Dear Miss Cox,

Thank you for the forms for the Hendricks County Ancestor - Decendant Certificate. Our interest in family genealogy began a few years ago. At that time my mother was able to get copies of a book written by a relative that listed and described the decendants of a German boy who entered this country in 1747. The author had accumulated information about the decendants down to our generation, a task that apparently took years of work. With this information and the memory of relatives, we have been trying from time to time to build the "tree" backward from our children's generation.

Since my family moved to Hendricks County in the early 1950's and we have few relatives in Indiana, the Hendricks County information could only include Annice's family. We have accumulated some information and are enclosing two charts. These are

On the forms that you sent, there were two books that might be helpful in filling the blanks and add some general information about the people: "1885 History of Hendricks County" or 1974 "History, Biography, and Genealogy of Hendricks County." If either of these books would be helpful, we will send the order to you.

At this point, it would not appear that we have enough information to consider the Certificates. With more information, it may be that Certificates for a couple of "branches" of the "tree" might be worthwhile.

Perhaps there are other sources or other procedures which you might suggest for us to add some information.

Please, don't do any research on our behalf. I'm sure you are very busy. That type of work must be compensated and a major research effort is more than we have in mind.
