was also a "Campbellite" and that some of her descendants are of that faith. Some indications here of a blood relationship between these two JANE BROWNS who married HUNT brothers. Old time "Campbellite's" around Clayton say they were blood relatives. That Alfred's wife was probably either a niece or a cousin of Cyrus' wife. They seem pretty certain of some blood relationship.

NOTES ON HUNT FAMILY GENEALOGY

Genealogy of Hunt Family, p.336 (Uriah Hunt's letter)

William Hunt (Sr.) came from Scotland, repudiatedly with William Penn, and settled in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. He had four sons and two daughters.

Minutes of Burlington Monthly Meeting (Burlington County, New Jersey)

On 2/14/1720, William Hunt of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, married Mary Woolman, daughter of John Woolman, of Burlington County, New Jersey. Witnesses were William, Sarah, and Margaret Hunt. (The Woolmans were members of Springfield Monthly Meeting)

The Journal and Essays of John Woolman, p. 517-521 (1922)

William Hunt (Sr.) died while William (Jr.) was a child, so the son was sent to live with an aunt in Virginia who brought him up in the very strict Quaker tradition. William (Jr.) began to preach at the age of 15 and it was said that he eventually preached in every Meeting house in America. On 6/1/1752, he produced a certificate of removal from Hopewell Monthly Meeting in Virginia to Cane Creek Monthly Meeting in North Carolina. (William settled on land that was near the site of the Revolutionary battlefield of Guilford Courthouse.)

William (Jr.) had a brother, Thomas, and two sisters, Margaret (Beals or Bales) and Hannah (Kersey).

John Woolman was a cousin of William Hunt (Jr.). He was the son of Samuel and Elizabeth (Burr) Woolman and was born in Rancocas, New Jersey, on 10/19/1720.

History of Guilford County, North Carolina

Most of the settlers to North Carolina came from Pennsylvania by way of Maryland. Some later came from Virginia. The migration to North Carolina stopped at the start of the Revolutionary War.

The Hunts migrated to Guilford County from Pennsylvania. They originally came to America with William Penn.

The New Garden Monthly Meeting was established at Piedmont, North Carolina, in 1754:

"On the 19th of October, 1757, Henry Ballinger and Thomas Hunt bought of Richard Williams fifty acres of land for five shillings for the use, benefit, privilege and conveniency of a Meeting house which is already erected upon the above and bears the name New Garden for the Christian people called Quakers to meet in for publick worship of Almighty God, as also the ground to bury their dead in."

Dictionary of American Biography

Nathan Hunt (son of William and Sarah Hunt) was a famous Quaker preacher and pioneer in education. At the age of 35 he was recorded as a minister. During 1820-21, he traveled abroad and preached to large audiences of Quakers and non-Quakers in England, Ireland, and Scotland. He was chairman of the committee that founded New Garden Boarding School in 1837 which later grew into Guilford College. He was a member of the North Carolina House of Commons in 1846. Nathan settled on the paternal farm which was near the Revolutionary battlefield of Guilford Courthouse. The Hunt family had suffered considerable financial losses from that battle.

Minutes of New Garden Monthly Meeting (Guilford County, North Carolina)

- 6/25/1791- Nathan Hunt and wife, Prudence, granted certificate to Springfield Monthly Meeting.
- 8/25/1810- Asher Hunt disowned for marrying out of unity.
- 9/28/1811- Asher Hunt received by request.
- 3/27/1813- Isaiah Hunt Jr. disowned for marrying out of unity.
- 4/29/1815- Zimri Hunt Sr. condemned his marriage out of unity.
- 4/26/1817- Isaiah Hunt Jr. and family granted certificate to Blue River Monthly Meeting in Indiana.
- 10/28/1820- Zimri Hunt Sr. and family granted certificate to Honey Creek Monthly Meeting in Sullivan County, Indiana. Zimri's first six children were born in North Carolina.
- 2/24/1821- Asher Hunt and family granted certificate to Honey Creek Monthly Meeting in Sullivan County, Indiana.

Eleazar Hunt (son of William and Sarah Hunt) was buried at New Garden, near Piedmont, in North Carolina. Eleazar's wife, Lydia, was a Quaker elder for thirteen years.

1885 History of Hendricks County, Indiana

Asher Hunt's first five children were born in North Carolina. Ithamar was the first child of Asher to be born in Indiana. Asher Hunt and his second wife, Abigail Foster, moved to Hendricks County from Sullivan County in 1836. Asher's third wife, Nancy (Brown) Wilson, died ten years after their marriage.

The children of John and Elizabeth (Norton) Bush were Lucinda, Pleasant, and Frances (Fanny Jane). Frances married Ithamar Hunt.

Asahel Hunt (son of Eleazar and Lydia Hunt) settled north of Amo, Indiana, in 1831-32.

William T. Hadley, the husband of Beulah Hunt (daughter of Zimri Hunt), re-married on 10/8/1869 to Hannah Hadley, daughter of Nathan and Olive Hadley. The children by this marriage were Luther, Olive, Beulah, Smithie, William, and Paul.

