The Hubbard men have always been carpenters or building contractors, at least from 1831 to the present.

Nathaniel Dixon Hubbard was a Quaker, born in North Carolina). According to Hinshaw's Quaker Encyclopedia, this Hubbard family arrived in Plainfield in 1877. There was a business in Plainfield called Enterprise Planing Mill owned by Hubbard, Hay and Wallenweber which might have been this Hubbard.

Nathaniel's parents were probably John Hubbard and Abigail Coffin Hubbard of Guilford Co., North Carolina. John and his family left Deep River mm in North Carolina with "financial problems!" They were granted a certificate in White Lick m meeting in Indiana in 1844, but the next year he was disowned. They later died in Wabash, Indiana.
