The Snodgrass Clan has been formally organized by incorporating under the laws of the State of Indiana as a not-for-profit corporation, with its office at 2444 Lafayette Road, Indianapolis, Ind., 46222, and Scott F. Hosier Jr. is Convenor of the Clan, and editor of THE MACE. The Snodgrass are a lowland Scotch family and never had a chieftan as did the highland clans. We believe there to be only one origin, and therefore everyone by the name is related, and therefore all Snodgrasses and their descendents are considered to automatically belong by birthright. Dues to THE MACE is \$7.50 a year and is not prorated but subscribers in mid-year receive the back issues for that year.

We organized our clan in order to promote fellowship among our family; to gather and disseminate genealogical information; and to reinforce our awareness of our heritage in the Scotch lowlands, in the Ulster Plantation in Ireland, and in the settlement and taming of 'the middle border' (western Pennsylvania, the Valley of Virginia, Eastern Tennessee and Kentucky).

Being Scotch originally, we naturally have our own plaid, properly registered with the governing authorities. We have had it woven and have a supply on hand. It is a soft green, quite heavy (13 oz to the square yard), 54" wide and all wool at only \$30.00 a yard. Our inventory went last long and orders will be filled in turn until our supply is gone. If any of the men want a kilt, it takes  $3\frac{1}{2}$  yards and I can supply a pattern.

The material published in THE MACE is contributed by the membership, and queries concerning Snodgrass ancestry are invited and published without charge to subscribers. We are in the process of publishing all the Census records pertaining to Snodgrass. We are especially solicitous of contributions of material before 1800 in Pennsylvania, Southwestern Virginia and Eastern Tennessee before 1820, and Bourbon and Harrison Co., Ky., before 1820. These areas are the main tangles in the genealogy and we believe that the rest of the genealogy can be laid out without any substantial difficulty.

As you keep sending additional information, and I keep filling in the cracks, a very large amount of genealogical information has already been accumulated. We believe we will be adding 'word processing' capabilities to our computer in a month or two. When that happens, we will begin transferring our data to the computer for greater ease in editing and locating information already in hand, and the correlation of all of it. For instance, we keep our files in order by the given name of the male, and it is almost impossible for me to find a daughter or wife without knowing the husband's name. Once the data has been computerized, it will be available 'camera ready' for the printer on demand. I anticipate that we will be ready to turn out our first volume about the beginning of 1983. Many of you have already sent in the information about yourself and your closer relatives, and many have not. You all know what family group sheets are. Get yourself a supply and start filling them out, or the printed history will come out without even mentioning your name! I do not have a crystal ball and you are just going to have to tell me.

We expect to have the third issue out about Sept. 15th and the 4th before Christmas.

Query:

Mrs. Joy Snodgrass Brown, 1212 Glade, College Station, TX 77840.  
I would like to hear of any information regarding anyone named Snodgrass in Missouri between 1800 and 1825; especially in Cooper Co., Missouri. Or any information about a William Snodgrass who was on the 1830 and 1840 Cooper Co., Missouri census. I would especially like to know if this William Snodgrass was the father of Joseph Snodgrass who married Sarah Hooser 1 Dec. 1825 in Cooper Co., MO.

Does anyone know who the husband of Lucy Snodgrass age 64 born in Va. on the 1850 Cooper Co., MO census was? Two others were shown with her, Nancy Snodgrass age 30 born in MO and Ellen age 28 born in MO. I believe this Nancy Snodgrass married John D. Hooser 13 Jan. 1854 in Cooper Co., Mo. He was the brother of Sarah (Hooser) Snodgrass. John died in 1865 and Nancy, his wife, died in 1905 both are buried in the Harris Cemetery in Cooper Co., MO. In the early marriage records of Cooper Co., Mo. there is an Edward Snodgrass who married a Nancy Harris 19 Dec. 1830 and the same or another Edward Snodgrass who married Lucy Harris 21 Feb. 1836. Are they buried in this Harris Cemetery and were they related to the Hooser couple? And was this actually Edmund Snodgrass rather than Edward? On the 1840 Cooper Co., Mo. census page 137 no. 4 there is an Edmund Snodgrass and listed next is John Harris. In 1850 there is an Edmond Snodgrass with a wife Lucy and six children and next is John Harris with a wife and son and two Snodgrass children who may have been the children of Edmond/Edward and Nancy (Harris) Snodgrass. Can anyone help straighten these early Snodgrass families out?

