Would Report that after having examined the proof adduced, finds that the said Benjamin Owen deceased, had four Brothers, to wit: Samiel Owen, Ephraim Owen, Joseph Owen, and Asa Owen all of whom are decd, but each of whom left heirs-them surviving That Hannah Owen the widow of said deceased had eight brothers and sisters to wit: Moses Farmer, Rebecca Sanders, Rachel Bradley, Sarah Smith, Phebe Pearson, Mary Creen, Nathan Farmer, and John Farmer - the names of all of whom, or their heirs, and their degree of kindred so far as said Commissioner has been able to ascertain from the evidence and set out in the statement, hereto appended, which is a made of part of this report.

(\$250.96) which has been fully paid by said administrator, the names of the heirs in whose favor said judjment was rendered, and the amounts which each were entitled, and the several amounts, still due the remaining heirs aforesaid are fully set out in said statement - leaving still due from the estate of said John Irons, due on account of the proceeds of the personal estate of said Benjamin Owen, deceased, the sum of Two hundred and thirty eight dollars and seventy seven cents.
