Honored Parents Brothers and Sister

I am glad of the opportunity to write you again a few lines to inform you of my welfare - my health is good the health of the boys is good. There is a few of the boys at Marietta my Tom Williams among them he was improving when we left Pin. The last letter I wrote when we were at Little River we are now about 15th miles from Rome we have marched about 40 miles to get to this place we had to go around a good ways to get on a road that the teams could get along on we have passed over some pretty good country in coming here there is plenty of hills in the country to the N. of

There is generally a rich valley—
Cave Springs is a little town
between two hills it has a Seminary
and a church or two, and a few
pretty good dwellings. we will likely
go to Rome and rest a while and
then the talk is that we are to
go through the country to Mobile.

I would not be surprised if we
undertook such an expedition if—
so we will be away from communi-
cation for a good while but our
mail will be sent to the point
where we are to go. we have been
feasting on potatoes pumpkins and
fresh meat for some time now it
is quite a happy change from Govern-
ment rations. I have no chance of
sending this to day I will write
more and send this the first chance.