History of Sullivan County, Indiana

Asher Hunt and his children by his first wife constituted the entire population of Sullivan County in 1830.

Hunt Family Genealogy

A William Hunt came to Concord, Massachusetts, from Salisbury, England, in 1635. His descendants were known as the "Concord" line of Hunts. Enoch Hunt of Bucks County settled in Weymouth, Massachusetts, sometime before 1652. Enoch was a freeman of Newport, Rhode Island, in 1638. Enoch's descendants were known as the "Weymouth" line. There appears to be no close genealogical connection between either of these Hunts to the Quaker Hunts of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and North Carolina.

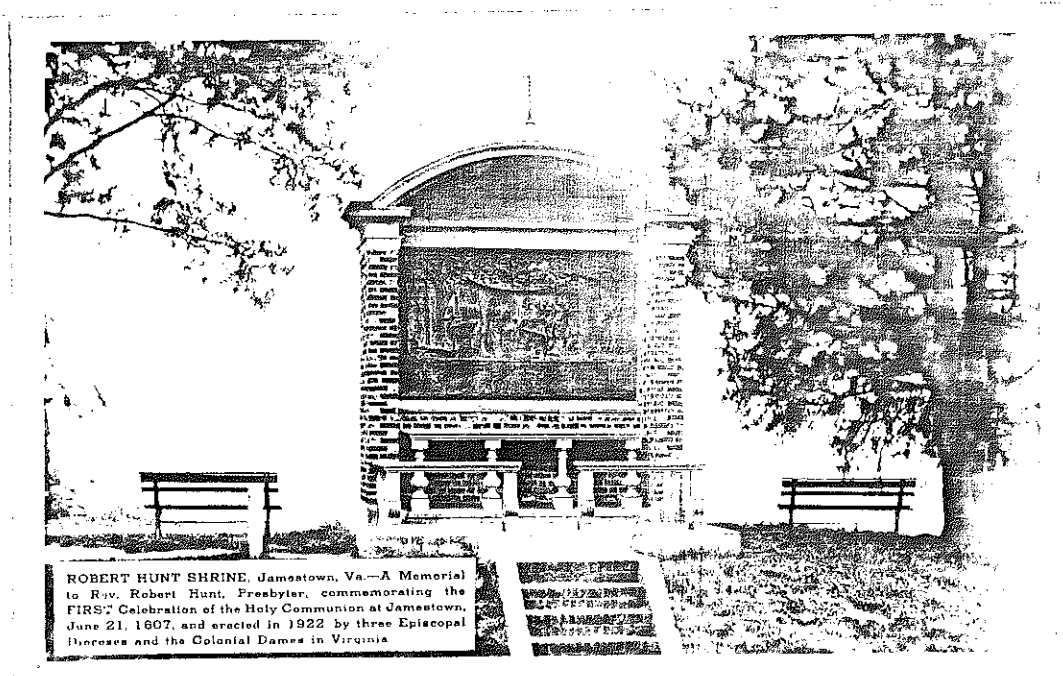

THE FIRST HUNT IN AMERICA

Rev. Robert Hunt lived in Jamestown, Virginia in 1607 (Church of England). He planted the first Protestant Church in America. Died 1608. He left a wife, Elizabeth, a daughter Elizabeth, son Thomas, and also a brother.

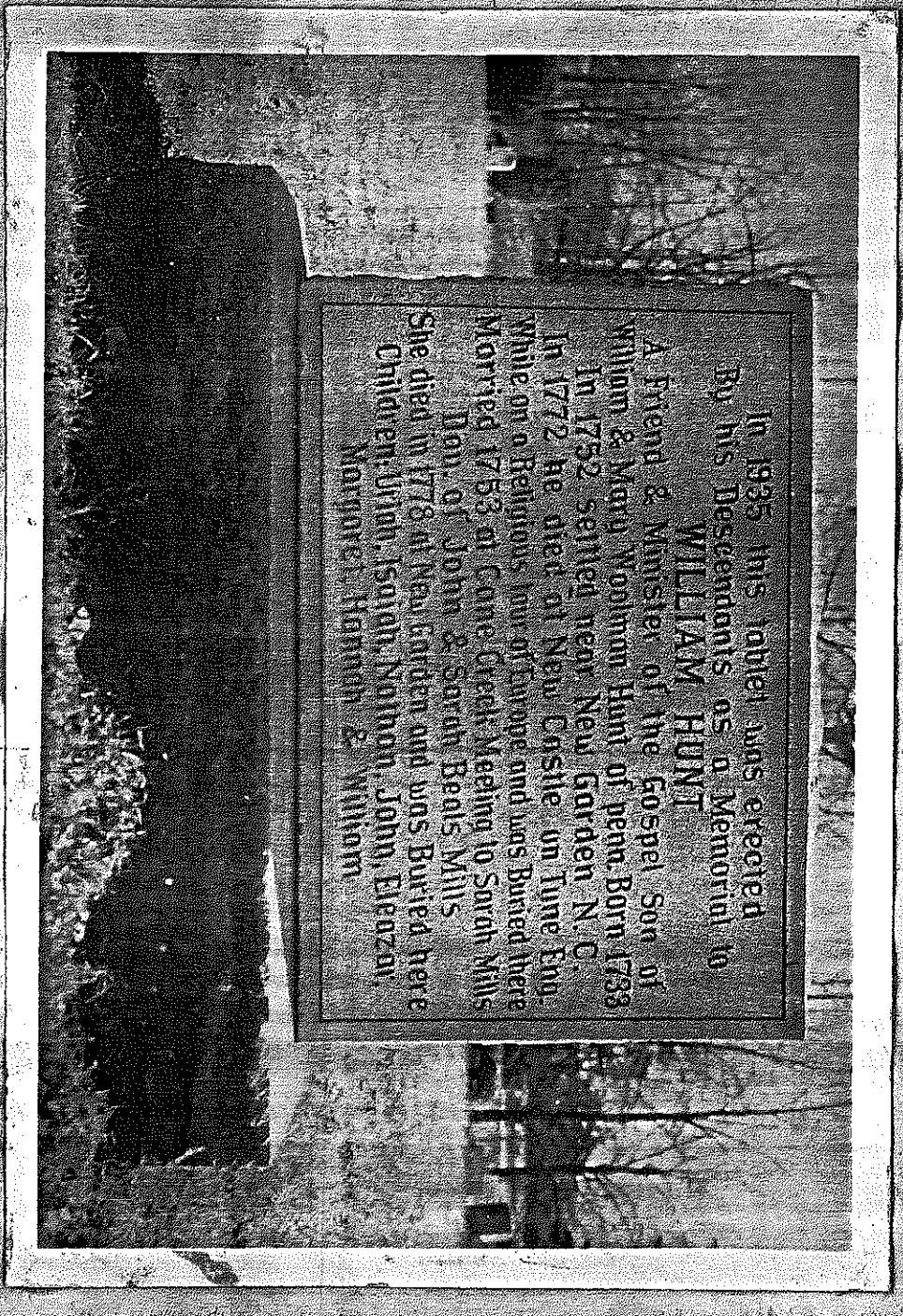
Now (1947) there are said to be around one hundred and twenty-five thousand people in the U. S. named HUNT. A lot more by other names who belong to the tribe. 97% are of Protestant faith. HUNT FAMILY

This Tablet is in New Garden Cemetery, Guilford College, North Carolina. Your attention is called to it for there is undisputable evidence in Hinshaw, verified by other histories in the library, that this WILLIAM HUNT was a full-blood younger brother of ELEAZAR HUNT (1). (All numbers are mine). ELEAZAR HUNT (1) was your ancestor. Both were children of WILLIAM HUNT (2) and MARY WOOLMAN HUNT of Bucks County, Pa.

Both ELEAZAR HUNT (1) and his brother WILLIAM HUNT (3) transferred their membership from Virginia to Cane Creek, N. C. Both were "Charter Members" of Cane Creek. Both married while there. Both transferred their memberships along with their cousin THOMAS HUNT to New Garden, where all three were again "Charter Members". That makes at least three Hunt Families in a total of forty families, not all of them listed by name, who were the original founders of New Garden (now Guilford College), North Carolina.

Once on the right track, it is easy to trace these HUNTS. Reason: Descendants of the brother of your ancestor have an outstanding part in the history of Guilford College.

Plenty of information in Raleigh, Greensboro, High Point and Guilford College, North Carolina about this family of HUNT'S. Books and records by Welborn, Hinshaw and others.

The Welborns are a well known Guilford County, North Carolina family (High Point) who search for such information and donate it to Greensboro and High Point Libraries. It is not likely their books are available in Indiana.

Hinshaw and a paid staff of some twenty people have been searching for information since 1923. The entire Quaker organization endorsed and helped him - also many who are not Quakers. Several people who are "above pay" assisted. Hinshaw has a world-wide reputation and his works are in the Indiana State Library, Indianapolis, Indiana.

HUNT FAMILY

Records show that this William Hunt (3) died in England of smallpox. That he was an orphan. Both parents died when he was still small. After their death and until he was married, this William Hunt made his home with his older brother, Eleazar Hunt (1) who was the grandfather of Cyrus and Alfred Hunt. *and AMIEL HUNT.*

Many letters on file in North Carolina show that this William Hunt (3) thought quite well of his brother, Eleazar Hunt (1).

William Hunt (3) was a Quaker Preacher sort of a "trouble shooter" who was often sent to make peace when there was "friction and accusers among the brethren". "He traveled and preached in all North American Provinces and many parts of England, Scotland, Ireland and Holland", and wrote home about "good solid meetings, comfortable and edifying".

Over a hundred and sixty-five years ago -- his obituary states, "reddish fair complexion, serious countenance, composed and solid, middle-sized, moderate in meat and drink, diligent in business, fervent in spirit, did not yield much to sleep".

He had a strong urge to travel and preach. When away from home he was a constant writer of affectionate and religious letters to his wife, children, brother and friends. Died before he was forty years old, but left his mark on America and a family of eight children, including his famous son, Nathan Hunt, a Quaker Preacher, who was preaching in Indiana as early as 1814.
