- 4. SAMUEL OSBOURNE, son of Samuel Osbourne and Cynthia Ann Stewart, was born 1838; probably at Louisville, Ky., d. about 1887 at San Francisco, Cal. (J.C. Furnas, in his "Voyage to Windward" has his name Samuel C.Osbourne.) About 1851-53 he was a student in the preparatory department of Indiana Asbury College, (later DePauw Univ.) at Greencastle, Ind., and somewhat later he removed to Indianapolis, Ind., where he was a court reporter, and was private secretary to Gov. Willard. He mar. Dec. 24, 1857 at Indianapolis. FRANCES MATILDA VANDEGRIFT, b. Mch. 10, 1840 at Indianapolis; d. Feb. 18,1914 at Santa Barbara (Montecito) Cal., dau. of Jacob Vandegrift and Esther Thomas Keen, of Indianapolis. Samuel Osbourne enlisted in the Forty Sixth Indiana Vol. Reg. in the Civil War, and was commissioned Captain of Co.F on Feb. 6,1862. He was at the attack on Island No.10. He resigned May. 6.1862. They lived at Indianapolis until, in 1864, he accompanied his brother-in-law, GeorgeS. Marshall , husband of Fanny's sister Josephine, on a trip (intended to end in California) for the benefit of Marshall's failing health.
