

Walter Rushton, Monrovia, Expires

After an illness of eight months, Walter E. Rushton, retired farmer of Monrovia, died Sunday afternoon in the Morgan County Memorial Hospital.

Mr. Rushton moved to Monrovia only three weeks ago, and was ill for a week in the local hospital.

He was born in Hendricks County October 21, 1869, son of Joshua and Mary Henley Rushton.

In 1893, he was married to Cora McCracken, who survives.

In addition to the widow, a son, Harry, of Monrovia; a brother, A. H. Rushton of Mooresville; six grandchildren, six great-grandchildren, and a great-great-grandchild survive.

The Rev. Mr. Robbins of the Monrovia Christian Church, of which Mr. Rushton was a member, will officiate at the services, which will be held Wednesday afternoon at the church.

A. H. Rushton of Mooresville dies

Arthur H. Rushton, 90 year old resident of Mooresville, died Monday in the Gosport Nursing Home after an illness of two years.

Mr. Rushton was born at Monrovia Feb. 16, 1871, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Joshua Rushton, and was married to Mable Horton, who died in 1957. He had lived for about 40 years in Mooresville where he farmed and operated a coal business. He was a member of the Christian Church.

Survivors are two granddaughters, Joan and Pamela Timmons, and a step-son, Merrice Horton, all of Indianapolis; a niece, Mrs. Forest Yeager of Danville, and two nephews, Harry Rushton of Monrovia and W. C. Johnson of Belleville. A daughter, Mrs. Ruth Timmons, died in 1948.

Funeral services will be in the Carlisle and Son Chapel Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock with burial in the Mooresville Cemetery. The Rev. Harry Spear of the Mooresville Christian Church will officiate at the service.

Mrs. Arthur Rushton

Anna J. Yeager, daughter of John and Ruth Yeager, was born September 30, 1873, at the old Yeager homestead, near Herbemont, and died at her home near Monrovia, January 3, 1913, aged 39 years, three months and three days.

When a girl of seventeen she united with the Christian church at Hall, during the pastorate of Rev. Omor Hufford. She was married to Arthur Rushton, January 4th, 1908, the Rev. Urban C. Braver officiating. Saturday marked the tenth anniversary of the marriage.

Upon removal to this community after marriage she placed her membership in the Christian church at Monrovia and has since remained an active and earnest member. When health permitted, her seat in the church was never vacant. Only one short week ago found her at the morning service though convalescing from serious illness.

She was interested in every department of church work and was instrumental in founding the present Ladies' Aid Society, the first meeting for the organization being held in her home at her call.

Though a faithful wife and interested in home duties she was always ready and willing to perform any work for the welfare of her friends or her church.

Hers was an ambitious and untiring disposition and in spite of frail health for the past few years, courage and determination have predominated and whether identified in church work or busied in affairs of the home she never for a moment considered failure.

The immediate surviving family is the husband, father, J. T. Yeager, and sister, Mary, both of Martinsville, sister, Mrs. C. R. Wilson, of Mooresville, and brother, Floyd, of Rushville. Mary, the little niece, who has lived in this home more than seven years, has grown to almost fill the place of a daughter. The funeral was held at the Christian church at one o'clock Sunday, Jan. 6th, conducted by Rev. J. W. Tudor. Burial at Hall cemetery.

Mrs. Rushton's Rites Held Today

Funeral services were held at 2 o'clock this afternoon in Mooresville for Mrs. Arthur Rushton, a woman long active in church and club affairs of the town as long as she was able.

Rites were conducted by her pastor, the Rev. Harold Criswell of First Methodist Church, at the Harvey Funeral Home. Burial followed in the Mooresville cemetery.

Mrs. Rushton, who had been ill for the last month, died at 1:30 Wednesday afternoon in the Jones Nursing Home in Spencer, having been a patient there for two and a half weeks.

A resident of Mooresville for 32 years, Mrs. Rushton had been especially active in First Methodist Church, having sung in its choir and worked in its Woman's Society of Christian Service. She had been a past worthy matron of the Order of Eastern Star, and had held membership in the Bay View Club and the Mooresville Woman's Club.

Formerly Mabel V. Mays, she was born in Belleville Dec. 11, 1880. Her parents, Stephen and Frances Tate Mays, had come to Indiana from North Carolina.

She was first married to Blanchard Horton and after his death in 1914 she married Mr. Rushton in February 1915.

Beside her husband, she leaves a son, Merrice Horton of Indianapolis, and three grandchildren.

The relatives and friends of Mrs. Arthur Rushton, of Monrovia, were grieved when the news of her death at three o'clock this morning was announced.

Mrs. Rushton had made a long and brave fight with sickness for more than a year, recovering at intervals from serious attacks but each time she suffered an attack grew weaker and less able to resist the inroads of the complications from which she suffered.

Her father, John Yeager, and her sister, Miss Mary Yeager, have spent many weeks in her home assisting to care for her and were with her until the end.

January 4th is the tenth anniversary date of the wedding of Mr. and Mrs. Rushton.

