of the county of *Hendricks* and State of *Indiana* of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said *William Shawver* of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of *four hundred and fifty dollars* to the said party of the first part, by the party of the second part in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, and sell unto the said party of the second part, all the following described pieces or parcels of land (To-wit) *South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section No Twenty-two in Township No Eighteen North of Range No One East in the district of land Subject to Sale at Crawfordsville Indiana containing forty acres be the same more or less*

To Have and to Hold, The above described premises with all the appurtenances to the same belonging to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part, his heirs, executors, and administrators, the aforesaid lot or tract of land, with the appurtenances to the said *Nobel Cox* and his heirs and assigns will forever Warrant and Defend.
