pages 402-05: Will of JOHN READ dated 17 Aug 1765.

JOHN READ of the County of Culpeper being sick and weak of body. I lend to beloved wife WINEFRED during her natural life the following slaves to wit Tom and Jeny and after her decease Tom unto my beloved son THEOPHILUS and Jenny unto my son JOHN READ.

Unto my daughter MARY (now decd) who was the wife of JOSEPH NORMAN one shilling current money.

Unto my beloved son JOHN READ one negro boy Peter in trust upon this special proviso that after the said slave arrives to the age of sixteen years my said son JOHN shall allow and pay unto my daughter WINIFRED, the wife of JOHN SHACKELFORD in nessary (?) clothing and apperel the sum of six pounds current money to be laid out the best advantage yearly and every year during both the lives of the said WINEFRED and Negro Peter aforesaid. Nevertheless if the said WINEFRED should out live her said husband then I give the said Negro Peter to her but if she should died before her husband I give the said Negro Peter to my said son JOHN READ.

Unto my daughter Elizageth the wife of STEPHEN JETT one gold ring.

Unto my beloved son JOHN READ one Negro boy Cato. Also to my said JOHN by (sic) great black walnut chest.

Unto my beloved son HANKENSON the land whereon he now lives with all

the stocks, tools thereon. Also the following slaves to wit Great Cato and Little Moll.

Unto my beloved son THEOPHILUS READ one Negro woman Moll and one Negro girl Judy.

Unto my beloved son JAMES one Negro man Adam, one Negro woman Hanah and one child Nann.

Unto the children of my daughter ANN (the wife of HUGH FREEMAN) to be equally divided between them at the death of my said daughter ANN one negro girl Lilley, one feather bed and furniture and one cow and calf, the whole being now in the possession of said HUGH FREEMAN.

Unto my granddaughter MARY NORMAN one feather bed and furniture and one cow and calf.

Unto my sons JOHN AND HANKERSON my cart wheals and whip saw reserving to my wife the use of the wheels during her life.

I lend the use of the plantation and lott whereon I now live with all the house hold furniture, stocks and tools of all kinds (not before bequeathed) unto my beloved wife WINEFRED during her natural life and after her decd. to be equally divided between my town sons THEOPHILUS and JAMES.

In case anything should be recovered of WILLIAM EASTMAN and others at the General Court concerning a debt my self and MR. JETT paid for STEPHEN JETT, I give my proportion to be equally divided between the children of STEPHEN JETT by my daughter ELIZABETH.

I do appoint my beloved sons JOHN READ and HANKERSON READ exeors:

JOHN M. SHACKELFORD enlisted February 1863 Co. C 4th Virginia Cavalry, Wickham's Brigade, Fitz Lee's Division; wounded at Five Forks, April 2, 1865 ; captured at Richmond VA April 4, 1865. Held there.

Company B 6th Virginia Cavalry casualties included:
JOHN SHACKELFORD GREEN, Major, Lieutenant Colonel, Colonel 6th VA Cav twice wounded; died since the war.

Judge HENRY SHACKELFORD, citizen, was one of eight prisoners taken by Federal Army from village of Culpeper.

Lost Link

Mr. A.L. Murray of 204 Belvidere Drive, San Antonio, TX 78212 wrote September 1986 he had FERGUSON ancestors. He adds that a "prayer