The funeral will be held at the church in Monrovia Sunday afternoon at one o'clock and the burial will be at Hall.

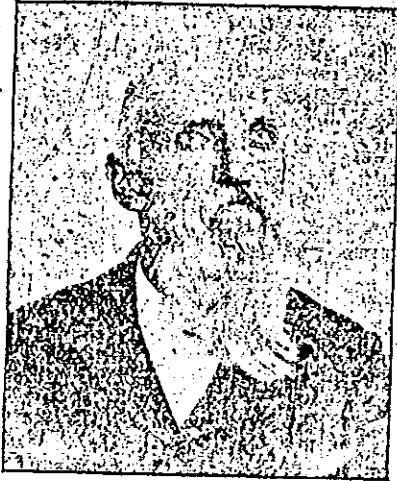

W. R. McCracken Dead.

William R. McCracken died at 1:00 o'clock p. m. Friday at his home on East Harrison street, of neuralgia of the heart.

He had been seized with his fatal sickness on Sunday, and his condition was regarded as critical until Thursday morning when he was much improved and continued so until Friday. That morning he felt so well that he insisted on eating some fried potatoes for his breakfast, but this diet was denied him. He ate a light breakfast with much relish and continued well until 11:00 o'clock when the neuralgic pains, of which he had been free for more than thirty-six hours, returned and brought death with them. He suffered severely and sank constantly from the moment of the re-appearance of these pains.



The deceased was surrounded by his relatives until Thursday evening when most of them departed for their homes.

feeling that he was perfectly safe, except that these pains might return. A brother and others remained to attend and watch over him.

He was born in this county and was in his sixty-third year. He had always made his home in the county and was well known among the citizens of the entire county.

He had been in the drug business in Moorovia for thirty-two years prior to his election to the office of County Recorder, in November, 1906. During sixteen years of that time he was justice of the peace. He moved to Martinville to attend to the duties of the office of recorder and continued his residence here after that time, purchasing a home here. Since his term of office he had opened an abstract office and had applied himself industriously to that work until the time of his fatal sickness.

He was first lieutenant in Company D, 70th regiment, during the Civil War. He went out with the regiment and remained out until the regiment returned—more than three years. He loved the record of his regiment and the cause for which they fought. He loved their comrades in the cause and remained an active member of the G. A. R. until his death.

He was also a Mason in good standing and an enthusiastic participant in the work of the order and of his lodge. He was a member of the Christian church.

Mrs. McCracken, who has been seriously sick for four weeks, was greatly shocked by the unexpected announcement of her husband's death, but bore up bravely throughout the ordeal.

His children are Charles McCracken, near Plainfield; Benjamin McCracken, who is in the West; Mrs. Cora Rushton, near Monrovia, and Will McCracken, who is deputy in the county recorder's office and has lived with his parents.

John, James, A. L. and Samuel, of Monrovia, and Steve McCracken, of Indianapolis, are his brothers. Misses Mary and Sarah McCracken and Mrs. Bethuel Stout, all of the vicinity of Monrovia, are surviving sisters; also Ruth, youngest child.

DON RUSHTON IS HURT FATALLY BY FALLING POLE

DIES FRIDAY NIGHT IN VETERANS
HOSPITAL IN INDIANAPOLIS
OF CHEST INJURIES

Injuries sustained in a fall from a utility pole resulted in the death of Don Rushton, age 42, Monrovia World War veteran, in the Veterans' hospital at Indianapolis early Friday night.

Mr. Rushton was working with Jess Turley, owner of the telephone line in the vicinity of Hall Friday when the fatal accident occurred. He had climb-

ed a pole and was inspecting the wiring when the pole, weakened with long service, broke. Mr. Rushton, who was strapped to the pole, attempted to free himself but was unable to do so and the heavy timber fell across his chest.

Realizing the seriousness of his injuries, friends rushed him to the hospital and x-rays indicated that his chest was crushed and a number of ribs were broken. Although suffering intense pain, Mr. Rushton remained conscious until a short time before his death.

Mr. Rushton was widely known in the Monrovia community, having spent most of his life there. He was a member of the Monrovia Christian church. He served with the American forces during the World War and was overseas for several months.

He leaves the wife, a daughter, Josephine, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Walter Rushton, a brother, Harry Rushton and several more distant relatives, including an aunt, Mrs. S. D. Blound, of Indianapolis, Charles and Ben McCracken, of Monrovia, and County Recorder Will McCracken, of this city and Art Rushton, of Mooresville.

Funeral services were held Monday forenoon at 10:30 o'clock at the home in Monrovia.

The services were conducted by Rev. Lindley Jones, pastor of West Union Friends church. Raymond Bray sang.

The pallbearers were Daniel Kirk, Lane Dillon, Elmer Shields, Roy Dillon, Paul Davis and Noah Schrader.

The flowers were carried by members of the American Legion Auxillary of Monrovia.

The burial was in the cemetery at Mooresville, a Legion squad conducted services at the grave.

