#107. Simon Moon (John 5, James 4, Simon 3, James 2, James 1)
Most likely b. at Cane Creek, North Carolina, m. 1808-1st mo. 1d, at Cane Creek, MM, Guilford co., North Carolina, Hannah Stout. In 11mo 20 day, 1820, the family moved from Guilford co., NC to Indiana and settled east of Richmond, near the Ohio line. A few years later they moved to a location near Sugar Grove, 2.5 miles sw of Plainfield, Hendricks co., Indiana. On 1832-September-29th, they moved to Westfield, Hamilton co., Indiana, arriving at sunset of the 29th. They built the first log cabin in Washington Twp., Hamilton co., Indiana, on the 160 acres of land Simon had previously entered on the sw corner of Plainfield, later called the Doan Farm. He gave the Friends Church two acres of ground for a hitching ground for as long as they wished to use it for that purpose, where Dr. Coffin's house now stands (1928). He was a Charter Member of the Friends Church. Simon d. 1835-Aug. 11 and was buried in the old grave yard. Hannah d. 1844, August 30 & is buried by his side. All of the following named children moved to Emporia, Kansas, in the fall of 1856. The families of all of them (1928) lived in Lyon co. except Simon Jr. & his family who a few years later returned to Indiana.



A primitive painting by
Hannah Pratt Jessup, painted
in 1931 shows the Moon Mill.
Blanchard's History says:

"White Lick Creek was the
attraction in early years. The
land bordering it was nicely
rolling and was largely alluvial,
and almost inexhaustible in
fertility. Log cabins arose in
every direction along its
banks and in a very short
period waving seas of wheat
and other grain could be seen.
Richard Day built a small corn
cracker on the creek as early as
1822.

Mr. Moon erected his saw
mill on the East Fork in 1823. It
was a rude affair, but furnished
considerable native lumber for
a few years."

The east fork of White Lick
goes through the new town
park, and west of Marleywood.
Presumably the mill was
somewhere in that vicinity.

The painting has a note

written on the back "This
picture was enlarged and
colored from postal card so
dark it had to be viewed from a
magnifying glass." The
painting shows two gray
buildings at the right, wood
fences and livestock inside of
one pen. There appears to be
cedar trees and maples. The
creek is blue, and the whole
picture is quite colorful.

The painting is the property
of Mr. and Mrs. Leland Jessup.
Mrs. Hannah Pratt Jessup was
the wife of Charles Jessup who
lived in Indiana before moving
to Texas.

Frances Jessup recalls that
she and Leland visited them in
Texas. She said that they had a
Mina bird which she tried to
teach the scale. It would say do,
re me so and leave out the fa.

The other primitive painted
on silk depicts a scene near the
Mexican border. These
paintings are examples of
history portrayed by artists.
