ADDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS TO BENJAMIN VEATCH - Page 698 of the Four V Book.

I will begin with Benjamin Veatch III, page 705. At a later date I will search for the documentation of his parents. There are simply too many Benjamin Veatch's in the early Kentucky tax lists, who have not been accounted for.

We find Benjamin Veatch III as follows:

1. 1810 Ky. Woodford Co. - Pg. 388 Census

2. Benjamin VEACH and Robert GUYNN/GUYNN/GUYN post marriage bond and agreement between Ben VEACH and Asbel GUYNN, witnessed by Robert GUYN and Samuel GUYN. Benjamin VEACH signed by his mark. Bond dated 20 Dec., 1810, Woodford Co., Ky. Jan., 1818 - Will of Robert GUYN directs wife Jane to give each of their children not named in his will, the sum of \$1.00. May, 1818 - In the form of a Will, Jane GUYN gives 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ to each of the following:

1. To the children, heirs of Moses deceased: Betsey, Jane, Polley, Margaret and Susannah.
2. Isabell
3. Sally
4. Samuel
5. Rossannah
6. Patsey' Sauderson

3. 1820 Indiana - Orange Co, Paoli Twp - Page 136 - Census (Southeast Twp)
I am searching now for anyone who went to Indiana with Benjamin and Isabella, but to date, have the following information.

2. Asa VEACH - listed as next door to Benjamin. (Info. on him given on breakdown later. He will be referred to by me as "OLD" Asa in further lines, primarily to keep him separate from Asa, the son of Benjamin.

5. In my proximity 1835 or 1836, Benjamin VEATCH died in Orange Co. Indiana.

As a attorney, James J. Varlow is presently searching out the estate of Benjamin. He finds no deed records for Benjamin VEACH/VEATCH in Orange Co. Indiana records. Orange County was formed in 1816, and that portion called Southeast Twp., was originally part of Washington County, Indiana. I still do not know the exact year of Benjamin and Isabella's move from Kentucky to Indiana. I do find a Benjamin VEACH voting in a Paoli election in November, 1816, but have not located the original voter registration to analyze the handwriting in order to ascertain if the name should be Benjamin VEACH. If Benjamin VEACH moved to Indiana prior to Nov. 1816, and IF he purchased land, the records are in Washington County, Indiana. I am now in the process of getting someone to search the deed records there.

6. Hendricks County, Indiana, Order Book 2 - Probate Court - Page 80. 24 November, 1836

Thomas VEACH - Guardian

On petition of Elisha VEACH, Elijah VEACH, Asa VEACH and Sarah VEACH, to be permitted to choose a Guardian, and on petition of Thomas VEACH, on behalf Solomon VEACH & Samuel VEACH, infants, the said Thomas VEACH is now here appointed guardian for the protection of the persons and Estates of the said Elisha, Elijah, Asa, Sarah, Solomon and Samuel VEACH, minors and heirs to the Estate of Benjamin VEACH, their father, late of the County of Orange, in the State of Indiana, deceased, and the said Thomas files a bond which is approved by the Court and he is now, here in open Court, duly sworn as such guardian, according to Law.

And Court adjourned untill tomorrow morning ten O'clock. Signed November the Twenty Fourth A.D., 1836

7. Orange County, Indiana, Probate Order Book 2, Pg. 23, Date 13 February, 1839 William Case, adm de bonis non (administrator appointed by Court to replace original administrator) of Benjamin VEATCH, deceased, now files under oath an Inventory of Interest upon money loaned amounting to fourteen Dollars and seventy cents, ordered charged. And the said Adm. files also several vouchers and also his claim for services sworn to, showing in the whole sum of Two Hundred and Seven Dollars and forty four cents that he be ordered.

8. Orange County, Indiana, Probate Order Book 2 - Pg. 194. Date 18 February 1843. William Case adm. of Benjamin VEATCH, deceased, now files receipt for Clerks fees of one Dollar and on his motion it is ordered that he have further credit for the sum of Three Dollars and 10 cents and also for the further sum of \$33.00 being on account of property retained by widow of decedent and charged on sale bill making in all the sum of \$37.10. And thereupon it is ordered that the Administrator be exonerated from further transaction in the premises, he having fully administered said estate.

*****The above documents, while still incomplete, give us a vague picture of events. Benjamin VEATCH is deceased prior to November 24, 1836. His Estate in Orange County, Indiana, had an administrator who did not serve to completion, for as yet, an unknown reason. The Estate was not settled and completed until 1843, 7 to 8 years after Benjamin's death. The Estate must have been substantial to warrant the large administration fees charged to it, and also to have taken so many years to settle.

**** There is a record of a small group of graves marked only by rough stones, reported by J.L. Noblitt, Historian, the burial place of members of a VEACH family. Land in this section was entered by James VEACH in 1837. Section 6, Township One South, Range One East.

This is James VEACH, who is the son of Kinzey and Nancy (Parsons) VEACH. James VEACH, his wife Martha Allen/VEACH, and his son, Kinsey A. VEACH are buried in Providence Cemetery at Greenfield Twp. Orange Co. Indiana. This gives credence to the feeling that the small group of family graves was there on the land prior to 1837, when James VEACH settled there, and could be the location of Benjamin VEATCH's Grave.

**** After Benjamin's death, Isabella takes her children and moves to Hendricks Co. Ind. I would guess she moved there to be near her brother Samuel GUYNN.

9. On 11 December, 1838, Son Cornelius VEACH purchased 40 acres from Phebe SIMMONS. Cornelius VEACH married Catherine SIMMONS ca 1834-35 place unknown.

*****I know the 7th son is Samuel VEACH, from the guardianship papers. I cannot locate him on the 1850 Census. The 8th son is thought to be John Thomas VEATCH, but unknown except by circumstance. He cannot be located on the 1850 Census either. John Thomas VEACH died in 1913 and I am in the process of obtaining a death certificate, which might or might not reveal something. Where the two youngest sons of Benjamin are in 1850 remains a mystery. I feel that the last son comes from a birth after the guardianship papers. The 5th son, Asa VEACH, also cannot be located on the 1850 Census. The descendant of Asa VEACH say he moved to Clayton Co. Iowa in 1849 but I do not find him there. So we now have the children of Benjamin VEATCH and wife Isabella GUYNN/VEATCH as follows:
