George Stewart Merritt came to Hendricks County in 1825 after living in both Tenn. and Ohio. According to family legend his father had left the south in protest of slavery. He hanged himself in 1853 because of failing health, and is buried in the Merritt cemetery just south of Avoh. We have a copy of the inventory of his estate which includes such interesting items as 4 glass tumblers, 55 teacups and saucers, 32 large bowls and one horse worth \$100.

George W. Merritt was about five when the family came to Indiana. He attended a school taught by Gideon Hufford, and was active in the Abner's Creek Baptist Church. He was in the nursery business with James Sigerson, and once developed a pear tree that bore two kinds of pears. An active supporter of the democratic party, he opposed the Civil War, doing everything possible to keep his sons and others from joining the army. He is buried with his wife, Melvina, in Abner's Creek cemetery. Their home is still standing, and is supposed to have the original logs under the clapboard which was added later.

William Merritt (1850-1939) began teaching school in Washington Twp. as soon as he completed the eighth grade. At that time teachers were hired on the basis of a test administered by an inspector from Indianapolis. Later he attended Central Normal College where he was one of the students "kidnapped" by the town of Danville when the school was moved from Ladoga. He and his wife, Abbey, were "truck" farmers, making weekly trips to Indianapolis to peddle produce on the west side. They were members of the Avon Methodist Church, and are buried in Maple Hill Cemtery in Plainfield.

Abbey Shipman Merritt came to Indiana from Ohio as a child. Her family lived in the old house still standing at the corner of Dan Jones and 36. Her father was a cabriagemmaker.