book" in the family of ancestor WILLIAM FERGUSON has written in it: "PEGGY SHACKLEFORD, daughter of SUSANNAH RICHARDS and WILLIAM SHACKLEFORD, born the 23 May 1798". 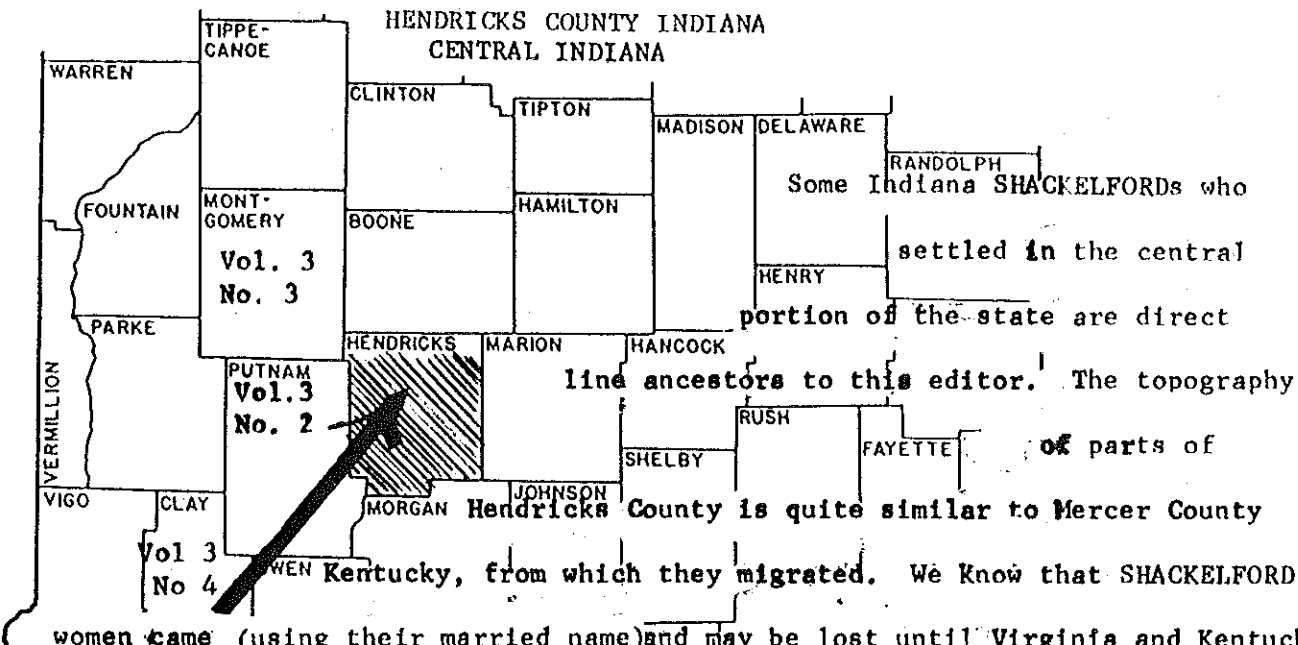

Some Indiana SHACKELFORDs who settled in the central portion of the state are direct line ancestors to this editor. The topography of parts of Hendricks County is quite similar to Mercer County Kentucky, from which they migrated. We know that SHACKELFORD women came (using their married name) and may be lost until Virginia and Kentucky marriage records help to identify the women. The following Hendricks County, IN marriages reveal some of this editor's direct line, and also another branch that came from a county other than Mercer (KY). Although the two groups may have been Indiana neighbors, neither oral nor written family stories indicate any 'clan-contacts' between the families. In reality they did share blood lines, with their own ancestors as brothers. Out of Hendricks Co IN they flowed into surrounding counties leaving traces in other county records. We hope to find descendants of some of these marriages and other identifying Hendricks records. We will be looking forward to hearing from our readership and publish further.

I am very tired staying here and wish to be employed at something profitable, since I returned the last time I have taken six pills and one or two doses of salt & water You will find my will about the first of the New Testament, if the Hords & Judge Reed are satisfied, I ought to be I had a good deal of business to settle but must give it up I am trying to finish my course with joy. If I should not be spared to see you again in this world I hope I shall meet you where parting is not known. My love to Mother and Giles. I hope you will see Anne Maria often and tell her to write me a letter agreeable to my view of right she ought to wrote before this time.

In the name of God, I, WILLOUGHBY T. YOUNG, a citizen of Mason County
Kentucky being confined at the Hospital at Lexington being in possession of
disposing memory do make this my last will and Testament this Eleventh day
of December in the year of Our Lord 1838.

Item: All the property it has pleased God to bless me with I give to my
mother JUDITH YOUNG and Sister MARGARET COOKE, during their natural lives,
after paying my just debts the ballance is to pass by the law of Decettss.
My Daughter ANNE MARIA to be decently clothed and supported until she
Marrys or arrives to the age of twenty one years, then to inherit what may
be left, subject however to the controls of my Execs.

Item: My will and desire is that the quarter section of land in Daviess
County, Indiana Patented to PRESLEY DAY be sold and the tract west of
the Flemingsburg Road I bought of E.S. PEPPER being by survey made to
contain twenty seven acres one half and twenty poles also my two tracts
in Campbell one on Bond Creek, the other being my interest in ROBERT YOUNG S
Preemption or so much as will pay my just debts the large tract covering
Mount Gillead to be investigated, the land on Mill Creek to be rented out,
the Claim on Genl Government to be investigated so soon as the papers are
obtained from N.D. COLEMAN, the Servants to which I am entitled now in
possession of my Mother to be liberated as soon as they clear fifty acres
of land on the west Fork of White River Indiana for my Daughter, for
doing of which I request my DAUGHTER to give them the wood to enable them
to purchase land for themselves. lastly I do appoint my freinds GEORGE
CHISM & PETER LASHBROOKES my Executors of this my last will and testament.

