



THOMAS LITTLE HOME

1738 West Main Street

Original owner: Thomas H. Little

Year built: 1885

Remodeled: Refurbished in 1989.

Architecture: Queen Anne; 3 story frame; 3rd floor turret room and 2nd floor balcony with railing; along 2 sides, a circular porch with round columns and railing; interior: spacious rooms.

Present owner: Charles Carpenter

Past owners and/or residents: Judge Givan; Mont Dailey.

Noteworthy: Thomas Little was superintendent of the Plainfield to Cartersburg section of the Cumberland Road when it was a toll road. A log structure behind the main house is rumored to be a former post office building which had been moved from downtown Plainfield and was used as a tenant house. When Mont Dailey was the owner from 1949 to 1982, the property became a goat farm.
