Dear Rev. Duncan:

In reply to your inquiry of June 15, 1985 please be advised that I made another search for early Fawcetts, etc. in Ohio.

I made a check of an index of early tax payers in Ohio and there were a number with the Fawcett name and variations of the name but all of them were in this eastern part of Ohio and most I could identify as coming from the Virginia Fawcetts.

In a listing of early land purchases made through the Cincinnati Land Office I found John Fossett purchased on Dec. 31, 1801, 198 acres in Sec. 28, T. 3, R. 4 in Hamilton Co., Ohio. I could not find where this was as I have a map which shows Sections in Hamilton Co. but not Townships and Ranges.

I also found an Elias Fasset listed as an early settler in Lucas Co. but that County was not founded until 1835 and is around Lake Erie so would not be your family.

The one buying land in Cincinnati seems to be the best bet. I hope that this will help you in some way.

James Madison President of the United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come greeting: Know ye that John Foyett of Hamilton County, Ohio, having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the Land office at Cincinnati whereby it appears that he has made full payment for two hundred and four acres and 7/100 of an acre of land in the South West corner of lot or Section number Twenty Eight, to Nam two hundred poles from East to West and one hundred and sixty poles from north to South of Township number three in the fourth Range of the land lying between the Great Miami River and the Virginia Reservation sold under the direction of the Register of the Land office at Cincinnati by virtue of the Right of prescription granted by law to certain persons who have contracted with John Closs Symmes or his associates, There is Granted by the United States in pursuance of the act of Congress in that case provided unto the said John Foyett the Tract of land above described. To have and to hold the said Tract of land with the appurtenances unto the said John Foyett his heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof I have caused these letters to be made patent and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed -

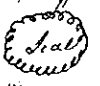

simple and have in themselves good Right full power and lawful authority to grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm the said bargained premises in manner aforesaid and that the said Thomas his heirs and assigns may from time to time and at all times forever hereafter by force and virtue of these presents lawfully peaceably and quietly have hold occupy possess and enjoy the said devised and bargained premises with the appurtenances free and clear and fully and clearly acquitted inonerated and discharged of and from all manner of former and other gifts Grants bargains sales or incumbrances of what name or nature soever that might in any measure or degree abtreat or make void this present deed.
