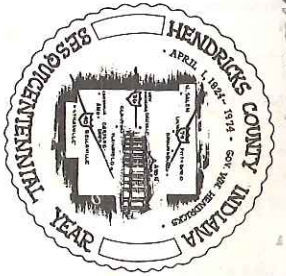

Dear Mrs Cox:

In answer to your letter of the 14th, I regret the delay but several weeks ago, in fact three or four months ago I had a letter from someone there, I dont remember who asking for this information. I sent it in, and then not too long ago some questionnaires came and I discarded them as I thought I had already given the desired information. Hence you can understand my delay.

I am sending for two certificates, both my son and myself and check attached. I could have gone back another generation to my great, great grandparents but they did not go from Kentucky to Indiana, but were originally in Virginia. My great grandparents and my grandparents, together with the former's large family, all went to Indiana about the same time, 1834. *(from Shelby Co. Ky)*

I have been for several years trying to locate the burial place of my great grandparents and I am sure it is in Marion County. All other members of my grandparents are buried in the South Cemetery in Danville. In this last issue of the History Bellefontin, I found an article by Joe Davidson relative to the burial place of his ancestor which I feel is or was a relative of my ancestors, Polly Bohannon. He tells of her burial place and I have said all this to ask if you can give me the name of the cemetery he mentions and how or with whom I might get in touch to find if that is also the burial place of my family? I do not have Mr Davidson's address. Polly was a Pierson and for that reason I feel that her burial place might be that of my grandparents and also an uncle, Augustus Pierson, my mother's brother, which I have been unable to locate. Will appreciate any information you may be able to give me. I have been away from Hendricks County over fifty years but have kept in close touch. Mrs Ersie Walter Ridgway was my sister and died in 1966. She was the wife of Frank Ridgway, who passed away in 1967.