The tract on Bond Creek was given up by SQUIRE GRAT to satisfy an

conveyed to me at what the land may be worth believing proper to be paid, when

HARLAN COUNTY, KENTUCKY

Harlan County was formed 1819 out of Knox County, KY. The first census available is 1820. Located in the southeastern part of Kentucky, this county borders Lee County, Virginia and very near Tennessee border.

A History of Harlan County by Mabel Green Condon (1962), is a volume mostly of reminiscence and general history on pioneer flora/fauna, dress and etc. It is often difficult to pinpoint the time era of which the author refers.

With no other reference the author makes the following statement: "HENRY SHACKLEFORD, a Revolutionary Soldier, came into Harlan about 1801, according to his pension application."

"In 1826 HENRY SHACKELFORD bought land from WILLIAM SPURLOCK on Martin's Fork."

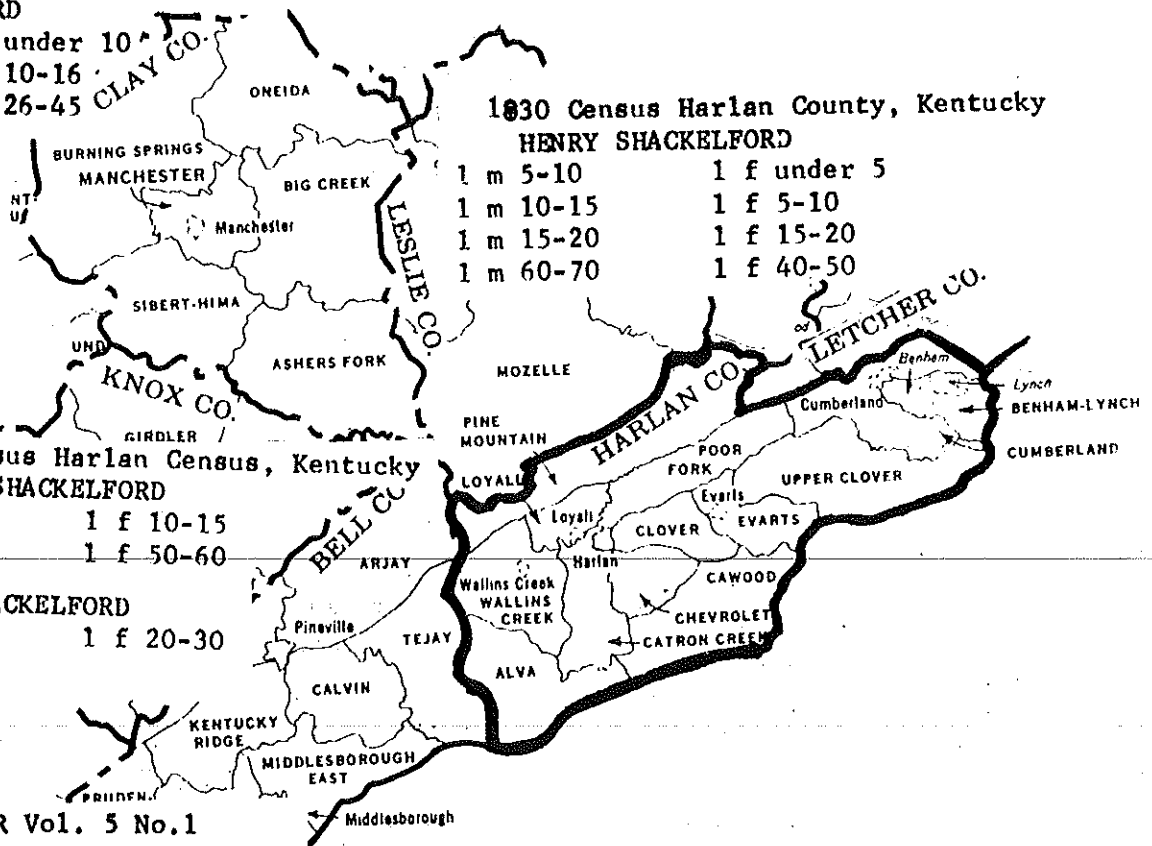

JAMES SHACKELFCRD as found in the 1870 Harlan County census (#141) enlisted in the Union Army at Irvine, Kentucky in Estill County. Pvt. Co F 47th. 47th Kentucky Mounted Infantry formed at Irvine 5 October 1863. The veterans were transferred to Battery E and to the 4th Kentucky Vet. Infantry after the 47th was disbanded at Lexington 26 Dec 1864. History of this outfit (47th) may be found in The Union Regiments Of Kentucky... Union Soldiers and Sailors Monument Association (1891).

