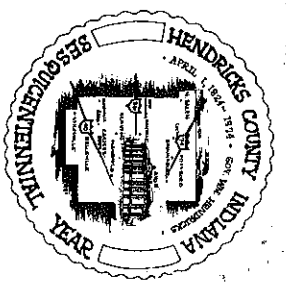

Carrie raised in a poor farm family in southern Iowa
was blessed with a rich uncle, who sent her to college.
This was Union College, of the Seventh Day Adventist
Church, where she took business administration. She
became engaged to Dr. Walter Smalley who was studying
to become a missionary. She was assigned to the Nevada
(Iowa) Sanitarium as business administrator & became
interested in nursing - which she trained for. ^{broken} This engagement was

Later she was employed by Wallace Homestead
owned by the Henry Wallace family. (no relation)
& she took dictation for "Uncle Henry"

She married in 1909, taking up abode in Des Moines,
where her husband was a partner in the Campbell-Russell
Printing Co. Their life spent in Des Moines, except for
a short time in 1915 when they "pioneered" to Sterling, Colorado.
Their assistance in field corn & jackrabbits - She got
rabbit fever, which began in a thump & settled in her
armpit - They hurried back to Iowa where she sought
treatment for this dangerous disease from Uncle "Doc"
Wallace at Winterset & she recovered.

She was active in charity work - helping much in World
War I with the Red Cross & later took active part in Red
Feather campaigns & helping the poor during the Depression.

Her deepest sadness was the loss of her four year old son
John with diphtheria.

Her later years spent pleasantly on four acres just outside
Des Moines city limits, where a big garden, fruit, a cow &
chickens were raised for the families' substance. She was noted
for her flowers, dahlias as large as dinner plates, her tulips
from Holland & name variety gladiolus.

She passed away at a age 52 years following a stroke
six weeks previous. She died in Christ.

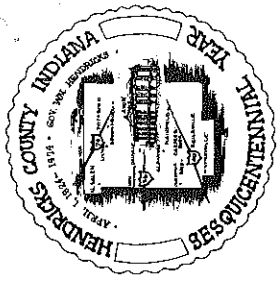

wife of Isaac Wallace, dau. of Robert Jones

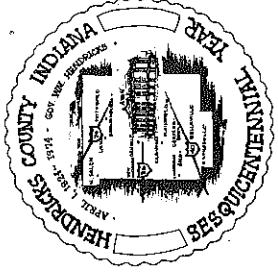
One of nine Jones girls + one brother - she was red-headed as were other of her sisters - They lived next neighbors to Isaac Wallace in Davis Co. Iowa - It was "hot" there for former Tennesseans + southern sympathizers - It was at the time of the Missouri border dispute - Bushwhackers were coming up from Missouri + stealing horses + food - John Brown was promoting his underground railway just 15 miles away, helping negro slaves escape to Canada. Isaac termed himself a "copperhead" - Shortly after their marriage, ~~Isaac~~ Wallace brothers + their mother moved to Taylor Co. Iowa + bought farms there -

Isaac was drafted in the Civil War - but refused to go - said they would have to come + get him - which they did, drug him out of his field + he didn't get to say "goodbye" to his wife + children - He fought honorably in the 15th Iowa, but "fought" the war the rest of his life for the southern cause - He contracted cancer in 1898 + "cost" 15 per day for treatment. Soon after they retired to Gravity, Iowa, but in 1913 cancer returned + they moved to Winterset (Madison Co.) Iowa to be near their doctor son - They built a four room house next door, but Isaac did not live to occupy - Mary spent her remaining years there with her oldest son Joe, who preceded her in death.

Mary, apparently was a Mason, as we have a small paper glove which was laid on her casket -

She + Isaac both were buried in Washington cemetery near Gravity - Their bodies were transported by wagon over muddy roads + did not reach their destination until night fall + the funeral was held the next day.

