

John Phillips, Germany; arrived at Philadelphia on the ship St. Andrew October 2, 1741. His son John Phillips emigrated from Pennsylvania to North Carolina in 1789.

On the books of the Moravian Land office in Salem, North Carolina may be found the following entry; John Phillips Dr. Sept. 29, 1790. To rent of 104 1/2 acres - one year - and in other records show an entry by his widow Ann Phillips in August 1794.

This John Phillips left three children that we know of and possibly more. They were John Samuel Phillips, born in Pennsylvania in 1776; David Phillips, born in 1781 and Nancy Phillips, who married Jonathan Mendenhall. As we know nothing of the decendants of Nancy M. our reunion is composed entirely of the decendants of John Samuel and David Phillips. The first (Samuel) named lived near Salem, North Carolina, until about the year 1831, when he emigrated to Wayne County, Indiana, where he died soon after. His remains lie in an unmarked grave in the Friends Cemetary at New Garden, near Fountain City, Wayne County, Indiana.