Are you looking for a JAMES COX SHACKELFORD? We believe there was no such person. See the following:

Kentucky SHACKELFORD researchers have passed around the name JAMES COX SHACKELFORD which this editor suspects is a grave error caused by misreading and careless interpretation of the following document once published in T.K. Jones's Shackelford Clan Magazine:

Camp Disappointment May 3 1813

To Captain JAMES SHACKELFORD:

Sir: I have this day read a letter from Lt. Col. JAMES COX, Commander 12th Kentucky Dept. of Ky Militia, in which I am directed to disband the Battalion under my command and that the same be exhonored from any further service under the law in the pursuance of which it was organized. You will consequently proceed to discharge the company under your command in any way which you may deem most convenient.

I am respectfully your obedient servant CHARLES CARTER, Major
(followed by the list of names of men in James Shackelford's company).

Jones further commented in The Shackelford Clan Magazine said JAMES had enlisted under Captain James Cox of Casey County Kentucky. This sentence could have been misunderstood to mean the name "Cox" belonged to JAMES SHACKELFORD.

See Kentucky Soldiers of War 1812 Report of Adjutant General by M. Wilder pg 244 for further proof JAMES SHACKELFORD served this war.

In no records elsewhere have been found the name JAMES COX SHACKELFORD...only JAMES !

James may have been about age 31 during service of War 1812. He was about age 96 and living in Casey County Kentucky when he applied for pension.

SHACKELFORD, the maternal grandfather, also of Virginia, served as a soldier and Captain in War of 1812. Mr. CONDIFF's parents both died in Casey County (LOUISA SHACKELFORD CONDIFF at ae 75 and W.B. CONDIFF at ae 83.) W.B. CONDIFF was a farmer and a minister of Baptist Church. Six issue: ADALINE A. CONDIFF, ELIZABETH CONDIFF, SARAH CONDIFF, JOHN CONDIFF (who was a soldier in the 13th KY), JAMES S. CONDIFF AND W.C.

JAMES SHACKELFORD CONDIFF learned trade of painter in Kentucky & made a career of this occupation in lifetime.

He married March 1861 ELLEN C. CHILTON, a d/o CHARLES CHILTON a Baptist Minister and wife POLLY BERNARD. Both parents d in Kentucky. In 1882 JAMES S. & ELLEN moved to Vandalia, Fayette Co Illinois. Two years later (1884) they came to Mulberry. Eleven issue: LAURA A CONDIFF, AMANDA CONDIFF, BERSHEBA CONDIFF, MARY CONDIFF, ELIZA CONDIFF, JOHN HARLON CONDIFF, LUCY E. CONDIFF, JAMES GARFIELD CONDIFF, LEWIS VERGILLIS CONDIFF, CHARLES W. CONDIFF and LORENZO DOW CONDIFF.....

(Ed. Note: Information gathered by this desk indicates that LOUISA SHACKELFORD was the daughter of RICHARD B. SHACKELFORD, Minister of Christian Church and wife TABITHA BALDOCK, d/o LEVI BALDOCK & ANN ROBINS. RICHARD B. AND TABITHA md 14 November 1788 in Lincoln Co KY. LOUISA and WILLIAM CUNDIFF md 23 March 1829 in Casey County KY. We believe the JAMES SHACKELFORD mentioned as father in this write-up is actually an Uncle to JAMES SHACKELFORD CONDIFF/CUNDIFF. Both RICHARD B. AND JAMES were sons of ZACHARIAH SHACKELFORD (Rev. Vet) AND WIFE DOLLY EMBREE. Further proof comes from a 1974 CUNDIFF researcher: Mrs Cook Cundiff/McCown's Ferry Road/ Versailles KY 40383 who said WILLIAM BUTLER CUNDIFF was called "Buck" b 4-1-1809 d 1-11-1888. JOHN JOSEPH SHACKELFORD.

