Gladys Hovermale may not have Jane Jones's mother's name on her record. I just recently found out her name was Elizabeth Campbell before her marriage to Allen Ennis Jones. They came to Hendricks Co. from Mercer Co., Ky. in the late 1820s.

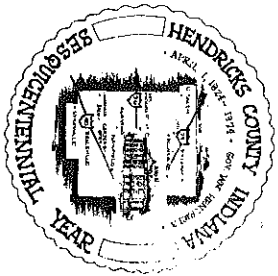

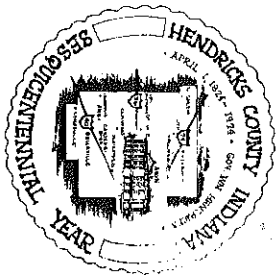

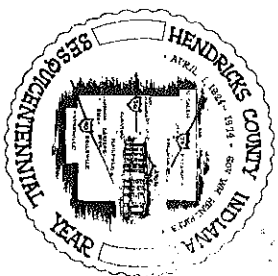
