Clarkson B. Thomas, s. of David and Lydia (Brantingham) Thomas; b. in Harrison Co., Ohio, Mar. 14, 1877.

David Thomas, s. of Bradway and Rachel (Hall) Thomas, was b. in Harrison Co., Ohio. He was a farmer. He died in 1924. His wife, Lydia (Brantingham) Thomas, who was b. in Columbiana Co., Ohio, died in 1937. Her parents were Joseph and Anna Brantingham, the former of whom was b. in Penn. He was a carpenter.

Bradway Thomas, father of David Thomas, was b. in Ohio (?). He was a farmer. He moved with his family to Plainfield, Ind., in 1898. He married Rachel Hall.

Clarkson B. Thomas, the subject of this sketch, graduated from the Friends Boarding Sch., in Barnesville, Ohio, and in 1902, graduated from the Physiomedical Coll. of Ind., in Indianapolis. Since 1902, he has engaged in the gen. practice of medicine in Plainfield. Dr. Thomas is a staff mem. of the Meth. Episcopal Hosp., and St. Vincent's Hosp., in Indianapolis.
