My dear Sarah Phillips

Dear Cousin Sarah this  
dark rainy Monday morning  
finds me at Mary Eliza's  
all in usual health and  
hope that this will find  
you all enjoying good  
health glad to see that you  
received your boys and that  
you were pleased with them  
It does seem strange that  
you can see the snow on the  
mountains and then look a  
round on the other hand and  
behold the beautiful nature



when you speak of the lobley  
roses and other flowers they  
are rich in something though  
but I expect that I never will  
see Cal or glad I would be  
if I could go to Long Beach  
with you think of one when  
you are there you spoke of  
rain it seems as though  
it rains all the time here  
this winter here it was a  
lobley bright day a Tomas  
thing over thing or heard  
with snow it was a simple  
lobley and a nice day a  
new years day we are a  
washing to day with the  
dress open this is Abes  
birth day he is 69 to day  
he and his wife has parted  
dont no the cause at all

You asked to know my age  
I was born the 28 of the 8<sup>th</sup> mo  
1823 that makes me 63 last  
August I will give you the  
age of our family in full  
Father the 27 of April 1812  
Mother the 24 of June 1817  
Margret Ann April 17 1835  
Albe Ward Jan 14 1838  
Eunice August 28 1843  
Henry August 29 1846  
Emley October 14 1848

Freya was born August 1  
1870  
Mary Eliza April 17 1872  
that is all and perhaps  
more than you called for  
I thought that I would tell  
all who were at it

got a letter from Jesse  
they are all well but Lula  
is having the toothache

and help Mary Eliza since  
she goes you spoke a bout  
many deaths out there I  
tell you there is lots of them  
here there was a Galamoro  
barred yesterday he got hurt  
by the cars barred his  
leg open a bout 2 between  
hip and knee clear to his  
ankle and the gangreen  
set in they took his leg off  
just below the hip and he  
lived a bout 8 weeks after  
the amputation and then  
there was a Ballard that  
got piled by the cars  
at South Charleston marked  
every

gone in his body it was  
sad I tell you might say  
no kind to either of us only  
the name name well be  
put close with best wishes  
to all
