Dear Committee,

My great great grandfather David Sparks with his wife and 4 children were first white inhabitants in Brown, Twp, Hendricks Co. Ind. in 1827. They were charter members of Big White Lick Regular Baptist church established in 1833, <sup>east</sup> at edge of Pittsboro. David was a farmer. His son Thomas J. C. was to be ordained <sup>at</sup> into this same church they were charter members of in 1864.

Elder Thomas Chilton Sparks became pastor of <sup>at Fayette, Ind.</sup> this church also Mt. Labor Regular Baptist church. Elder Sparks was known as an elegant speaker of his day. He started his education in a school house first west of Brownsburg where Jesse Smith was <sup>first</sup> teacher. I understand there was a grist mill on David Sparks land. My grand father ~~and~~ Aaron Othenial Sparks and his brother ~~David~~ David William grandsons of David worked in a saw mill in 1880 and lived in the village of Fayette. My father Elder John Earl Sparks son of Aaron became an ordained Primitive Baptist minister in 1927 at Salem church, Hendricks Co. line and Wall Street Pike.
