Daniel Richardson and Dorcas Barker were married in North Carolina in 1829. Their honeymoon was a trip on horse-back to Indiana. One horse carried them both with all their worldly possessions. One evening as they were riding late to find a place of shelter for the night, a piercing scream broke the stillness of the forest.

Looking up, they saw a wildcat ready to jump down. The horse was just as quick to sense danger and sprang to safety.

They entered land or bought it in Hendricks County in Liberty Township about a mile north of Center Valley. They put up a cabin with the help of seven neighbors who lived as far away as Mooresville. Daniel sold the land and bought eighty acres now owned by John T. Richardson. The record shows this was dated 1830. The cost was \$1.25 an acre. Daniel paid a large part of it

with money he received for working on the National Road. where his wages were thirty-five cents a day. In 1831 he entered an adjoining 80 acre tract.

Daniel and Dorcas lived in a rail pen until their first cabin was built. Wild beasts were numerous and panthers would frequently scream at Dorcas when she went to the spring.

William Beeson Richardson, son of Daniel and Dorcas Richardson married Mary Elizabeth Hurd from Kentucky in November 1850. They lived in the Hazelwood and Center Valley Community all their lives. William was a farmer and fought in the Civil War. Mary, his wife, was always present when there was sick or want in the community.

Joshua Newton Richardson was the third child of William Beeson Richardson and Mary E. Hurd Richardson.

J.N. or "Newt" as he was called was a farmer all his life. In 1881 he married Luemma Allen and they had seven children. They lived on purchased land southeast of Hazelwood on the county line road.

Walter Newton Richardson
was the fifth child of J. N. Richardson.
He was a graduate of Indiana
University ^{in 1916} and farmed all his life
on the "home place" near Hazelwood
where he specialized in dairying.

In 1932 he married Lucile
Bowen from ^{New} Washington, Indiana. ^(Clark Co.)

Walter served in the First
World War ^{in France} with ^{Co. E, 309th} The Supply Division.

He and Lucile were the
parents of a daughter Virginia E
and a son Kenneth W.

Kenneth Walter Richardson son of Walter Richardson presently owns the Richardson farm southeast of Hazelwood.

Kenneth is a graduate of Milligan College, Indiana University and De Pauw University. He is a mathematics teacher.

In 1960 Kenneth married Revenna Singleton of Putnam County. They are the parents of two daughters.
