The First Newlin to Live in the Plainfield area.

In the year 1834 Esther Stubbs Newlin, widow of John Newlin, moved from Ohio to a farm south of Plainfield near Sugar Grove Cemetery. She purchased the 157-acre farm from Eleazer Bales, who had received the deed from the government in 1824.

Esther Stubbs was born in Waynesboro, Georgia. At the age of 21, with several Stubbs families she arrived in Ohio in an immigrant wagon train. There she met and married John Newlin, recently from North Carolina. The wedding occurred in Miami Meeting, November 12, 1807.

Soon after their marriage John and Esther became members of Center Friends Meeting, which was located 3 miles west of Wilmington, Ohio. Nine years later they became members of Springfield Meeting. During the 18½ years after their marriage, twelve children were born to them.

When John died, at the age of forty-nine, Esther was left with nine children under her care.

In 1834 Esther and her seven minor children moved from Ohio to Guilford Township

in Indiana. Her children were: Joshua, Ruth, David, Elias, Phineas, Joel, and Esther.

The land which she purchased in Guilford Township, Indiana, was so densely wooded that Esther's little son, Joel, couldn't see the panther which his small dog treed while he was hunting for cows. Joel went for his older brothers who killed the big animal. There is a tradition that wild deer would come to their farm house to get salt.

Esther lived eighty-six years and five months. She died in 1873, and was buried at Sugar Grove.

Joel Newlin and wife Mary Osborn Newlin reared their family at this place. Later the family of Calvin Newlin and Leonora Harworth Newlin lived there.

The last owners of the farm were Grace Newlin, Glenn Masten and Marjorie Chandler Surber. Now it is called Forest Ridge subdivision.
