(Same family distins record that there was a mixth son, William, and a daughter that died in infancy).

A rezor hone, now in the possession of Daton Kersey, Amo, Indiana, bears the following data, carved in the edge:
"John Kersey brought this resor hone to America from Ayorshire, Scotland, in 1850. Gave it to his son, John, about 1706. "As given to his son, William, about 1742. William gave it to his son, Amos, about 1780. Was given to Amos! son Jemes in 1830. James gave it to his son, Jemes, in 1880.

The Dictionary of National Biography, edited by Sidney Lee, Vol. XI, Konnett - Lluelyn, 1909, contains rather full accounts of two Kersoys. The following are excercts from this biography:
"Yorsey, John, the alder, '1516-16907'), methemetician, son of Anthony Gersays or Kersoy and Alice Penimore, was bactised at Bodicote, near Benbury, Oxfordshire, on 25 Wov., 1616.
Kersoy early came to London, where he seems to have had relatives."

"Korsey, John, the younger, (flourished, 1720), lexicographer, son of John Kersey, the older, revised the work of his fether. He was mainly occupied with lexicography. The date of his centh is uncertain."

From, Puthey-Cone Wistory of Chester County, Pennsylvania: "Kersey, "illiam, of York in the county of York, Pa., late from Worth Carolina, son of "illiam and Mizabeth Kersey, deceased, was married at the former place, 9, 8, 1767 to Hannah Bennett. Her parents, Joseph and Rebecca Bonnett were natives of Chester County. William Kersey-became a prominent member of York Westing, was appointed an elder in 1775, and clerk of the Monthly Meeting in 1776. In 1787 he was clerk of Marrington Quartely Meeting."

This Futhey-Cope History gives a lengthy account of Jesse Kersey. The following is an excerpt:

"Jesse Korsey, an eminent minister in the Society of Friends, was born at York, Pa., Ath month 5, 1768. His parents, William and Hannah Kersey, were members of the society. Jesse Kersey's children: Hannah, 1791-1877; Lydia, 1792- : Mary, 1795- ; Joseph, 1797- : Ruchel, 1800- : Sarah, 1802; Jesse, 1805-William, 1807- : Elizabeth R. 1809- : Ann, 1812- ; Esthor, 1815- ? There is over a full page concerning Jesse Kersey, his fine character and ability as an orator.

From the diary of Miss Virginia Kersoy: Dr. Vierling Kersey. my fethor, told me the Korseys originated in Scotland, drifted to Ireland for a few generations, and then to England, located noor Combridge, where a town or villege, named Yersoy, still exists. I em sure they sees originally wesvers in all three countries." (The village of Kersey is in Suffolk, 25 miles MW. of Hadloigh. Karaay cloth is a well known fabric in England). "John Yoseey of England and his twelfth son, Villiam, were among the early sattlars of Conneylvania. William omigreted to North Capalina and settled in dichland Greek. in Guilford County. He married Henral Went, sister of Milliem Punt, who died of amali-pox while on a religious virit to Friends in Unaland. Their mother was Mary Woolman, sister of John Woolman. William and Harrah (Munt) Korsey had six sons and one daughter, namely: Amos, Deniel, Jeess, Thomas, Wisazer, Filliam, and a daughter that died in infancy. Daniel Kerrey married Very Certer, daughter of John and Ann (Shirple) Corter. Hethanial and Ann Center of Dublin, Ireland, were the parents of John Cirker. John Kersey came to America about 1702."

The XX 1561-1834 edition of Dr. Robinson's Register Merchant Teylor's School, edited with Biographical Rotes by Brs. E.P.Hart, Lists three Korsey boys who were students in the school: "John Kersey, (in school 1621-1627; b. 20-6-1613; James Kersey, (in school, 1677-6-30; and Arthur William Kersey, (in school, 1374-73; b.13 -7-1361, son of William (morehent) and allon Frances of Masons Bridge, Hadleigh, Suffolk, went to New Zenland, and died there."

W. B. I will be very grateful to anyone who can and will supply any missing data in these early records, or make any corrections in them. I was cancelally desirous of knowing if the two John Karseys mentioned in the Dictionary of Entional Biography are those mentioned on the rezer hone. The birth date of Jesse Kersey, mentioned in the Futhey-Cope History, is given in this history, as "Oth month 5, 1788." Under "Children of William and Hannah (Munt) Kersey," Jesse Kersey's birth date is 1753. Was this the same Jesse Kersey, or is one of the dates wrong? Laurence T. Kersey

I would like very much to hear about the Kersey Reunion, recently held in Indiana, if you or Clarence or anyone else could take the time and trouble of writing me.

Remember this Kersey History is to include written articles, old letters, or items of interest by or about any of the great 'tribe' of Kerseys, in-laws included, and I will appreciate anything along this line that you will send me. No doubt your father had much that would have been wonderful - too bad it was destroyed!