Mildred Martin, Rt.#4 Box 313, Ripley MS 38663 has contributed a lot of data. Due to lack of space the information will have to be divided among issues. The following is combination of oral history supplemented by courthouse records.

Tippah County Historical Research collected bios on pioneers of that county. Mildred Martin contributed the following article from this collection. No date was given on the copy.

J.J. SHACKELFORD was born in Abbeville District S.C. March 14, 1822. JOHN J. moved with his family to Mississippi in 1843 when J.J. SHACKELFORD was about 21 years of age. He owned a fine mule that he wanted to keep so he rode this mule all the way from S.C. to Mississippi buying land and settling in what is now the Mitchell neighborhood...a large snow on the ground when they arrived. They decided to buy a tract of land and not try to go farther. They built them a small log house while later other families of the SHACKELFORD bought a large tract of land from an agent in Holly Springs, Mississippi, divided and homestead this land. Mr. SHACKELFORD lived on this same tract of land until he was 84 years of age. He built a nice home of which was destroyed by fire after he became an old man. Mr. SHACKELFORD was married twice. His first marriage was to Miss RHODA JONES, who lived only a few years--then in Dec. 1853 he was married to Miss SARAH LONG, a beautiful and accomplished young lady who was ever an inspiration and help to her husband.

Mr. SHACKELFORD was a teacher...He filled the office of Magistrate and was Supervisor several terms, was always one among the leading citizens in his community, was a Master Mason---a deacon in Old Clear Creek Baptist church of which was organized in 1858. He always took an active part in his church work. He came to this county when it was new and very scarcely settled, in fact he grew up with the county and was one of the most substantial Pioneer citizens of Tippah County. He helped develop and made great this section of a great commonwealth. When the Civil War came he was appointed to look after home affairs in the District and etc.

Mr. and Mrs. SHACKELFORD owned not a fine but a happy home and reared a large family of interesting and useful children both men and women who were educated and refined. Mr. and Mrs. SHACKELFORD possessed that old fashioned spirit of welcoming and lived with the latch string on the outside of the door where friends and neighbors could enter anytime. Their children married and went out as leaders of their communities.

GEORGE, by his first wife, married Miss LUCY DANIEL; Mrs. ELIZABETH ANDERSON; SAMUEL GIBSON who married Miss SALLIE MORTON; Mrs. DONIA TIGREET; Mrs. SALLIE MARTIN; JOHN HENRY, a noted and much beloved Baptist preacher married Miss MARY LOU COVINGTON; JAS. W. who married Miss LULA COLLINS; Mrs. OPHIE SMITH; JOE J. who married #1 Miss MYRTLE STORY and #2 to Miss VIOLA MCKINNON; HUGH who married Miss LESSIE MORGAN. These children all have families who are leaders and helpers in their respective town and communities.

Mr. and Mrs SHACKELFORD were real Pioneers who believe in making a living at home, were leaders in the church and school attending the sick and helping the needy, their home was surrounded by an orchard of fine fruits of all kinds gardens of vegetables of all kinds, their barns were filled with corn and feed stuff with plenty of livestock and etc. These pioneers were the grandparents of Mrs. ETHEL WALLACE one of our helpers on Tippah County Historical Research.

Leaves 40 grandchildren.

Subscriber Mildred Martin and family believe John Joseph (J.J.) Shackelford's full name was JOHN JOSEPH JEFFERSON SHACKELFORD. John Joseph Jefferson Shackelford used three given names for a son (GEORGE W.W.) and three daughters (MARY ANN ELIZABETH SHACKELFORD, CATHERINE J. CALADONIA SHACKELFORD, and SARAH ADELINE JANE SHACKELFORD). Not all descendants agree, with some accepting his name as JOHN JOSEPH SHACKELFORD.

