Dear Mrs. Carter,

Enclosed are three family charts. Charts I and II have ties to Hendricks Co. I know of no Mc Achrane in Indiana at the present time, although there may be. You might want to check for Hudsons; otherwise chart II may not be pertinent for you to file either.

I think there were Mc Achrane in the Greencastle area in the 1840-50's who were not descendants of my James Mc Achrane. I'm trying to determine if James had a brother John <sup>who died 1833</sup> in Ky. - & if John had sons.

I'm not sure James my ancestor was in Hendricks Co. in 1819 — He was in Ind. <sup>that</sup> that early but which Co. I'm not sure. He taught school at Greencastle in 1838. He moved around more than any person I've ever heard of! Several counties of Ind., several in Ky., several in Va. And I'm trying to trace him to Pennsylvania. He died 1853, Putnam Co. at age ~~69~~ <sup>70</sup> ~~80~~ <sup>81</sup> ~~83~~ <sup>84</sup>.
