

Woody lineage: (12 generations)

1. Richard Woody I md Ann born and married in Kent, England and travelled to Roxbury, Mass. in 1638. The one son of Richard Woody I--Richard Woody II was an ancestor of Paul Revere. ~~Whether~~ son of Richard Woody the I--Isaac Woody was my ancestor.

2. Isaac Woody md. Dorcas Harper - born in England but later lived in Mass.
 3. John Woody I was born in Roxbury, Mass. in 1659
 4. John Woody II was born in Mass. in 1688 and died and was buried in Mass.

 After John Atkinson died--in 1830--Mary later gave birth to a son and named him Miller--and assigned to him, her maiden name--(since John Atkinson was not the father, hence this son was known as Miller Woody.)

Mary Woody died when her son was five years old--year 1838. Miller was born in 1833. The 1850 U.S. Census report found in Chatham Co, N.C. states that Miller Woody was then living in the home of Ruth Hadley Woody and her husband, Nathan Woody. The History of Hendricks Co. families in the State Library states that Miller Woody came to Indiana in 1851 at his age 15; however I believe Miller was 18--not 15--when he came to Indiana --. There is a discrepancy in Miller Woody birthdate (1833 or 1836) -see note under Millers name.

A letter from Joab Hadley to his brother Wm. T. Hadley states that he, Joab Hadley was the father of Miller Woody. This letter is now in the possession of Wade Hadley in Siler City, N.C. Wade Hadley is the son of Wm. T. Hadley. Jacob Hadley, Sr. had 3 children: ~~At B. C. 1833--some from Miller's diary was born 1833~~ ~~Academy was md. to Gladie Perry 1823~~ ~~Wm. T. Hadley B. July 15, 1814 D. Nov. 17, 1889 who married a Ruth Woody (this Ruth Woody was the daughter of John Woody and Mary Holliday Woody) (she was born on Oct. 20, 1822 and died Dec. 9, 1902 and md. Oct 1, 1843~~ ~~Jacob Hadley, Jr. --about whom nothing is known --one letter refer to name~~ who had no schooling and did not know how to spell Jacob--so signed the letter Joab--or who perhaps was called Joab because his father was also named Jacob) ~~who md. 8. Miller Woody B. Sept. 1833 D: Jan. 13, 1909 in Nowata, Okla. md. Margaret Ruth Lacy The Quaker records from Miller Woody's mother's church in N.C. list him as being born in Sept. 1833 but his tombstone lists him as being born in May 15, 1836. I prefer to take the actual church birth records as authentic--thinking that perhaps since Miller's mother died when he was age 5 and his father was not present either--Miller did not know his actual birthdate so just assumed the date of May 15, 1836--knowing that was approximate. Therefore he could have come to Ind. at age 18 -not age 15; and the history states he came with his parents--so perhaps the writer of the history just thought Ruth Hadley Woody and Nathan Woody were the parents of Miller Woody--since Miller Woody lived with them.
 Also: Margaret Ruth Lacy (Lacey) ~~was a Plainfield resident Born April 17 1819, 1841 and died March 27, 1877 or 1879 . She is buried in Pioneer Cemetery at Lizton, Ind. After her early death--Miller Woody went to Okla to live with his son, Clarkson Woody--in Indian Terr. and while there--it is said that both he and his son Clark--md. Cherokee Indian women.~~