In 1825 if a girl was under the age of 16 did she have to have parental consent to marry? Did a boy?

I believe that the age of consent has been 18 for a girl and 21 for a boy and has been that for centuries, and the father is legally entitled to the full services of the children till then, and without compensation, being obligated only to provide them with food, shelter, clothing, and training in some occupation. Even to-day the children are not counted as employees for the Social security tax until they are 21 years of age. We have several members that are lawyers, and perhaps one of them would know what the law has been in various jurisdictions at different times. It would be a help to know.

QUERY

I am trying to find the name of the father of my g-grandmother Ellen Day Snodgrass. She was always known as Ella. She was born on 15 Sept. 1858 in Wyandotte County, Kansas. From her death certificate we have learned that her mothers name was Isabella Ferguson and that her father was a Snodgrass, but no first name was give.

From family members we have learned that Ella was a nieghbor of Jesse James when she lived in Kansas and that he was a visitor at their home on several occasions. The way I am told, Ellas father was a 'lawman', this we have never proven and he must of died while she was young and her mother then remarried to a man named Sanders. Ella returned to the Pittsburgh, Pa. area around the 1870's with a brother and sister that used the name of Sanders. It is not known if they had taken Sanders name or if they were Sanders children from another marriage. Ella once made the remark that she didn't care if her name was '##?' she would never change it until she married. This remark leads us to believe that the brother and sister were Snodgrass children, they were John and Sally.

If anyone can give us help on this end of the family it would be appreciated a great deal. Ella married the widower Albert Anderson who had three children and had eight more by him. She died in 1922.

Kansas City Times, Kansas City, Mo., October 5, 1963  
 LILBURN E. SNODGRASS, 66, of 2401 Meyer Boulevard, died yesterday at St.  
 Mary's Hospital. He was born in Springfield, Mo., and lived here 60 years.  
 He was a postoffice clerk 42 years before retiring in 1962. Mr. Snodgrass  
 was a veteran of World War I and was a member of the Independence Boulevard  
 Christian Church. He was a member of the Postoffice post of the American  
 Legion, and the National Association of Retired Civil Service Employees.  
 Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Anna K. Snodgrass of the home; a son, L. E.  
 Snodgrass, jr., 8131 McGee; a sister, Mrs. Jessie Lee Harris, Springfield,  
 and three grandchildren. Services will be held at 3 o'clock Monday at the  
 Floral Hills chapel; burial in the Floral Hills Memorial Gardens. Friends  
 may call after 2 o'clock Sunday at the chapel.

SAMUEL SNODGRASS

Samuel Snodgrass was born 16 June 1754 in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. He lived in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania near "the Falling Spring", four miles from Chambersburg, in 1776 when he was drafted into the militia as a "common soldier" (a private) for a two month term under Captain Ryer, also of Cumberland County. With 55-60 men in the Company, he marched from Chambersburg, by way of Little York and Lancaster, to Philadelphia, and thence to Trenton, New Jersey and to "Princetown". The brief, but not his personal statements, from his pension application states that he also served a two month term under Captain John Andrews of Pennsylvania in the latter part of 1776. In 1777, in Cumberland County, he was again drafted for a two month term under Captain James Poe. In the forepart of 1777, he was again called for a two month term and marched under Captain William Long of Cumberland County, to Allentown and Adamstown in Pennsylvania, but received orders to return home after three or four weeks as there were no provisions at their intended destination. In his final term of service, he was in one skirmish at the White Marsh and another between Valley Forge and (Lone ?) Horse, commanded by Potts, in which he received a wound in his leg which, however, was "sound and well" years later at the time of his pension application. He was discharged in Lancaster, Pennsylvania in 1778.