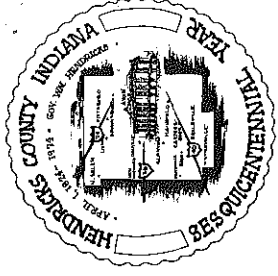

Finding him was most difficult as the Wallace family tradition was that his wife's name was Nash.
Had material in the files four years & did not know it was mine. My record only went back to 1820 in Missouri - I knew they were born Kentucky from the census records. They moved from Randolph Co - Mo - in 1842, before Iowa was a state to Davis Co - across the border. From other records we find the Indians were quite vicious in the Hunterville area & the Iowa Indians were friendly - He & his brother Martin "squatted" on rich ground, rolling hills & trees & thick grass. (Been to his farm several times). Neither filed their deeds until 1854 as Fairfield, (Jefferson Co.) Iowa Robert set aside an acre for the family cemetery & sold his farm to Peter Runcle & the cemetery is now known as Runcle. in Fox River twp, near Drakeville - His son & several daughters & grandchildren are buried there as are Robert & Martha - In 1973 the stones were readable but knocked down from cattle grazing there -

From records at Merce Co. Court house in Kentucky we found the original marriage contract for Robert & Martha & feel they left Kentucky for Missouri shortly after - ward because of a Depression that hit Kentucky about 1819 & sent prices downward - Legend says Robert was a shoe maker by trade. from records of inventory his grandfather Josias Campbell may also been a shoemaker. We also have several records of slaves involved with Martha's parents & grandparents - She & Robert signing them back to her father - Legend says one refused to leave & went to Missouri with them - Evidence was she died (the slave) in Davis Co. Iowa.

No will has been found for Robert as yet - We feel there must have been one -

We were real lucky to receive a copy from the Family Bible of Martin Mitchell Jones Jr. now in the hands of Claud Jones McPherson, KS - We would never have found that her name was Campbell.

Some of the Bible record did not correspond with tombstone records & there were other errors, but we presume M. M. Jones Jr. wrote them from memory. Other data has been found from census, voting records, descendants etc, & more coming in -

In Mercer Co. Ky, we found the marriage consent for Allen & Elizabeth. Quote: "19th January 1792, Thereby give free consent that my daughter Elisabeth shall have Allen Jones given under my hand -"

The Jones Family

A part of southeastern section of Middle Township was settled by Thomas B. and Matilda (Yount) Jones. They were, like most early settlers of the ^{mid} 1800's; they tilled the soil, built their own buildings and reared a family of four boys. They were active members of Abner Creek Baptist Church.

Their sons were Otis E. Stillard, Anson Lee, and Aubrey C. As the sons grew to manhood and Thomas and Matilda moved to Pittsboro, Ind., the farm was divided equally among their four sons.

Anson received the ground directly across from his birthplace. He lived his entire life on his farm. Later he bought the ground that belonged to Otis Jones. Anson cleared the ground and made it tillable. The farm is still owned by the Jones boys, Clarence and Ralph.

Anson built a three-room house ^(later) ^{added} _{a room} and a barn on his farm. He married Laura (Stiles) of near Avon, Ind. They reared eight children, all of whom

were educated at the Pittsboro School. Gladys, Freda and Catherine Jones all graduated from Central Normal College at Danville and became successful teachers. Freda Jones returned to Pittsboro and taught the third grade in 1935-1937. Catherine returned to Pittsboro and taught the fourth grade during the forties.

Anson Jones owned and operated his farm, owned and operated a threshing "rig" every summer. He was a member and believed in the Farm Bureau and its policies. He was very instrumental in bringing the REMC to Hendricks County.

Anson loved politics. He was a staunch Democrat all his life. He loved to attend political rallies and talk politics. He was Middle Township Assessor for many years. He campaigned for Township Trustee of Middle Township and Hendricks County Assessor on the Democratic ticket but was unsuccessful. He was always working for better schools; he wanted everyone to have a good education. He worked to improve conditions for the farmer.

Anson died of a heart attack in May 1937. Laura died of a stroke in June 1957.
