This is the second of a series of manuscripts to be published on the Milhous Family Descendants. HISTORY OF THE WRIGHT FAMILY

The patronymic "Wright" is an occupational surname, derived from the Anglo-Saxon word *Wryhta*, which like the modernized form, *faber*, signifies a skilled workman of any kind, especially an artificer in wood or hard materials. Hence, good carpenters were known as "wrights" meaning a skilled workman in woods. Variants of the name include "Cheeswright, Glasswright, Cartwright, Wheelwright, Arkwright," etc., meaning a skilled workman in his own field. Among other spellings of the name are: *le Wricte, le Wrichte, Wrygson, Wryght, Wreghtson*.

Tradition is that the Wrights probably originated in England, emigrated from there to Ireland, and from there to America. There is a Rowland Wright and his wife, Ayles, who lived in "Sheep Pasture (Here) Gillingborough", Yorkshire, England, who could have been the great-grandfather of Sismore Wright. We are not sure. His son, Mark Wright, with his wife, Ann Carlyle, and two children, Jane and Ayles, removed to Lygatory, Parish of Shankill, Co. of Armagh, Ireland, between Apr. 1655 and Mar. 1656 when their third child, John, was born. Three other children were also born there, Ann, Mark, and Jane. John or Mark, either one, could have been the father of Sismore. Of a fact, we know that Sismore was born in Ireland, and emigrated to America from Ballycane Monthly Meeting, Co. of Wicklow, Ireland, in 1725 with their four children, Isaac, Thomas, Margaret, and Ann. They settled in Berks Co., Pa. Thomas married Sibilla Pearson, dau. of Lawrence and Ester Pearson. Thomas and Sibilla were the parents of Benjamin Wright, Sr., who married Ann Parvin. They were the parents of Benjamin Wright, Jr., who married Hannah Milhous, who began the generations contained in this book.

The Monthly Meetings of the Friends in Maiden Creek, Berks Co., Pa., were established as early as 1757, but were probably held at the homes of some of the Friends. On July 12th, 1759, Benjamin Lightfoot granted a small tract of land from his farm to certain Friends-- Joseph Penrose, Richard Penrose, Thomas Wright (mentioned above), and William Tomlinson, who then erected a meeting house thereon. HISTORY OF THE MILHOUS FAMILY

The name "Milhous, Milhous, or Millhouse" is said to be of German extraction, and was originally spelled "Mulhausen" or "Molhouse". The town of Mulhouse, France, in the Alsace-Lorraine district, is said to have been named for people of that name. Mulhausen and Mulheim, Germany, perhaps were named for people of this family, also. "Mul" in German is translated as "Mill" in English.

Tradition stated that Milhous ancestors emigrated from Germany to England perhaps as early as in the 1300's. Some of them became Quakers, and during the early persecution in England of their faith removed first to Northern Ireland, settling in the Counties of Atrim, Down, and Antrim. There we find our earliest ancestor known, Thomas Milhousen and his wife, Elizabeth, living in Carrickfergus. Later his son, John Milhouse and family, and Elizabeth, his widow removed to Ireland, and settled in Tinalce, County of Mildere. In 1729 John's son, Thomas Milhous and his family came to America, and settled in Pennsylvania. John's other son, Robert and his family, came to Pennsylvania for a time to be with his brother Thomas and family, but in 1751 he and his sons and their families removed to what was known then as Pine Tree Hill, Kershaw Co., South Carolina. Thomas and Robert were both very active Friends and brought certificates of removal with them. Thomas's certificate is still in existence today. Hannah Milhous, who married Benjamin Wright, is a granddaughter of Thomas who emigrated to Pennsylvania in 1729. This manuscript contains her descendants.

Latest information seems to indicate that Robert Milhous and his family came directly to South Carolina from Ireland, and did not stop in Pennsylvania with his brother, Thomas and family, for a time first. These facts still remain to be proven with more research.

In going over old papers in a box given to the Historical Society at Mt. Pleasant, Ohio, Elizabeth Lupton found the billhead of "Charles Wright - Building & Other Hardware, Silver Plated Goods and Window Glass. Also, Staple and Fancy Groceries." In Town Hall Building dated 1876. This was the year that he married Hannah W. Price whose home was almost across the street from Town Hall. Charles Wright was also prominent in the Underground Railroad.

His first wife, Mary Wood, died at their residence in Martin's Ferry, Ohio, at the age of 66 years. She was a member of the Short Creek Monthly Meeting. She was of an amiable and social disposition, and much beloved by her friends. Her last illness lasted about six months.

Parvin Wright with Jacob Mauls, a Pleasant Friend, founded a school at Mt. Pleasant, Ohio, before his marriage to Mary Anne Stroud. He couldn't have taught there too long as he became Superintendent of Earlham College in 1872, which position he held until 1880. He started out as a farmer and was listed as such in the 1850 Census. His funeral and burial were private with "no flowers".

Ellen's death notice told of "a protracted period of bodily weakness, peculiarly trying to one who had formerly enjoyed almost uninterrupted good health".

After her sister's death, Mary gave up teaching which she loved very much, married Parvin and reared his three sons. She had been a teacher in both Ohio and Indiana for several years. She and Ellen were great-granddaughters of Col. Jacob Stroud.

In the 1860 Ohio Census Parvin's mother, Hannah, was listed as a member of his household at the age of 71.