The Pennsylvania tax lists show the following for one Samuel Snodgrass:<sup>2</sup>

- 1779 - Matick (Martick) Township, Lancaster County, 75 Acres, 2 horses, 2 cows.
- 1781/2 - Guilford Township, Cumberland County (Franklin County?)
- 1783 - Tyrone Township, Westmoreland County, 1 horse, 2 cows, 5 whites

A Samuel Snodgrass served in 1786 in the Company of Captain Fitzgerald, Franklin County, Second battalion.<sup>3</sup> However, in his pension application, our subject Samuel Snodgrass makes no mention of Franklin County, of Fitzgerald, or of service at such a late date. Undocumented statements of a researcher indicate that one Samuel Snodgrass of Franklin County was mentioned in 1793 York County Pennsylvania will of a James Snodgrass. The 1790 Pennsylvania census shows Samuel Snodgrass, Washington County, page 258, 1 free white male age 16 and over, 3 free white females age 16 and over, 3 free white males under age 16. While Franklin County, page 121 shows 3 free white males age 16 and over, no males under age 16 and 2 free white females.

"After the war" Samuel Snodgrass, our subject, resided from eight to ten years in Pennsylvania, then moved to L\_\_\_\_\_ River, Rockbridge County, Virginia where he lived approximately sixteen to eighteen years.<sup>1</sup> Rockbridge County was formed in 1778. We know nothing of Samuel's parentage but Robert Snodgrass, in his 1795 Rockbridge County will, names Samuel as his brother and joint executor of his will.<sup>4</sup>

Belief is that Samuel Snodgrass married Rebecca Devor or Dover. A daughter, Rebecca Snodgrass, is mentioned in the 1800 will of Elizabeth Devor, South Hampton Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.<sup>2</sup> This would imply that Rebecca Devor Snodgrass was alive in 1800, whereas our subject, Samuel Snodgrass, married Elizabeth Adair in Rockbridge County, Virginia on 22 November 1792 (at an approximate age of 38 years), in a ceremony performed by James Houston, VDM.<sup>5,6</sup> Elizabeth is presumed to have been born in Virginia.<sup>7</sup> It is also presumed that James Adair and wife Isabella were the parents of Elizabeth since, on 24 November 1808, they ~~left~~<sup>sold</sup> the Snodgrass couple 211 acres adjoining Snodgrass land, on the waters of Broad Creek, Rockbridge County, Virginia.<sup>8</sup> *DOS ANYONE KNOW WHICH SNODGRASS DID MARRY REBECCA DOVER?*

There is little more than the following information on these; all appears to be undocumented except as cited:

- A. Samuel Snodgrass, born Pennsylvania 1781, married Susannah Mc Casland 24 June 1804 in Virginia, died July 1835 in Decatur, Indiana
- B. Nancy Snodgrass, born Rockbridge Virginia 1794, married Daniel Baker.
- C. James Snodgrass, born 1795 in Virginia, Married 1 September 1825 to Abigail Mendenhall (ancestors appear in family records as Mendenhale, Mildenhale etc) in Greene County, Ohio.<sup>10,11</sup> Occupation was farmer.<sup>12</sup> Served in war of 1812.<sup>10</sup> Died as widower Jefferson Township, Greene County, Ohio 20 April 1882.<sup>12</sup> Wife Abigail died 6 July 1870, Jamestown, Silver Creek, Township, Ohio.<sup>13</sup>

James Snodgrass is shown in Silver Creek, Greene County, Ohio census from 1830 to 1870 and, in 1880 is listed under his daughter Mrs. George (Lucinda) Karns. James Snodgrass lists his birthplace as Virginia, father's birthplace as Pennsylvania, mother's birthplace as Virginia. John Snodgrass, one of the children of James and Abigail Snodgrass, immigrated to Greene County, Iowa in 1854 and is shown in the census there in 1860 through 1880 when he reported his father (James) as born in Virginia, his mother (Abigail) as born in Ohio and himself as born in Ohio. Other Snodgrass families are shown in Greene County and in Jackson County Iowa by 1870.

