July 29, 1905

Knightstown, Ind.

If not to much trouble I wish you would please find out and ans. the following questions:

How old was Enos G. Pray -the father of your late husband at the time of his death. Where did he die, and where was he buried. By ans. the above you will greatly oblige me.

We expect to celebrate the One Hundredth Anniversary of the establishment of Friends Meeting at West Elkton, Ohio on the 13th and 14th of Oct. Mr. Pray was recorded a minister by Elk Monthly Meeting in 1845. I have been selected by the Executive Committee to write a history of our meeting since its establishment in Sept. 1805. This is why I make the inquiry.

My Grandfather and Grandmother partly raised Mr. Pray. When he was married to Elvira Stubbs they built a house on their farm for him to live in. Remember me to your daughter Alice and Mr. Elliott. I am somewhat acquainted with them.