Richard Ellis is the son of PHILLIP R ELLIS and wife ELIZABETH SHACKELFORD who migrated to Hendricks County IN from Mercer County KY with other ELLIS-s. PHILLIP died about 1841 in Hendricks Co. RICHARD ELLIS appears back in Kentucky in 1850 living with his maternal grandparents ZACHARIAH SHACKELFORD & wife FRANCES ROSS in Madison County. His sister MILDRED ELLIS also returned to Kentucky where she married her first cousin ZACHARIAH SHACKELFORD, son of RICHARD SHACKELFORD & wife ELIZA DEAN. At this marriage the elder ZACHARIAH was listed as guardian to his granddaughter MILDRED. Before 1860 (ca 1855) the bride/groom ZACHARIAH & MILDRED, along with RICHARD ELLIS and others returned to Hendricks County IN from Kentucky. RICHARD ELLIS md in Hendricks County MARY E. SMITHY September 25, 1858 Book 5 pg 271. Many many probate records exist in Hendricks County IN on Phillip R Ellis estate for the 1840's. We know that ELIZABETH SHACKELFORD ELLIS was living on 21 April-1841 when letters on the estate were granted to JAMES GREEN and the renunciation of the widow was filed. JAMES GREEN filed the widow's receipt for \$81.31 in May 1844. She may have been living then (1844), but GREEN could have given her the receipt in 1841 and merely filed late. We do not know when ELIZABETH SHACKELFORD ELLIS died. We are sure of only two of her children: MILDRED and RICHARD ELLIS. It is possible she had more children, unknown at this time.

Descendants of ZACHARIAH & MILDRED (ELLIS) SHACKELFORD today live in Mercer County Kentucky in Harrodsburg/Salvisa area. MILDRED died in Hendricks Co IN sometime in the 1860's, and it is said ZACHARIAH put his children in a spring-wagon and departed Indiana for his parents and relatives in Mercer County after Mildred died. Thus, this group returned to a place of long roots in Kentucky after a brief residence (off and on) in Indiana.

The previous pages have given records on HAYDEN (HADE) SHACKELFORD of Guilford Township, and ZACHARIAH SHACKELFORD and the ELLIS group. These two men were brothers of JOSPEH SHACKELFORD who also married in Hendricks County, Indiana but moved over to Putnam County Indiana. All three men were s/o Mercer County, Kentucky RICHARD SHACKELFORD and wife ELIZA DEAN.

It is not easy to tell a descendant he is claiming the wrong ancestor. Especially when the information was picked up from a published family history. This is frustrating for everyone concerned. Because it happens now and again, it is time to review the problem in regard to this newsletter.

Libraries readily bind into hard cover, or place on file (accessible to public use) contributed work on family history. Just because it is between cover on a library shelf, or in a library file does not guarantee accuracy. Family histories are seldom documented, nor are resources cited.

In the case of SHACKELFORD, researchers more often refer to T.K. JONES (desc.d), Lubbock, TX who edited/published Shackelford Clan Magazine (see Shackelford Newsletter Vol. 2 No. 1 1984). Some subscribers to this newsletter still refer to correspondence they had with JONES, using JONES as their proof. JONES supplied us with errors that have been copied over and over these past forty years into the 1980's. He also supplied us with good clues to further investigate!

Everyone's aim is to go straight back to our one immigrant ROGER SHACKEL(LE)FORD. A large gap often baffles us between ROGER and what you know. The temptation is there to "hook onto" a family because of similarity in given names(s). Like most families, the SHACKELFORDS used given names over and over for children within generations and in succeeding generations. An example is JOHN SHACKELFORD. In this example, to compound the problem several JOHN SHACKELFORDS married women named ANN(E). It is easy to confuse the JOHN and ANN couples, and grab a set for your own. One needs to identify by #1. Time Period #2. County/State Residence/MIGRATION. To further complicate matters, T.K.JONES was often guilty of confusing couples of same-name and passing on the errors in correspondence and onto family sheets (LDS).

Some descendants have no library at their disposal for research. Some descendants neglect to investigate courthouse records, even by mail. Result: little or no effort is made to provide documentation of fact!

The Fort Wayne Public Library genealogy department rates among the top three genealogy archives in the nation. SHACKELFORD documentation is found here on microfilm, microfiche, and in volumes. Since these are secondary (mostly) sources, we can only hope the compilings are accurate. These findings are published in this newsletter, with sources cited, for your records.

Shackelford Newsletter further assists by requesting each subscriber to submit for publication their earliest four generations they know. In 90% of the cases, this begins with grandparents and three preceding generations.

By supplying family history we know by oral tradition, and supplemented by county records we are able to identify correct lineal descent. Often readers identify with what may be sibling information and are able to tie-in to the same line.

This editor does not have every SHACKELFORD line researched, and cannot come up with an immediate answer of the question "WHO ARE THE PARENTS?" (repeatedly requested). The answer will be up to you, the reader, to find from the documentation provided in Shackelford Newsletter.