- D. Robert Snodgrass, born Rockbridge County, Virginia 23 September 1800, married Phoebe Miller on 12 August 1825, died Greene County, Ohio on 31 March 1839.
- E. Joseph Snodgrass, born 15 September 1802, married Eliza Ballard, died 19 October 1883.
- F. John Snodgrass, born Champaign, Ohio 25 January 1812, married Jane Ballard, Died 29 April 1862
- G. Peggy Snodgrass, born Virginia, married Andrew Adair
- H. Elizabeth Snodgrass
- I. Phoebe Snodgrass, married M. W. Barr
- J. Sarah Snodgrass married Silas Toleman

Samuel and Elizabeth Snodgrass were granted one thousand acres of Virginia land on 17 August 1805. Of this, a 248 acre tract and a 209 acre tract were sold 9 April 1810 to Andrew Alexander. A 200 acre tract on Wolf Spring Run and other waters of Broad Creek in the southern part of Rockbridge County was sold 11 August 1810 to Samuel Summers. Two hundred acres was also sold to Samuel Adair (Peggy Snodgrass married an Adair) but no deed was located for this latter transaction.<sup>14</sup> This was a total of 857 acres conveyed by Snodgrass.

Land tax lists of Rockbridge County, Virginia (no source cited) show that Samuel Snodgrass and wife held land there through 1811 as follows:

- 1807 - 1000 acres
- 1809 - 1000 acres plus 211 acres from James Adair
- 1810 - 1000 acres
- 1811 - 343 acres

No further listings for Samuel Snodgrass

Samuel Snodgrass and family moved to Ohio in 1810 or 1811, and lived in Champaign (later Clarke) County near Springfield for two years. He lived in Ross Township, Greene County, Ohio (in the southwest part of Section 2 just west of Bellbrook) at least until his pension application on 20 September 1832.<sup>1</sup> The 1820 Ohio census for Sugar Creek Township, Greene County, shows other Snodgrass families who moved to Ohio: James, Robert, Sarah, and William. There is also a James Snodgrass in Crosby Township, Hamilton County and a William Snodgrass in Springfield Township. By 1830, forty-two Snodgrass families appeared in the 1830 index of Ohio census records.

James, the son of Samuel Snodgrass, stated that his parents moved to Champaign County, Ohio in 1808 and to Greene County sometime before 1819.<sup>10</sup> The 1820 census, page 138 of Ross Township, Greene County, Ohio shows Samuel and his household which then consisted of himself (born before 1775), two males (Robert and Joseph?) born between 1794-1802, two females (Nancy and \_\_\_\_\_?) born between 1794-1804, one male born between 1802-1804, and one male (John?) and one female born between 1810-1820. In the 1830 census, page 381, he is shown still in Greene County and the household included himself (stated as born between 1760-1770), one male and one female

born between 1800-1810, one male and one female born between 1810-1815. In the 1840 Ross Township census, page 275, his household included himself (born between 1750-1760), two males (John and \_\_\_\_\_?) and one female born between 1810-1820, and one female born between 1835-1840. Note that, while we do not have the date of the death of Elizabeth Adair Snodgrass, these census records might indicate that she had died some time earlier and that the child born between 1835-1840 would not have been her child. Note also that the female born 1810-1815 remains in the family during these census years.

Samuel Snodgrass' will<sup>9</sup> of 22 April 1842 states that he is of Greene County, Ohio. Samuel Snodgrass died 6 May 1844 and was buried in Silver Creek Cemetary, Jamestown, Ohio.<sup>15</sup>

In addition, deed book K, page 81,83 shows a deed of 50 acres to Robert, which his executors aquired by grant.

Rockbridge County deed book F 380, shows a conveyance 3 October 1808 by Samuel Moore Sr. to Elizabeth, Nancy and Robert Snodgrass, all orphens of Robert Snodgrass deceased, Samuel Moore had married the orphen's mother and now wished to convey any interest in any property that had belonged to her prior to their marriage.

