

PLAINFIELD, Ind., October 15.—

John A. Miles, age seventy-six, a Civil War veteran and a wealthy Hendricks County land owner, died last night at his home here. He was born on the National Road near Belleville, and had lived in this county most of his life.

Mr. Miles was a member of the Masonic Lodge and the Christian church. He is survived by two sons, J. Harry Miles, of Indianapolis, and A. Strong Miles, of Plainfield; two daughters, Mrs. J. C.
