James Clark was the 2nd. child of Chas. and Elizabeth Clark, born Oct. 22, 1810 at the Clark home near Scollsville, Clark Co. Ky. As a young man he drove a stage-coach from Louisville to Catlettsburg, changing horses at the Tavern on the Hord Plantation. On one of his trips he met Polly Willis Hord. He also was a stock trader, buying mules and sending them to the far South, to be used in the cotton fields. He was a life long Mason, a member of "M. M. Trimble Lodge 145", Grayson, Ky., and at the time of his death he was the oldest Mason in Carter Co. For 25 years he was Tyler of his Lodge. His son, Charles Washington Sales Clark, was a Mason from the time he was 21 years old. His grandson, James MacDonald, is a Shriner, his Grandson, Chas. Willis MacDonald, was a Shrine and Knight Templar Mason. Practically all of his grandsons were Mason of high standing.

James Clark married Mrs. Polly Willis Hord England Feb. 3, 1831. The daughter of Willis and Polly Buckner Hord, who was born Jan. 17, 1819. Her first husband was Dr. Cornelius M. England, who died July 18, 1835.

James and Polly Willis England were married in Greenup County, Ky. and settled in Carter Co. on a farm two and one half miles from Grayson, the County Seat of Carter, Co., Ky.

James Clark died Jan. 23, 1886.- Polly Willis Clark died . . . They are both buried in the old Hord Cemetery.

Heloise Gertrude Clark, 4th. child of James and Polly Willis Clark born Dec. 23, 1842 married Jahue Donahue Williams, at the old homestead near Grayson, Ky. Dec. 1, 1870. (Relatives, friends and business associates knew him as J. D. Truly I had never heard my father's full name until one day, when I was about 18 years old, and was invited to a Masque Ball, which Col. and Mrs. E. B. Wilhoit were giving at Grayson during the Christmas vacation, when I was home from Mrs. Williams School, Snipping the big white plume from his Masonic hat, borrowing it to wear on my head to my first big social affair. Among other things in his wardrobe I found his sword, on the scabbord I found- "Jahue Donahue Williams" Haysville Com'dy No. 10, K.T. Denton, Ky.) (Hattie Williams Carter).

They settled in Carter Co. two miles east of Ashland, Ky about 6 miles from Grayson. In a few years J. D. Williams' Cross ties, lumber and General Merchandise business created a town, which he named Denton. In 1899 he moved and concentrated his business in Ashland, where he built up a great manufacturing plant.