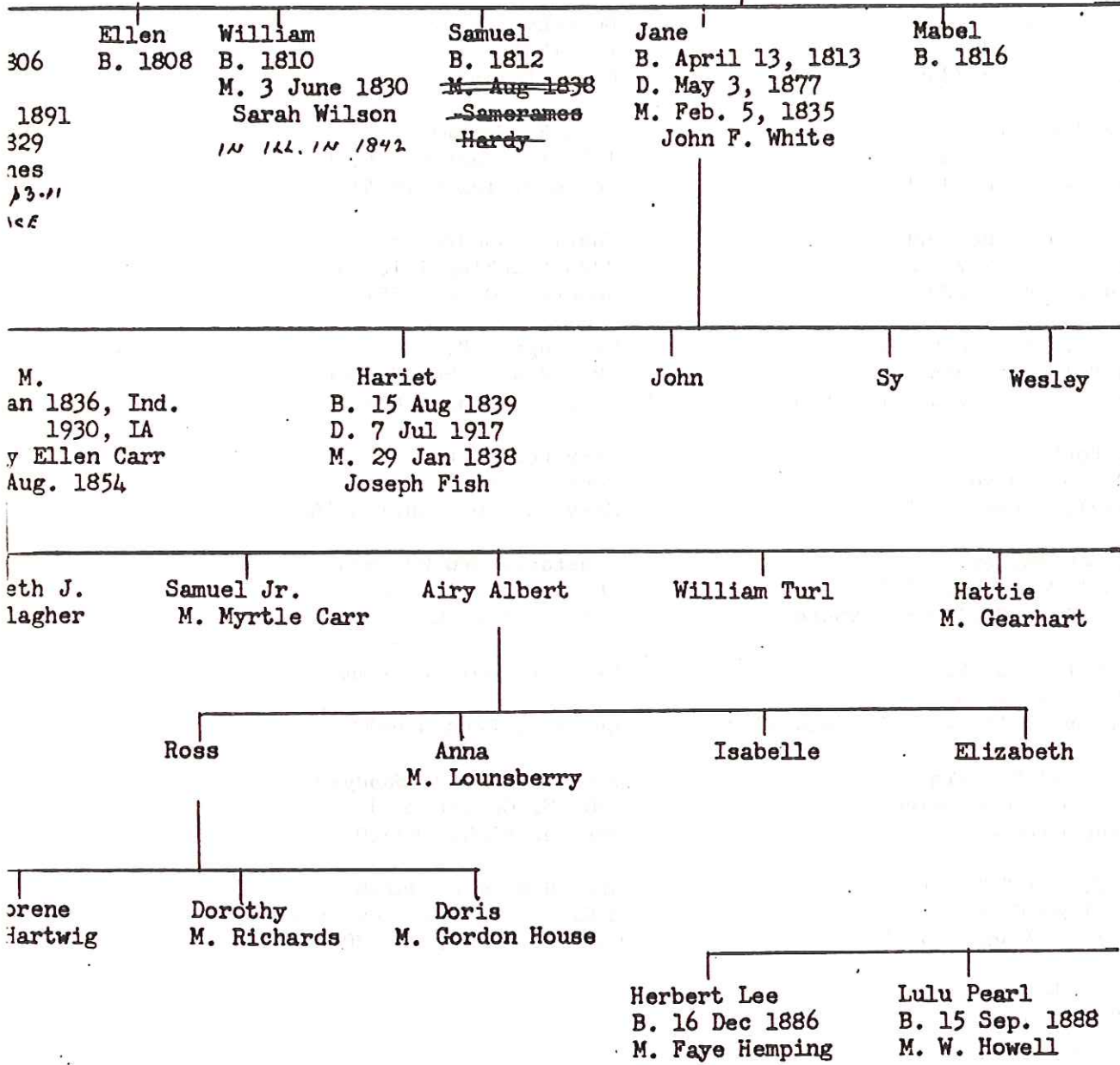

I want to call your special attention to the rather long biography of Samuel Snodgrass (1754-1844) so ably prepared by Constance Wustman. He is one of a handful of ancestors of crucial importance in the development of a complete genealogy of the Snodgrass family. In spite of all that is given in these five pages, there is a serious lack of information about him and his family. I hope that everyone of you that knows anything about this man will let me know immediately of any additional detail, or challenge any statement made that you may suspect is incorrect. We want to work out any disagreements as to facts now, and not wait until the book is published and then have someone poke our pedigree full of holes.

