so we came back to our old camp
for the night but will be likely
to move again today we will
likely get settled in camp in a
day or two, there is a flag of
truce going out about 6 miles
to meet a like flag of the rebels
and exchange prisoners that have
been taken on this campaign I
hope that Linger Green Williams
and others will get with us again

We look to be payed in a week
or so and after that there will
be some furlows granted I do not
expect to get to come home as there will
be but few, probably one or two from
our company. we had another man come
up yesterday viz. A. J. Poe he says Poe is
still at home and will not be up
soon as he had a good place there and
assistants were needed in the hospital.

I think of nothing more
of importance to write at

Wee were on the moove yesterday wee packed up and went to our Brigade but it had orders to moove and our position was not assigned so wee came back to our old camp for the night but will be likely to moove again today wee will likely get settled in camp in a day or two, there is a flag of truce going out about 6 miles to meet a like flag of the rebels and exchange prisoners that have been taken on this campaign I hope that Linzy Green Williams and other wills get with us again wee loock to be payed in a week or so and after that there will be some furlous granted I do not expect to get to come to home as there will be but few, probably one or two from our company. Wee have another man come up yesterday viz. A. J. Roe he says Poe is still at Rome and will not be up soon as he has a good place there and assistants are needed in the hospital. I think of nothing more of importance to write at present.