B. H. McCracken Of Monrovia Dies

Benjamin Harrison McCracken, age 80, well-known resident of the Monrovia community, died at his home Thursday afternoon at 5 o'clock after an illness of one week.

He was brought to the Cure and Hensley Funeral Home here and today was returned to his residence on the County Line Road, two miles north and a mile and a half west of Monrovia, where friends are invited to call after 7 o'clock this evening.

Funeral services have been set for 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Hazelwood Christian Church, conducted by the pastor, the Rev. Richard Sutherlin, with the Monrovia Masonic Lodge taking part. Burial will be in the cemetery at Center Valley.

Mr. McCracken was a member of the Hazelwood church and of Masonic Lodge No. 74 at Martinsville, having brought his membership here in 1903 after receiving the degrees at Kokomo the preceding year. He had served as senior deacon and junior warden in his early years of membership. He was also a member of the American Poultry Association, was a licensed poultry judge, and had served as judge at state fairs.

At one time he was in the heating and tinning business in Martinsville, moving to the Monrovia farm in 1909. He lived there the remainder of his life with the exception of a few years at Kokomo and the period from 1924 to 1929 when he again lived in Martinsville. In more recent years he had served as road supervisor in Monroe Township.

The son of W. R. and Nannie L. Black McCracken, he was born Dec. 31, 1873, at Monrovia where he spent his boyhood. On Dec. 28, 1909, he was married to Miss Minnie Paralee Cain, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Dennis Cain, at Monrovia.

She survives her husband as does their daughter, Emeline Leon, now Mrs. Dalbert Lewis of Monrovia; a granddaughter, Sharolyn Lewis, and a brother, Will McCracken of Martinsville. Four brothers and sisters, Charles, Cora, Claude, and Anne, and a half-sister, Ruth, died a number of years ago.

H. C. McCracken, Monrovia, dies

A man long active in Monrovia community affairs died yesterday at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Indianapolis. He was Howard C. McCracken, who had held the longest active membership in the Monrovia Christian Church and who had served six times as master of Monrovia Lodge 654, F & A M.

Mr. McCracken, 71, had been ill five months and he had been in the hospital three weeks.

He was born May 8, 1891, son of James and Alice Dillon McCracken. His father was a Monrovia native, and his mother was born in North Carolina.

Injuries sustained in a fall from a utility pole resulted in the death of Don Rushton, age 41, Monrovia World War veteran, in the Veterans' hospital at Indianapolis early Friday night.

Mr. Rushton was working with Jess Turley, owner of the telephone line in the vicinity of Hall Friday when the fatal accident occurred. He had climbed a pole and was inspecting the wiring when the pole, weakened with long service, broke. Mr. Rushton, who was strapped to the pole, attempted to free himself but was unable to do so and the heavy timber fell across his chest.

Realizing the seriousness of his injuries, friends rushed him to the hospital and x-rays indicated that his chest was crushed and a number of ribs were broken. Although suffering intense pain, Mr. Rushton remained conscious until a short time before his death.

Mr. Rushton was widely known in the Monrovia community, having spent most of his life there. He was a member of the Monrovia Christian church. He served with the American forces during the World War and was overseas for several months.

He leaves the wife, a daughter, Josephine, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Walter Rushton, a brother, Harry Rushton and several more distant relatives, including an aunt, Mrs. S. D. Blound, of Indianapolis, Charles and Ben McCracken, of Monrovia, and County Recorder Will McCracken, of this city.

The body will be returned to Monrovia, where funeral services and burial will be conducted Sunday or Mon-

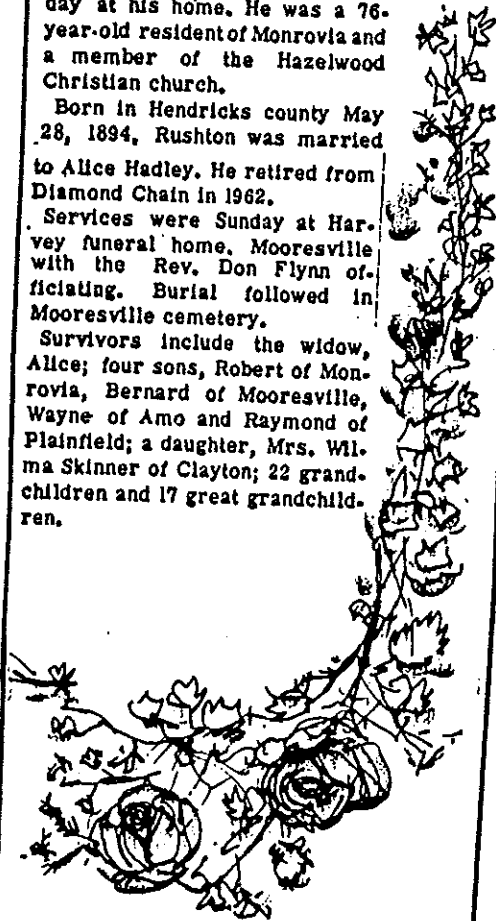