Another of our key ancestors is Agnes, mother of James Snodgrass of Franklin Twp., York Co., Pa., whose will of 25 Apr 1793 and proved 21 May 1793 also named five brothers (Robert, Samuel, William, John and Joseph) and five sisters (Sarah, Mary, Pheby, Agnes and Elizabeth). There is some reason to believe that Robert is the one who died in Rockbridge Co., Va., 1795, in which case the Samuel who married Elizabeth Adair would be another of the sons of Agnes. Larry Snodgrass considered the possibility that Agnes was the mother of his John who married Jane Steele, in which case the Joseph who married Hannah Morrison would be another. As you can see, it is all highly speculative and as yet not a shred of proof. Of the above daughters, there was an Agnes who married James Rea and moved to Clark Co., Ohio. It seems that the husband of Agnes never owned land in York Co., Penn., nor did he leave an estate that we can identify. I believe that John, Joseph and William were together in Harrison Co., Ky., before moving to Ohio. We need from you any ideas you have, even unfounded speculation. In its essence genealogy is very simple. All you do is to look in the right book for the evidence you need. But what do we look for in this case?

John Snodgrass, born <sup>22 JAN 1802</sup> 1799 Bracken (1) Co., Ky., married in Ky. and moved directly after his marriage to Ind., lived in Ind. about 15 years (Hancock Co.), then return to Ky. He married Hannah Lee, a cousin of the noted Robert E. Lee. They had twelve children - 3 boys and 9 girls - whose names are Wm. Dudley, Nancy Ann, Mary Caroline, Martha Jane, Amanda, America, Elizabeth, Harriett, Hannahitte, Frances, Noah.

Mr. John S followed farming as a livelihood but was by nature adapted for work of various kinds. He worked some at distilling. In politics he lived and died a democrat. He and his wife were long members of the Christian Church.

His children are most all dead. Of those yet living are Nancy Ann and Noah. Nancy Ann bought out the heirs and is living on the old home place.

John S accumulated quite an amount of property and died wealthy.

Robert Snodgrass was born in Bracken Co., Ky., in <sup>9 JAN 1804</sup> 1802, grew up in Bracken Co., and learned the millers trade from his father when quite young. He attended school and learned to read and write quite well. When a young man he came to Hancock Co., Ind., and after four years in that County was married to Miss Rebecca Gregg.

Sept. 19, 1826, John Snodgrass moved from Bracken Co., Ky., to Hancock Co., Ind.

James McCormick Snodgrass, born in Bracken Co., Ky., in <sup>13 FEB 1806</sup> 1804, attended school in Ky. while young, was a farmer (owned 160 A), moved to Hancock Co., Ind., while young. He married Lucinda Thomas. To them was born 8 children whose names were John, James, Wm., Agnes, Elizabeth, Shaan, Malinda, Mary Jane, Barnet. Of these thildren two are dead and five are living.

John James children are Mary, Sarah (diseased) Manson.

William married Sarah Hack, daughter of Adam Hack to whom the following children - John Mary, —, —, —, —, —, —,

William Snodgrass died about 17 years ago - was a soldier in the late war - served 3 years as a private. He belonged to the Christian Church and in politics was a democrat.

Agnes married Mr. Dungan.

Elizabeth married Mr. Ragsbly who was a Christian preacher. Elizabeth was reared in Hancock Co. and she and her husband now live at Washington, D. C.

Susan was raised in Hancock Co., married Mr. Rector, a farmer. Susan died about 25 years ago in Han. Co.

John Snodgrass was born in \_\_\_\_\_ Co., Va., (about 1779), moved with his father to Ky. at 15. There he married Miss Agnes McCormick. They lived in Ky. where he worked at the millers trade until Sept. 19, 1826 when he migrated to H. Co., Ind., where he entered several hundred acres of land (5 or 6 hundred) and farmed the rest of his life. He died in 1829. He was educated in Va. and Ky., being given quite a liberal education by his father. He owned a distillery, which he operated in connection with his mill. He owned 3 farms in Ky. He was a member of the New Light Ch., uniting directly after his marriage. He is buried in the graveyard at New Palestine.

Mrs. Agnes (McCormick) Snodgrass died July 3rd, 1845 at age 68 yr 4 m 19 da, having been born on the 14th of Feb. 1777, raised until 10 yrs old in Va. - moved from Va to Ky. The McCormick family was wealthy.

Robert Snodgrass emigrated from Va. to Ky. in 1794. He was probably *I believe she* born in 1754. He married Mary White of Va. She died in Ky. at age 91 or *died in 1827* 91. He owned 3 good farms in Ky. - was fairly well to do - He was a patron of education, having given his children a good chance in the Schools.

Peggie Snodgrass Anderson m in Ky., to Jas. Anderson and moved to Iowa where they died.

B 23 Dec 1851

Nancy Snodgrass Pope lives in Ky., well off. She moved at one time to Ind., H. Co., but returned in 2 or 3 yrs to Ky. She was educated and was very well learned in Scriptures.

Martha Snodgrass Davis lived in Ky. Husband Chas. never came to Ind. Their son Martin came to H. Co., then moved to Iowa.

Robt. McCormick, father of Agnes Mc., was reared in Pa., moved to Ky. where he married Jane McGregory. They lived and died in Ky. Children: James lived in Ill.

R. Mc. purch a tract of land from Govt where a part of Cincinnati now stands, while enroute from Pa., but Indians were so bad he was forced to leave it and went to Ky.

Rethe & Walter McC (sons of Robert) were in the War of 1812. Afterwards lived in Ky.

Thomas lived at Madison, Ind., in wholesale business.

John Snodgrass made a record of all of his children in his family Bible in 1852. John Snodgrass II copied this record - from this old family Bible. These were recopied and one is still in possession of Mrs. Lillie Whipple at Wilson, Ind.

(1) The frequent references to Bracken County, Ky., are in error and in every instance should be to Bourbon Co., Ky. And there are several other errors that are difficult to understand if the information was indeed furnished by Minerva Snodgrass who was born 19 Mar 1824 and was married 11 May 1848 to Thomas Smith Woods, youngest child of John Snodgrass and Agnes McCormick. I have the copy of the above record that was then in the hands of Mrs. Lillie Whipple, my grandmother, daughter of Minerva Snodgrass Woods. The record is in the family Bible of the father of Minerva's husband, and I am very sure that it is in Minerva's own handwriting. Yet, having herself written the dates of birth of all her brothers and sisters, none of them are correctly stated in the notes above. Neither could it have been done by her father John Snodgrass in 1852 as he died 5 Aug 1830. John II, Minerva's oldest brother, might be the one who made the information available. Whatever its shortcomings, these notes are a goldmine of information and the kind of 'find' that each of you would like to make, and just might find in some old papers somewhere.

We need contributions of similar material from all of you, for you must not forget that the MACE is a cooperative project aiming at the development of the history of all the Snodgrass family.

Barton Stone, a Presbyterian preacher at Cane Ridge, Ky., to which church this part of the Snodgrass family belonged, broke with the Presbetry, and was instrumental in organizing what for a time were known as "New Light". Alexander Campbell, a few years later, did the same and for the same reasons, and his followers were called "Campbellites". Later, the two groups merged, wishing to be known by no other designation than "Christians", but not claiming to be the only Christians. This is considered the beginning of the 'restoration' movement back to New Testament practices and beliefs, devoid of man-made creeds, and the beginning of the Ecumenical movement. Unfortunately for the Ecumenical movement, these people lost their way, and have become Disciples of Christ, Church of Christ, and Christian Church, etc.
